

How to use vertical tabs on Microsoft Edge

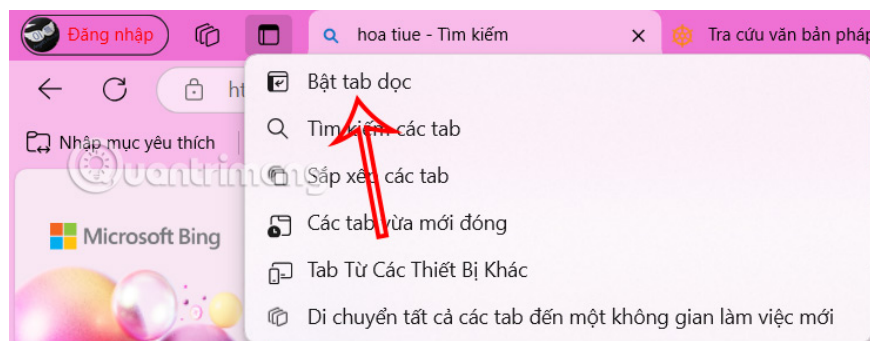
Vertical Tabs on Microsoft Edge brings a more organized tab management interface, managing and viewing tabs on the left side of the screen interface.

All open tabs on the browser are displayed on the left side of the screen for you to access or perform other operations. Below are instructions for using vertical tabs on Microsoft Edge.

How to use vertical tabs on Microsoft Edge

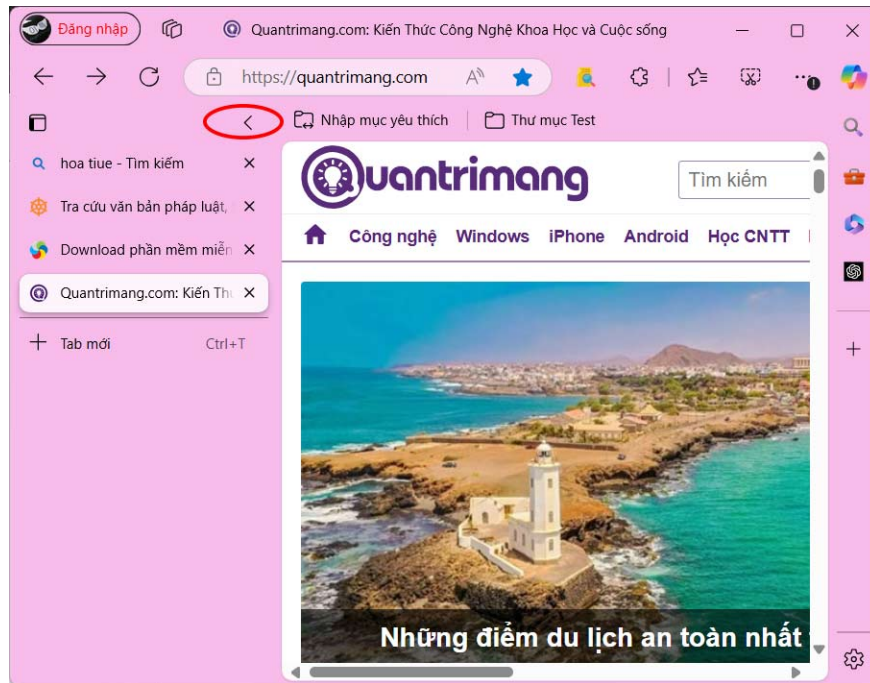
Step 1:

You open tabs on the browser as usual, then click on **the tab icon** on the tab bar as shown below. Now you click on **Enable vertical tabs** to do it.

