

How to view and quickly delete saved passwords on Chrome.

To view saved passwords on Chrome, you need to access Chrome's password manager by typing `chrome://settings/passwords` into the Chrome address bar or following these steps:

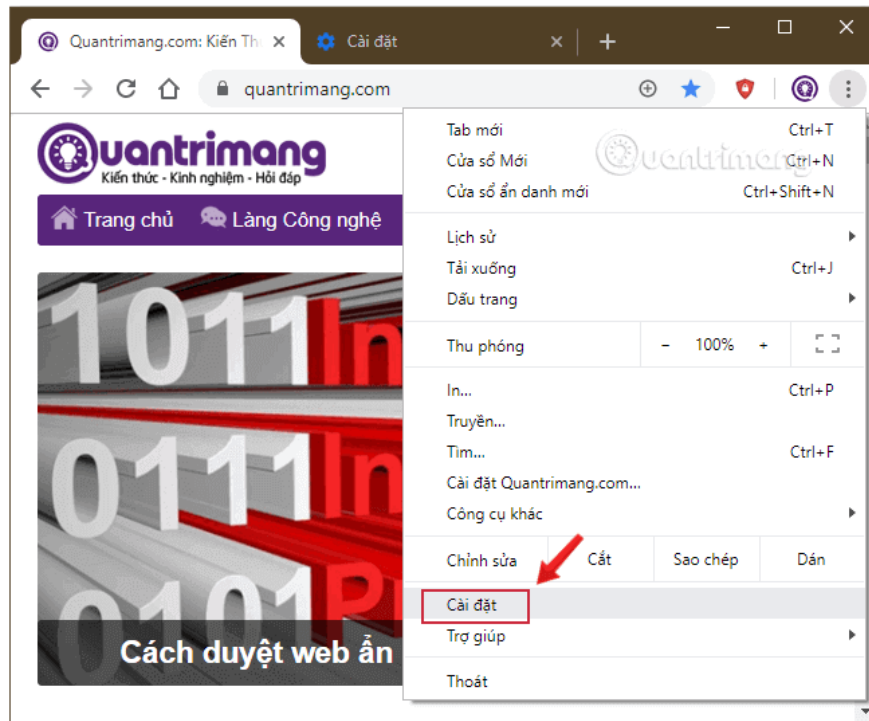
Have you accidentally forgotten a password you saved on a website in Chrome? Recovering your password is much simpler when you use Chrome's built-in saved password manager to log in to that website.

Thanks to this feature, users can review their saved passwords for easier login on future visits. Alternatively, they can delete saved passwords. Refer to the instructions in the Network Administration guide below.

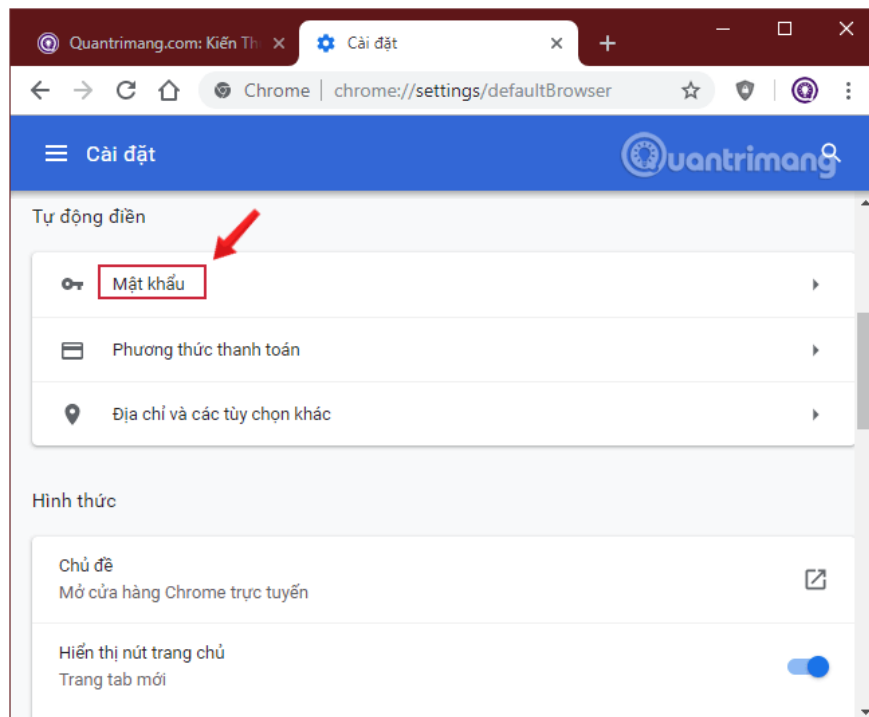
How to view saved passwords on Chrome PC

To view saved passwords on Chrome, you need to access Chrome's password manager by typing `chrome://settings/passwords` into the Chrome address bar or following these steps:

Step 1: Open your Chrome browser, click the **three vertical dots (?)** in the upper right corner of the screen, and access **Settings**.



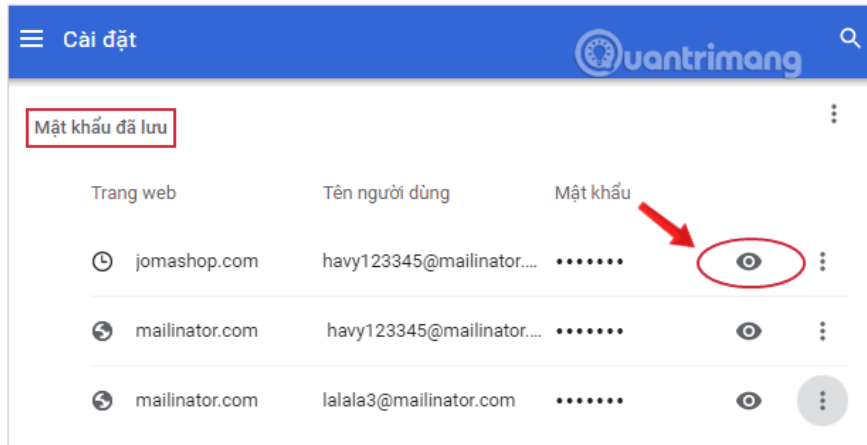
Step 2: Scroll down, find the **Autofill Setting** section , and click on **Passwords**.



