

How will a debit card be stolen?

You usually go to the bank's automated teller machines to withdraw money. You put the card in the machine, then ... nothing could be done (nothing could be done)

You press the " *Delete* " button to retrieve the card, but the card is retained in the device

You say to yourself, " *No problem, I'll go to the Bank house and get it back tomorrow morning* "

The next day, at the Bank, someone told you, " *No sir, our cash machine doesn't swallow your card, we don't have it.* "

You call the Bank where the account is registered and . surprised to receive the notice: " *Sir, your account has been withdrawn.* "

What happened?

Explain

The thief put in an automatic teller machine a small piece of plastic



The cash card has a small piece of "vhs" tightened



With the automatic machine cannot read the card and cannot swallow the card



The thin plastic block prevents the card from being pushed back

What to do?

If you experience such a problem, look closely at the insert slot.

If you see a plastic strip (stick on both sides) in it: pull out, and get it back.

Look around, the thief is definitely not far away. If someone comes to see what happens, you must not leave the cash dispenser, because it is probably a thief and he will advise you to come home tomorrow and get the card back so he has a chance to steal the card when you leave.

In any case: if the person advises you to try pressing the battery again, don't listen.

If you suspect the cash machine has "swallowed" your card, report it to the bank immediately.

Tell your friends about this thief's trick so they know how to handle it.

Be careful with automatic teller machines!

1) Is this automatic teller machine normal?



2) Are there any additional parts?

This is a wrong part that has been added to the automatic machine (same color, same size for assembly)

This unit contains a lecher card that can copy all the information contained in the card and thus can produce the same new card that has been inserted into the device !!!



3) A screen and a box of leaflets, not unusual?



4) Is it really a leaflet box?

On the side of the box opposite the screen is a glass-mounted hole: it's a camera!



5) *The box of "leaflets" leaflets next to the screen*



Mini camera on the side of the viewfinder screen and keyboard.

Attaching a transceiver, this camera image can be played up to 200m away

6) *"Inside world" of leaflets "wacky"*

Follow the arrows from the top down:

- The camera attached to the angle of view can clearly see both the keyboard and the screen of the card dispenser
- Electronic battery
- Antenna receiver