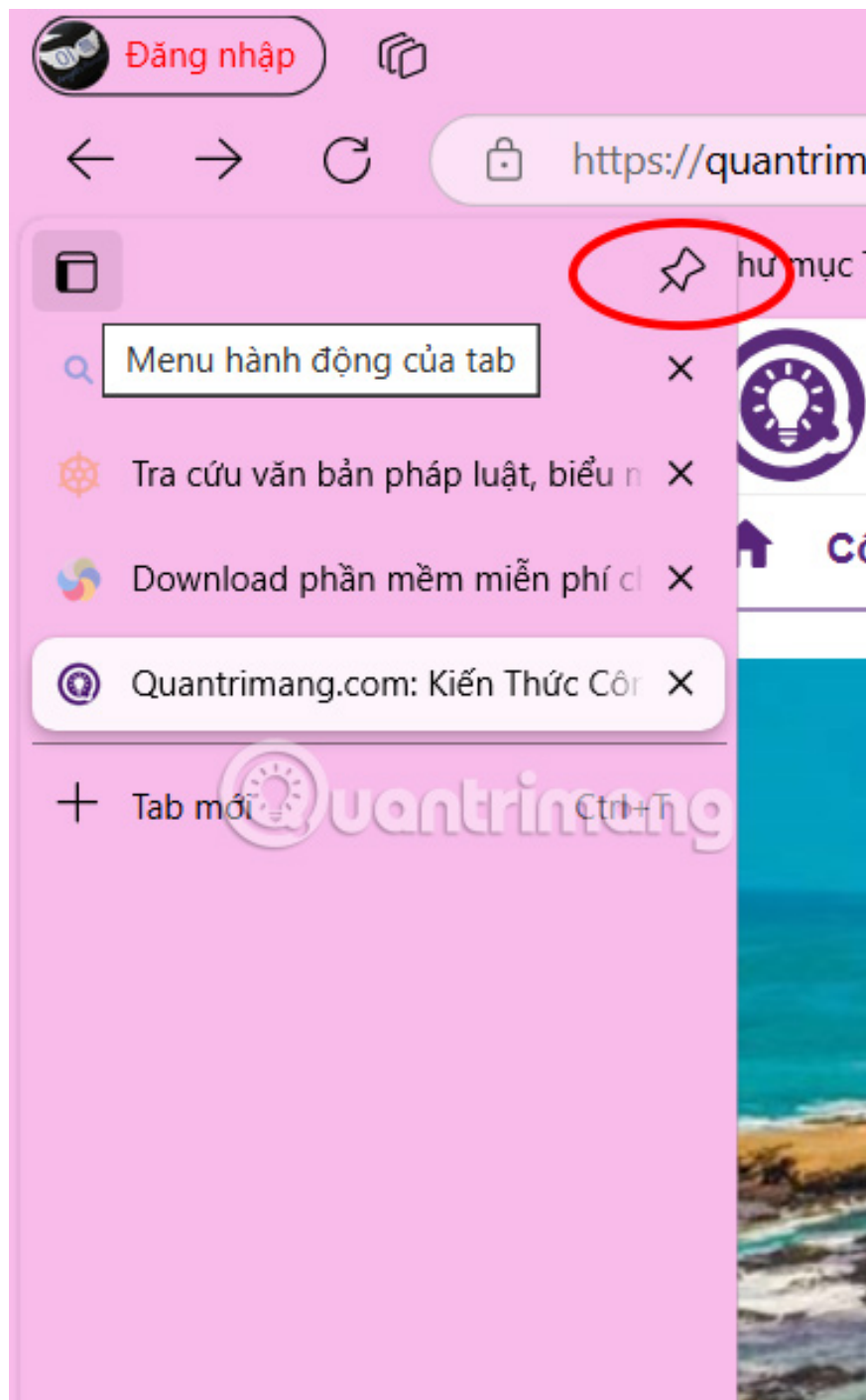


Step 2:

Immediately after that, you will see the interface for managing open tabs on Edge moved to the left edge as shown below. We just need to **click on the left arrow icon** to **hide the vertical tab bar** on Edge.