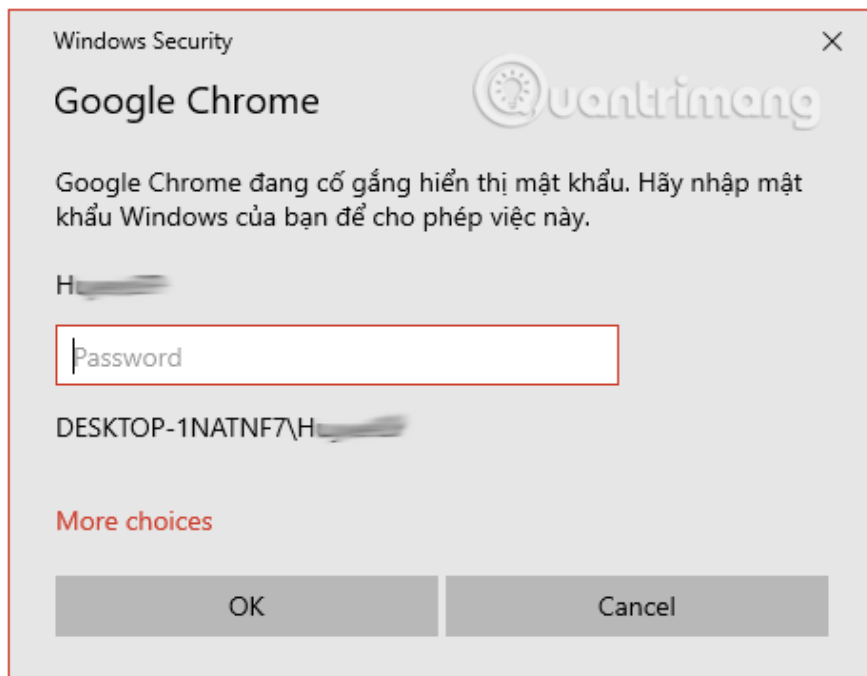
Step 3: Under the "**Saved Passwords**" section , you will see a list of websites and their saved passwords.

This section will show you all the passwords you have saved on your Chrome browser.

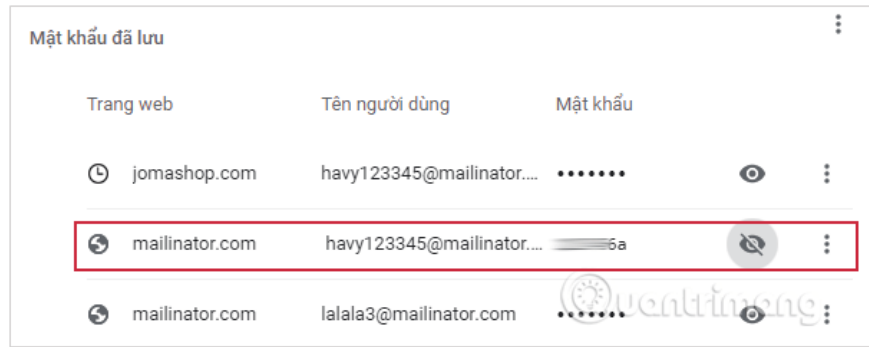
When you see the password you need, you can click the eye icon to view it:



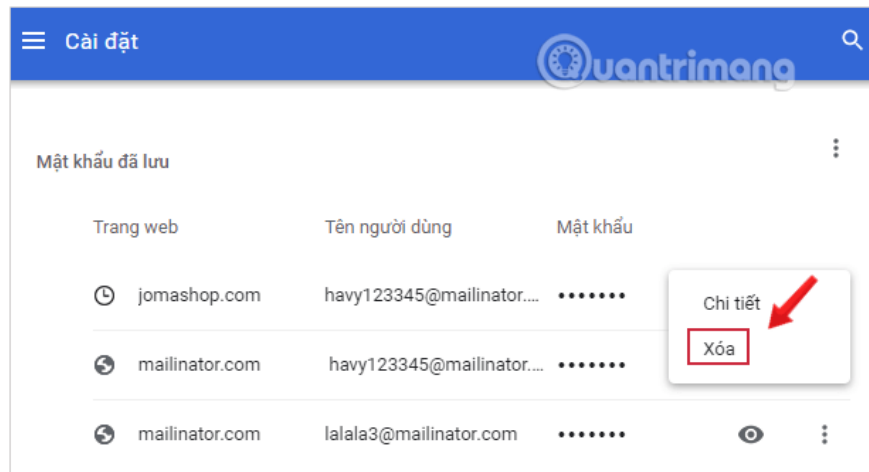
Step 4: Chrome will prompt you to enter your computer's login password to view the passwords saved on Chrome.



The password will then be displayed as text:

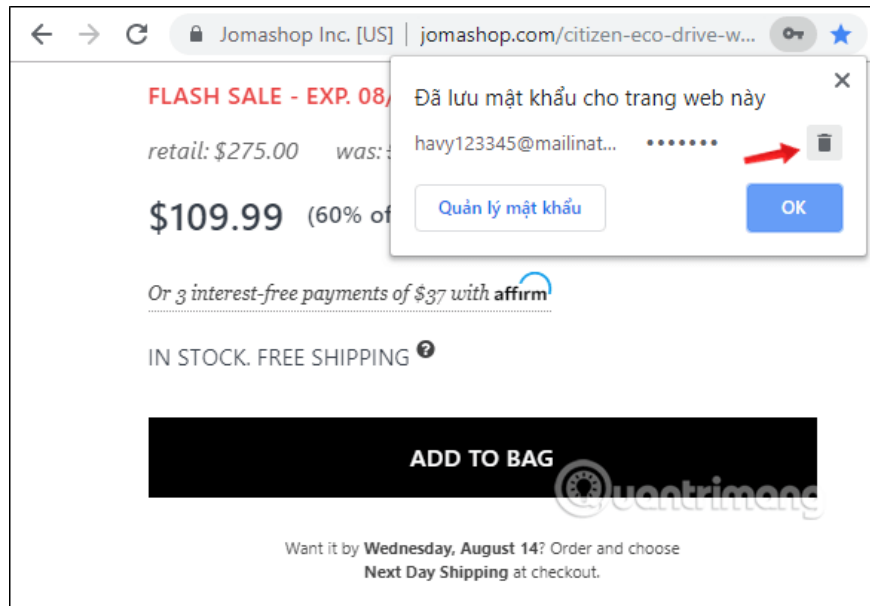


Step 5: If you want to delete a saved password on Chrome, click the three dots next to the password and select **Delete**.



Additionally, if you want to remove the password from a website you are currently visiting, you can do the following:

1. Go to the website from which you want to remove the password.
2. Next to the address bar, click the padlock icon.
3. After entering your username and password, click the **trash can** icon to delete the information you've saved on this website.



View saved passwords on Chrome on iPhone.

To view/delete saved Chrome passwords on your iPhone, follow these steps:

Step 1: Open the Chrome app on your iPhone or iPad and tap the three vertical dots icon in the bottom right corner of the screen.

