Go to WiFi in Settings > Tap to view connected WiFi information > Tap Password to view WiFi password.

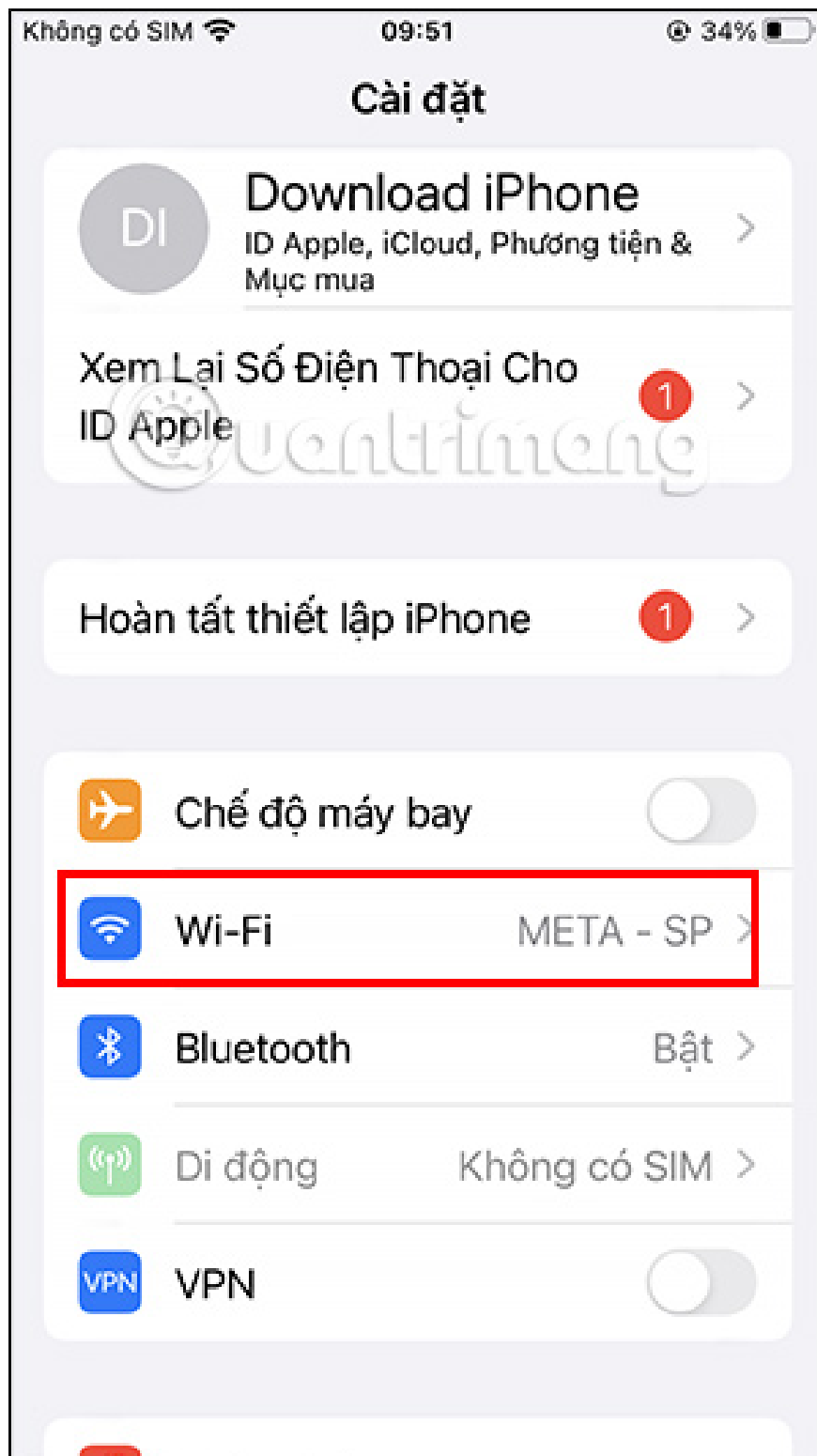
Detailed instructions

Step 1:

Then the user accesses **the Settings section** on the iPhone and then **clicks on WiFi** .



