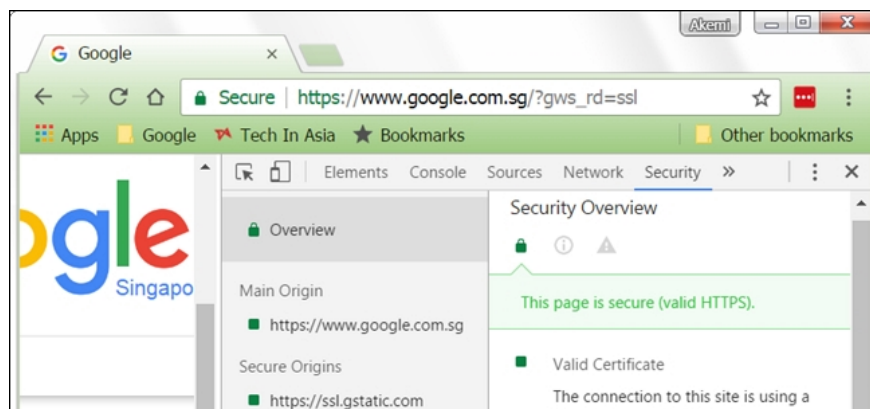


How to view SSL certificate details on Chrome browser?

Answer 1:

You can find SSL details by clicking on the 3 dots icon in the top right corner of the screen => **More Tools** => **Developer Tools** , then clicking the **Security tab** . Here you can see an overview of security features with just one **View Certificate** button.

Answer 2:

Add the above answer: Starting from the Chrome version 56, the above method (in answer 1) is the only way to see details of SSL certificate information.