Step 2: Select **Settings ? Password**.

Step 3: Under the "**Saved Passwords**" section, you will see a list of saved websites and passwords. This section will show you all the passwords you have saved on the Chrome browser.

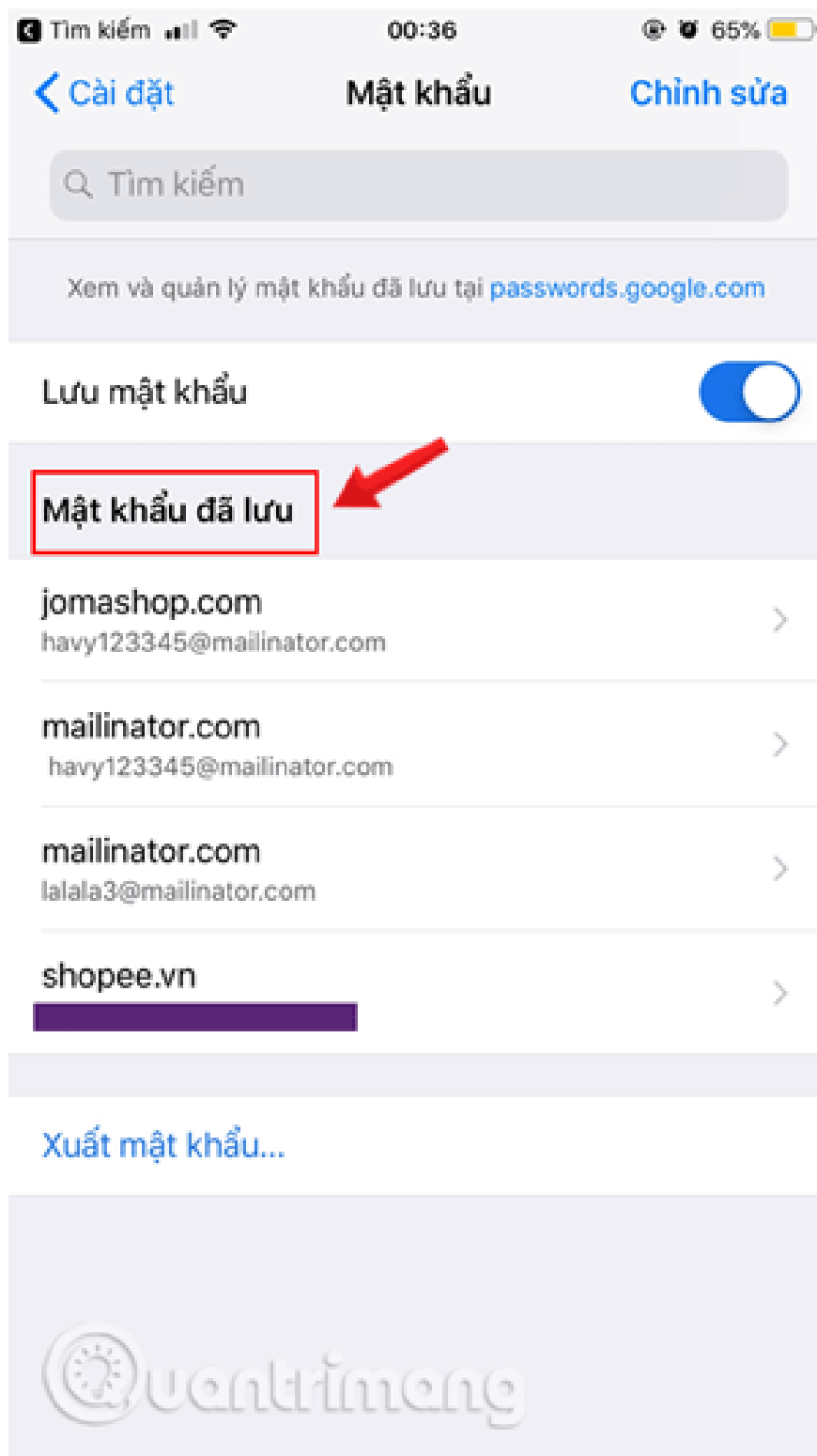

Step 4: Once you see the website whose password you want to view, click on it and select **Show**.

Step 5: Chrome will prompt you to enter your device password to view the passwords saved on Chrome. The password will then be displayed as text as follows:

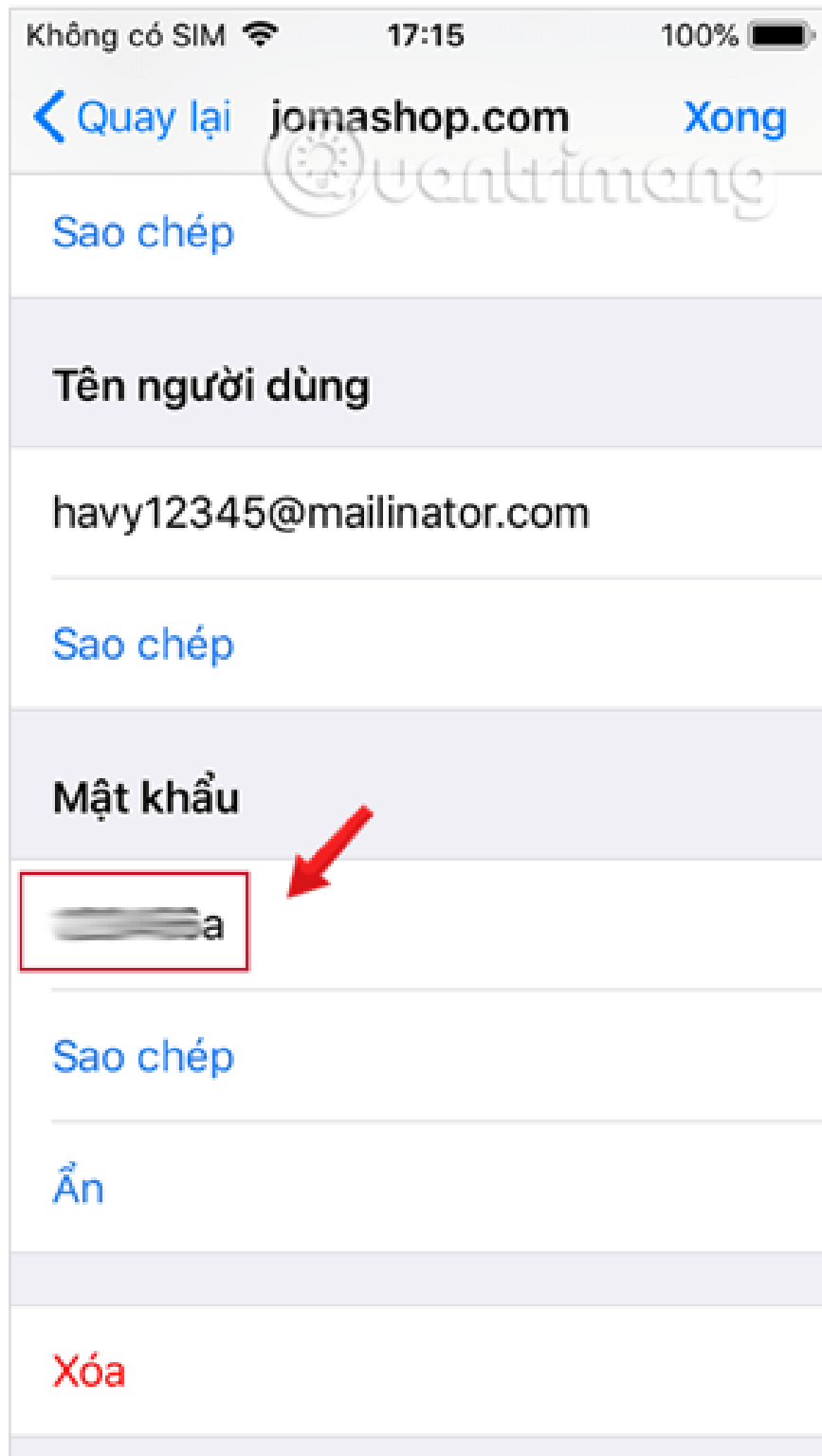

Step 6: If you want to delete a saved password on your iPhone , there are several ways to do so:

1. *Method 1* : Select the account you want to delete, then find the **Delete** option at the bottom.
2. *Method 2*: Swipe left on the account you want to delete the password for.
3. *Method 3*: Tap **Edit** in the upper right corner of the screen, then select the accounts you want to delete. This method applies when you want to delete multiple accounts.

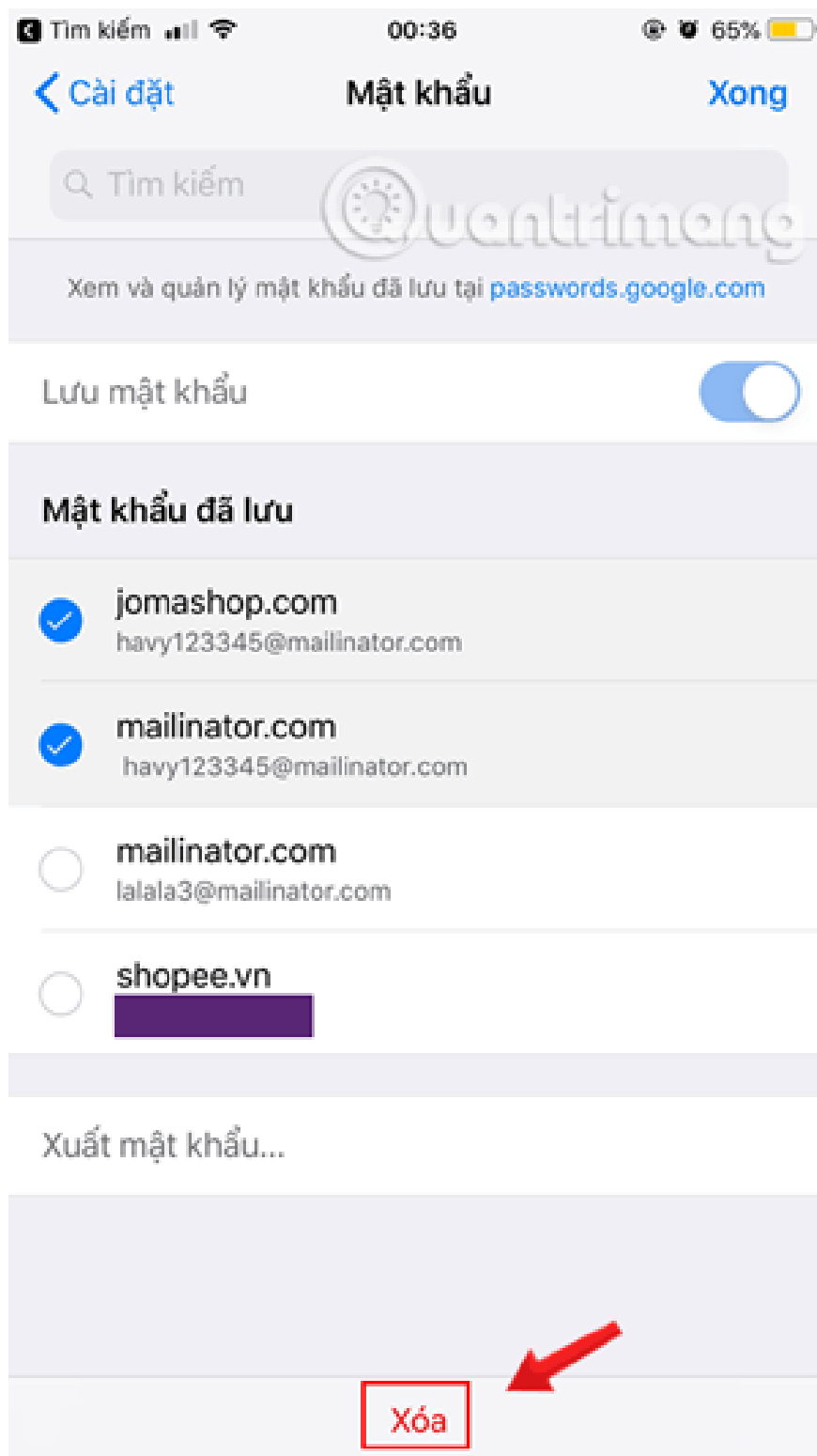

Ways to delete saved passwords on Chrome browser on iOS devices.

View saved passwords on Chrome for Android.

Step 1: Open the Chrome app on your Android device and tap the three vertical dots icon in the upper right corner of the screen.

Step 2: Select **Settings ? Password** .

Step 3: Under the "**Saved Passwords**" section , you will see a list of websites and their saved passwords.