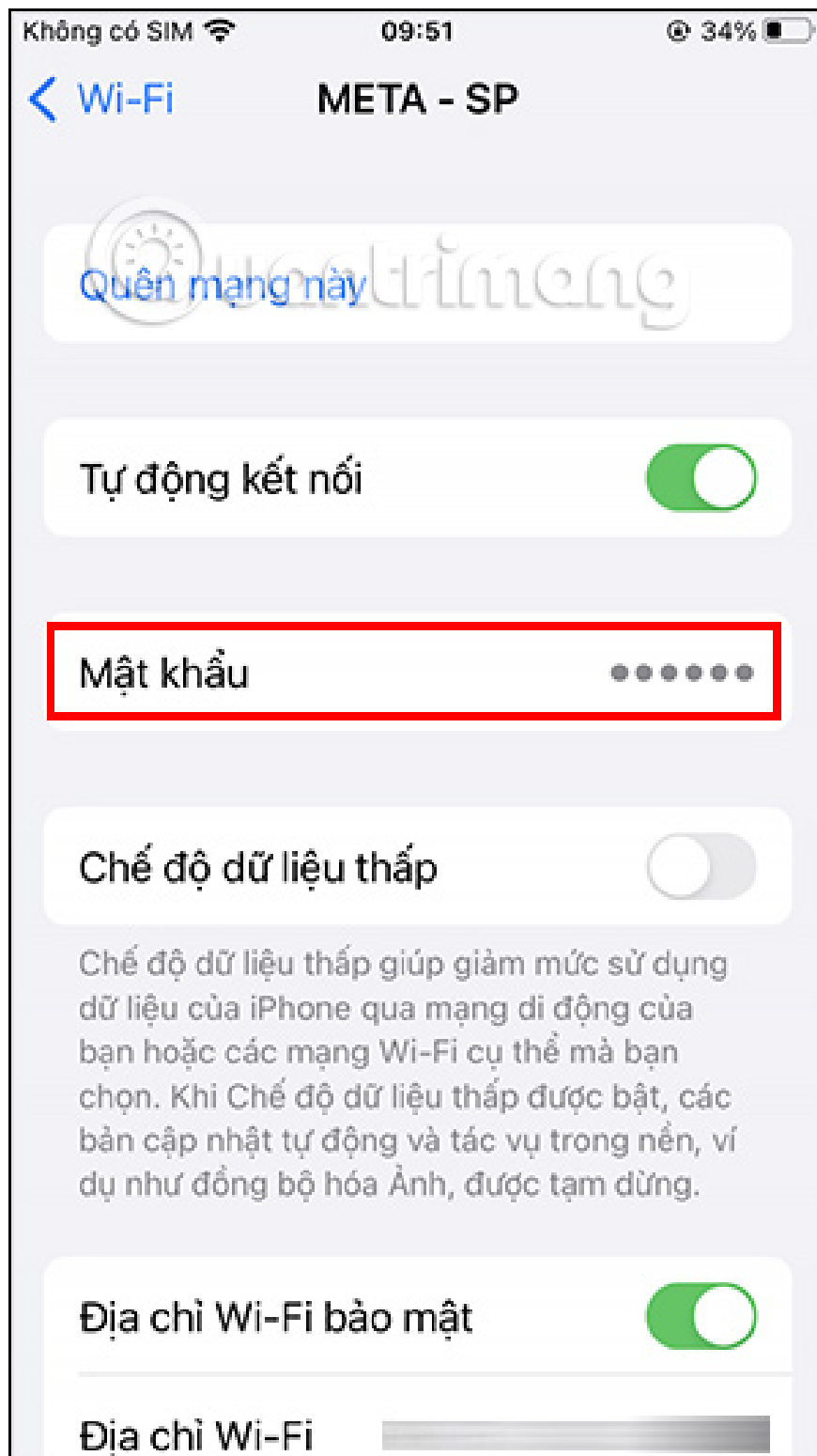
Step 3:

Next, at the WiFi network we are connecting to, click on **the i icon** to see information about this WiFi network.



Step 4:

Switch to the new interface, users will see information about this WiFi network along with information about the Password. You just need to **click on Password to see the WiFi password on the** connected iPhone.



When clicking on the WiFi password line, we will have **the Copy option to copy the password** and share the password with others.



When you tap the Password line again, the password will be changed to circular characters to hide the WiFi password string on the iPhone.
