

How to verify your Facebook account and authenticate it.

Have you seen the blue checkmark on Facebook? It's a sign that your account has been verified. Let's find out how to verify your account and the requirements to get the blue checkmark!

How to verify your Facebook account is legitimate.

1. Benefits of verifying your account ownership

- Verification helps prove that the account belongs to the legitimate owner. Accounts without a blue checkmark are fake and may be reported.
- Facebook will prioritize assisting you, making it easier to recover your account in case of problems.
- If it's a fan page, the account will appear higher in search results.
- Accounts with a blue verification badge or fanpages with a gray verification badge are more trusted by viewers.

2. Conditions for obtaining a blue checkmark and verifying the account's ownership.



- If you are a celebrity or a well-known company that is actively involved on Facebook, Facebook will automatically update your verified badge.
- If you want to proactively apply for a blue verification badge, contact Facebook Management Agencies in Vietnam. They can help, but your application may be rejected if you don't meet the requirements.
- If the account has a verified blue checkmark and is then transferred to another account, that account will still be prioritized for the blue checkmark update.

3. Verify the authenticity of your personal or business Facebook account.

- Facebook is popular and has a large following (personally).
- If you work for the government, you can submit a request on Facebook to receive a verified badge.

Businesses can contact Facebook's Manage Agencies in Vietnam.

- Some well-known businesses will be automatically verified and given a gray checkmark.

Therefore, if you own a personal Facebook account, a personal fan page, or a business page that meets the requirements, please contact a Facebook Management Agency. For regular Facebook accounts, verification can only be done if the account is lost.

Through the article above, you now have a better understanding of the conditions for verifying your Facebook account and obtaining the blue and gray checkmarks, right? It's not easy to get that verification unless your Facebook account or Facebook fan page meets the standards mentioned above. After verifying your Facebook account, you can register to get a Facebook checkmark for your personal page or fan page. The blue checkmark will further confirm that your Facebook account is genuine.