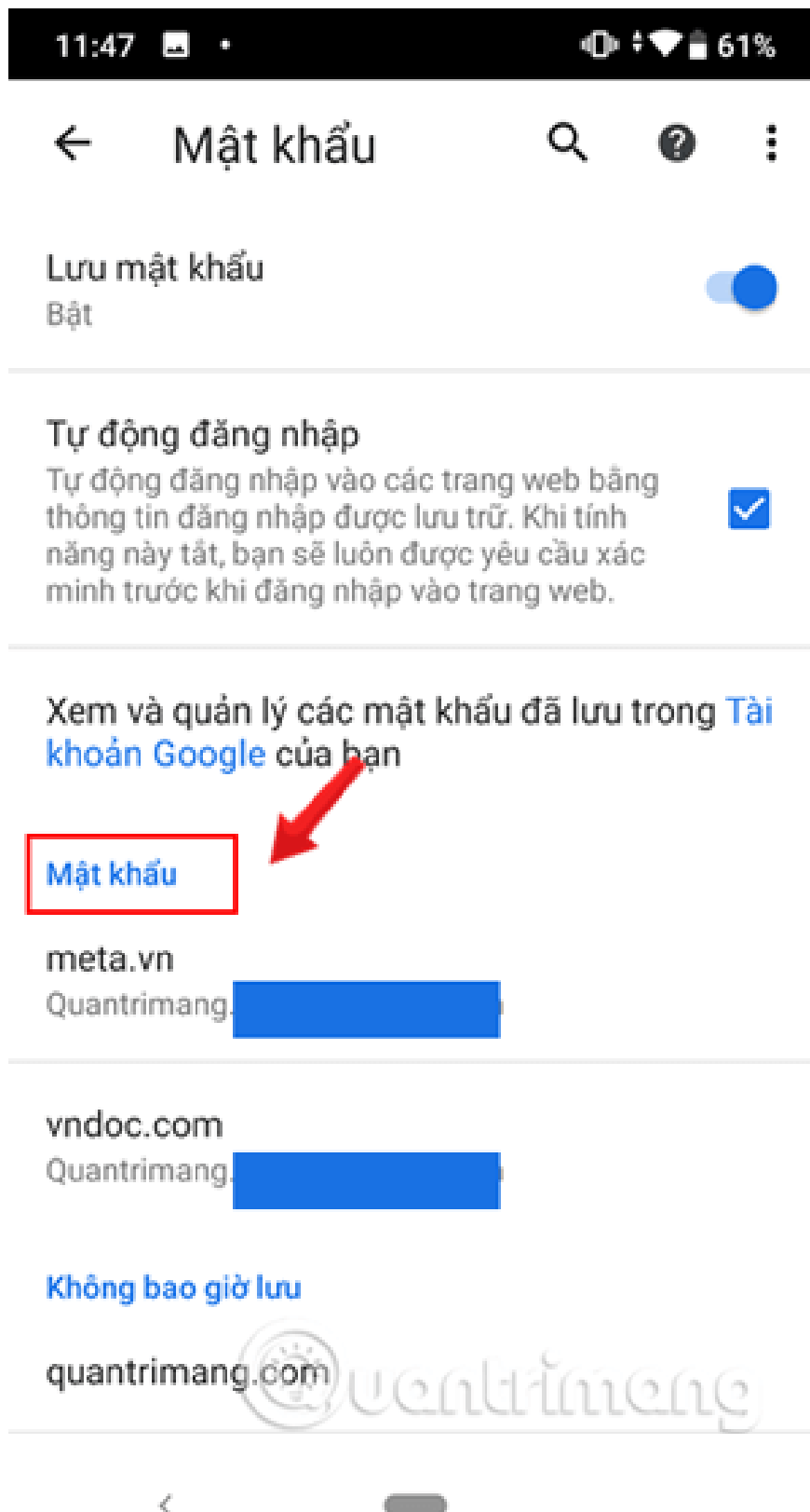

Step 4: Once you see the website whose password you want to view, click on it and select **Show**.

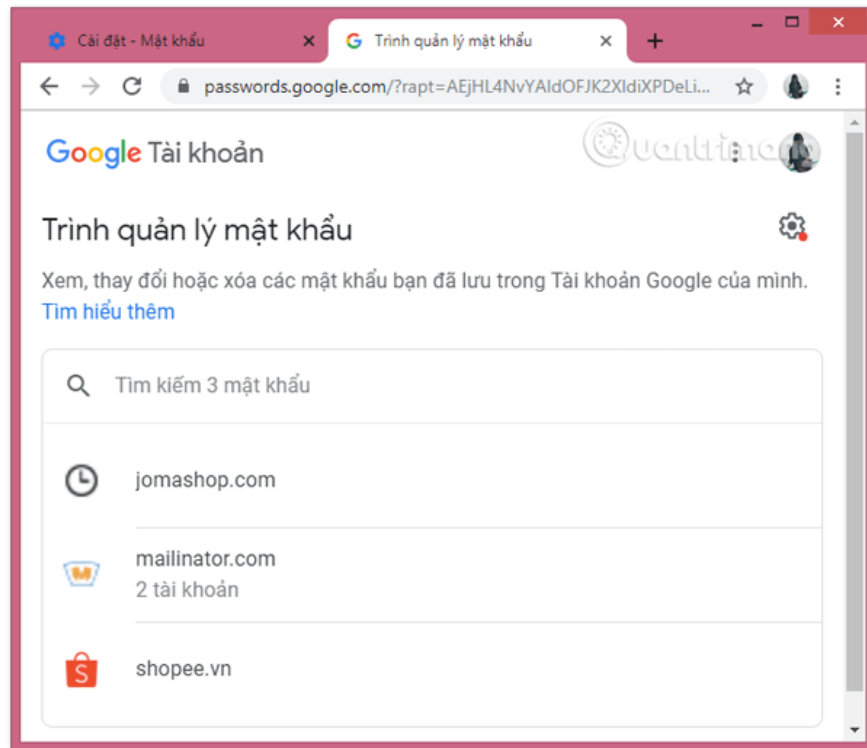
Step 5: Chrome will prompt you to enter your device password to view the passwords saved on Chrome.

Step 6: If you want to delete a saved password, tap on the account you want to delete, then select the trash can icon in the upper right corner of the screen to delete the password.