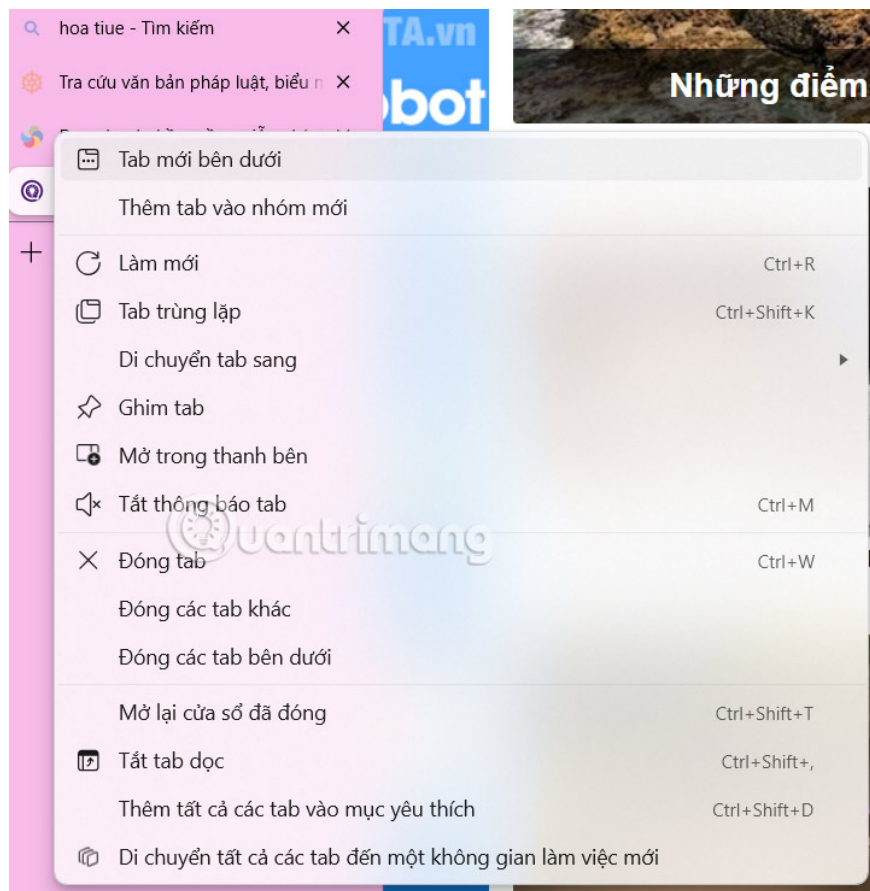


At that time, the vertical tab bar on Edge has been hidden to simplify the web browsing interface. To show it again, just click on the tab icon. If you want **to fix** this vertical tab bar on the interface, just click on **the pin icon**



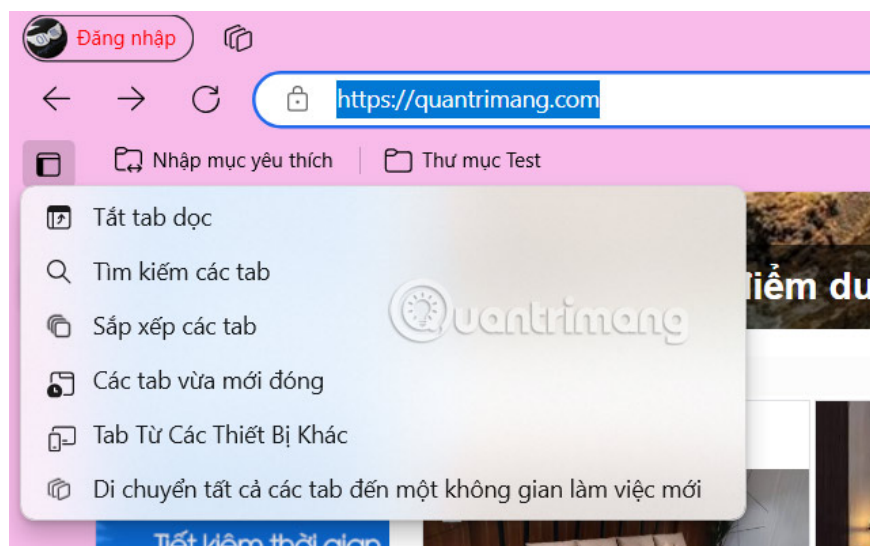
Step 3:

In each open tab when you right click on each tab there are options for each tab as shown below.



Step 4:

Click **the vertical tab icon again on Microsoft Edge** , now users will see the option to Turn off vertical tabs or other options.