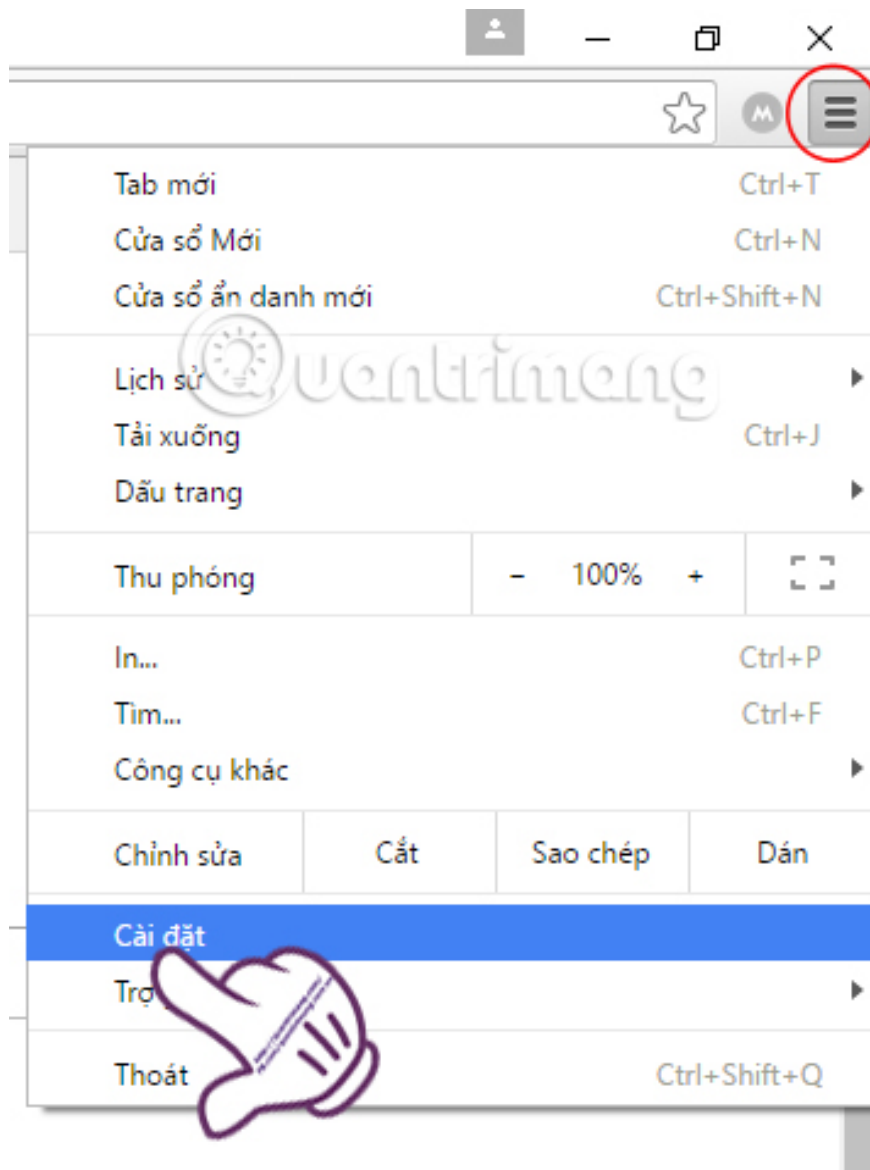
View saved passwords on Chrome using Google Password.

You can easily view the passwords you've saved on your Chrome browser by visiting the website: passwords.google.com.

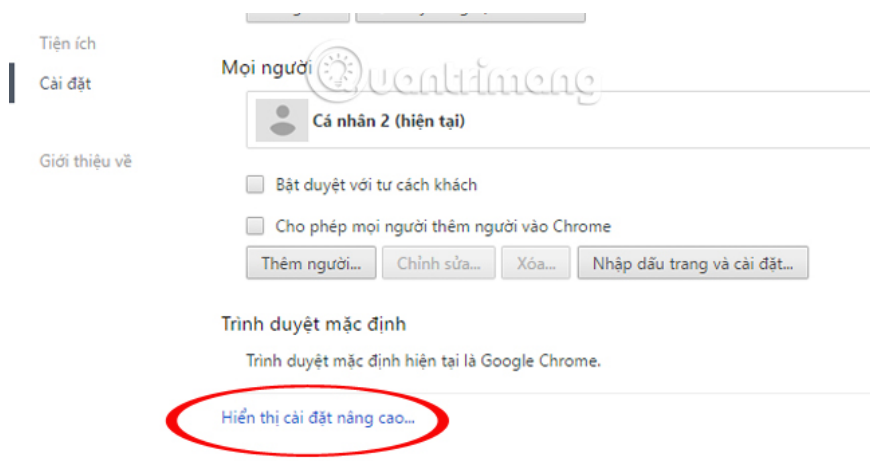


How to view saved passwords on Chrome 59 and earlier.

1. On the main interface of the Chrome browser, click **the three horizontal lines icon** and select **Settings** .



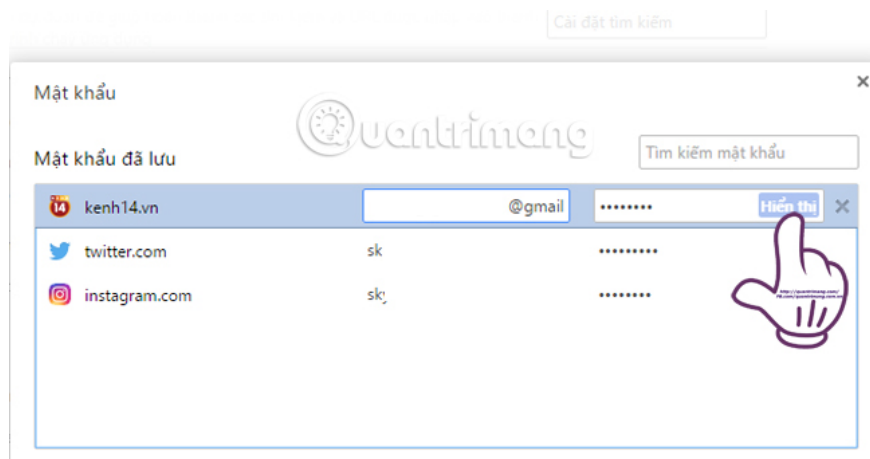
1. In the Settings interface, scroll down and select **Show advanced settings** .



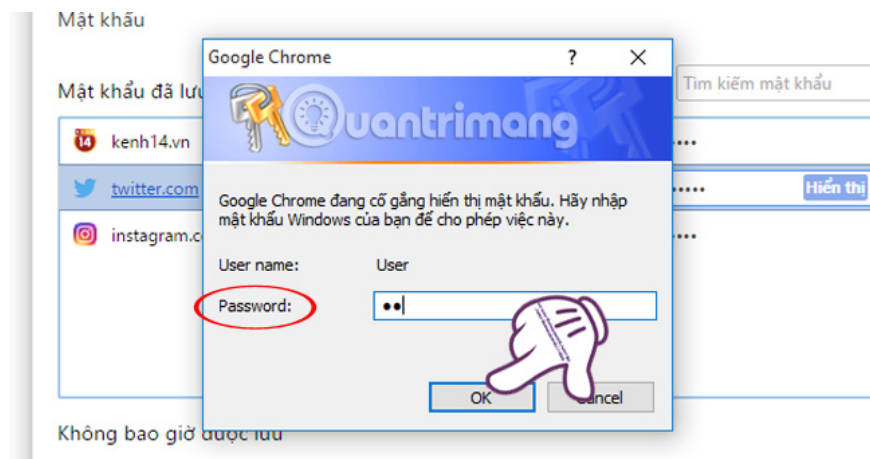
1. Next, find the **Passwords and Forms** section , then click on **Manage Passwords** .



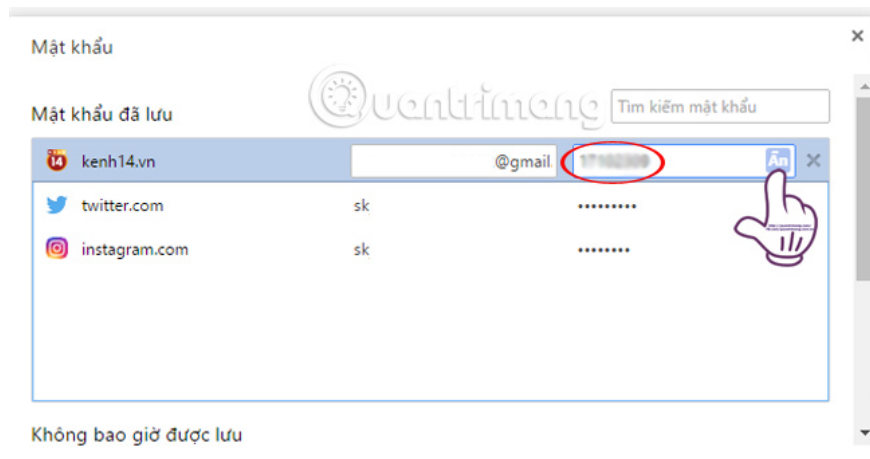
1. The Passwords window will appear. Here, you can view saved usernames and passwords for websites in the **Saved Passwords** section . If you need to **view a password for a specific website**, select the desired entry and then click the **Show** button .



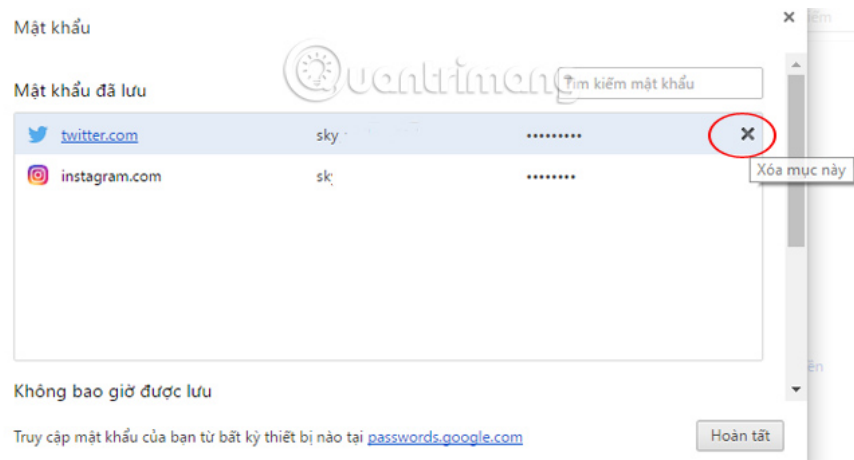
1. Immediately afterwards, a notification from Google Chrome will appear asking you **to enter your computer password** . Enter your password and click **OK** to confirm.



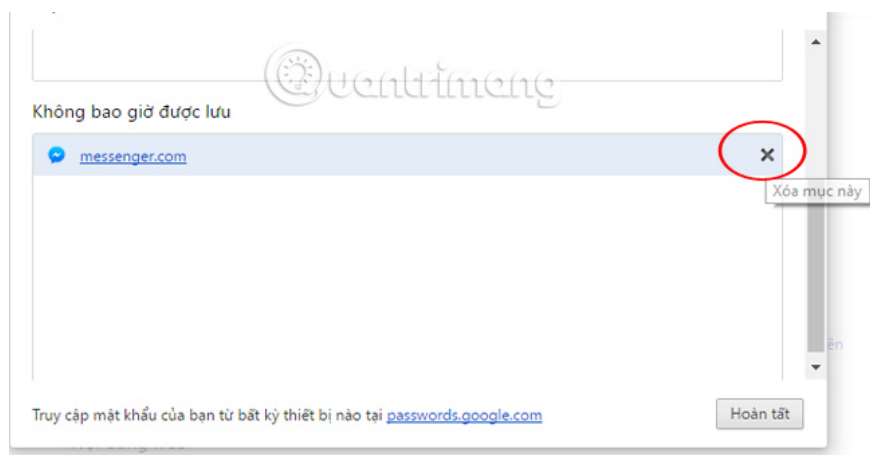
1. You need to enter your computer password correctly to display the saved password for that website. To revert the password to its original format, click **Hide** .



1. To **delete saved passwords** for websites, click **the X** at the very bottom.



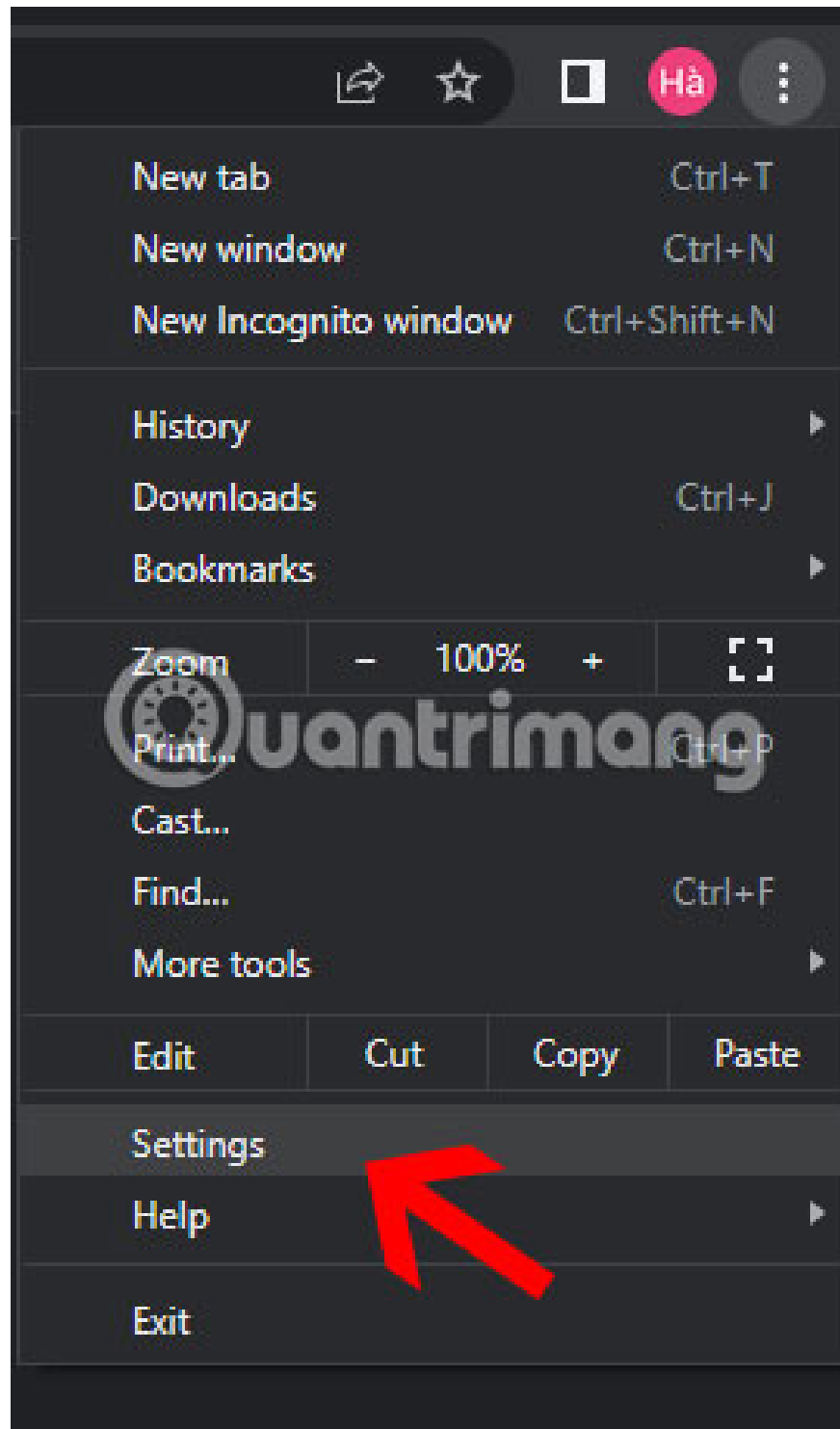
1. In the **"Never save"** section , Chrome will save the passwords for pages where you didn't click "Save password" when prompted on your first visit. To save a website password, click the "X" at the end of the line.

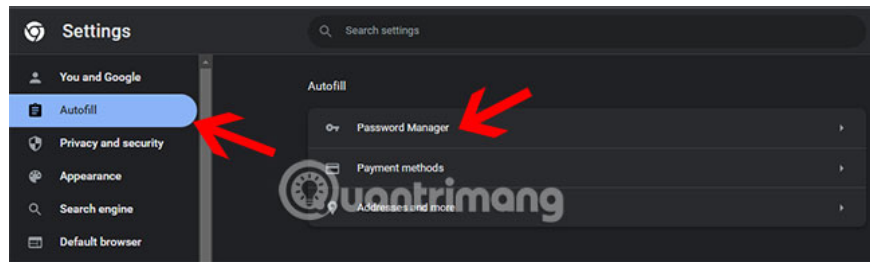


Some frequently asked questions

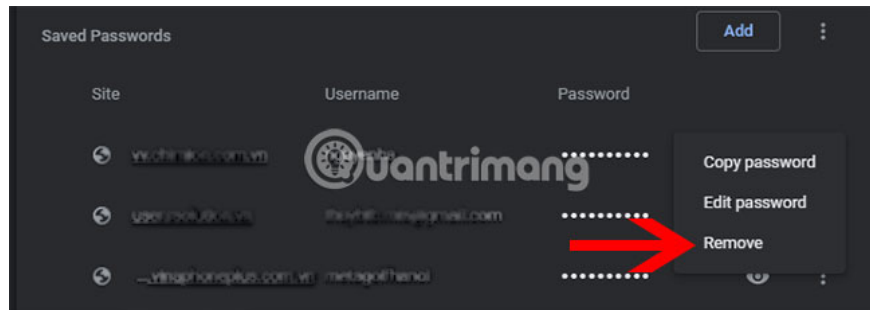
How do I delete saved passwords in Chrome?

In your desktop browser, go to **Settings > Autofill > Password Manager** to view your saved passwords.





Next, click on the **More** menu (three vertical dots) and select **Remove**.



In the mobile app, select **More** (three horizontal dots) > **Settings** > **Passwords** . Tap the password, select **Edit** , then select **Delete** at the bottom of the screen.

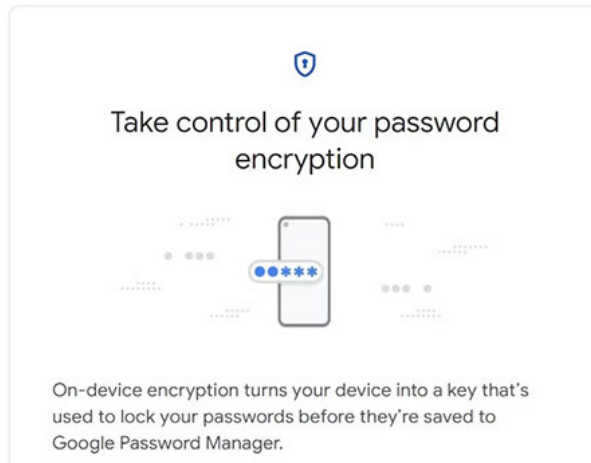
How do I delete all saved passwords in Chrome?

Chrome doesn't include a quick way to instantly delete all your saved passwords. You'll need to delete them one by one in the mobile app or the desktop browser.

Should you use on-device encryption for your password?

On-device encryption allows you to lock saved passwords on your Google account with a unique security key. Once this feature is set up, you'll need to sign in with your Google account from the device that locks the security key. You'll then have control over your passwords. However, there's a risk of losing access.

On-device encryption



On-device encryption can be an attractive option for those who want strict control over their passwords. Offering this option means Google takes personal account security very seriously, regardless of your level of expertise in this area. However, because this feature is optional, this article only recommends it to advanced or proficient users who want more control over their passwords. If you're willing to try on-device encryption, you can rest assured that your passwords will be extremely secure. Be extremely careful to prevent your device from being lost or stolen.

So, we've now guided you through the steps to retrieve your saved passwords. Now you don't have to worry about not being able to access any website if you accidentally forget your login password.
