

How-To successfully pass IELTS: 10 tips for the perfect essay

Even if you do not like to write an essay or think that this skill you will not need in everyday life and at work, sooner or later you will meet with him.

Writing an essay is a mandatory part of all international English examinations, such as IELTS, and sometimes even the stage of the job interview.

It is not necessary to hope for intuition - in the English examination essay you may not forgive the non-structuredness, the absence of the corresponding vocabulary, and especially the injection of "water", that is, abuse of unnecessary words to increase the volume of text.

Read - write - read - write - read - write

In other words, do not start your next paragraph (paragraph) without reading the previous one. Take care of the connectivity of the text and the logic of the presentation. Try to read everything written out loud, turn it into your imaginary reader. Is it clear? Are there any questions about the author's logic?

Do not be too smart, be clear - choose the best ideas

A popular mistake of those who first write an essay in English - trying to say everything immediately. The examination text first checks your knowledge of the language, and not the overall level of intelligence. Therefore, select one or two of the clearest and understandable approval and write about them in detail, it is just an essay, not a monograph.

Write about understandable, choose the topic that best

It is not necessary to break your head over a complex and confusing theme for the essay - again, international English exams do not evaluate your IQ. The ideal option is to write about something well-known, common worldwide, but to disclose personal experience while avoiding generalizations and narrowing the topic.

Examples are more eloquent than explanations:

If you feel that they are confused in your own words, trying to reveal the essence of the chosen problem, give up explanations. In this case, accurate examples will be valuable, life situations or quotes confirming your point of view.

Do not write too much

The exam essay does not have officially limited volume, but specialists do not advise writing text in which more than 350 words.

First, the examiner allocates the same amount of time to each written job. So, the essay of 400 words will be read less carefully than 300.

Secondly, the more you write, the greater the likelihood of errors.

Thirdly, the bulk text increases your chances to deviate from the topic, and the fact that the topic does not apply to the examiner. And if you write less, you give yourself more time to choose the most accurate words, as well as more time on the self-test.

Control your typical errors

Each person knows most of his weaknesses and strengths. During self-test, remember in which words you could make a mistake, whether there were problems with punctuation and the like. Look for typical mistakes before passing the essay - there is a chance that they will not find the examiner.

Imagine holistic text even before writing it

Of course, in the process of creating an essay, it may change or edit. However, the backbone of the text should be remembered in the process of writing. So it will be harder for you to get away from the topic too far.

The first sentence of each paragraph is the most important

Essay in English requires compliance with the structure. Remember that there are three main essay genres - For & Against (for and mind), Points to Consider (problem is a solution), Opinion (special point of view). Each of these genres has its specifics, but there are general requirements for the structure.

Starting with the introduction in which you characterize the problem, provide general information about the question, without expressing your point of view. In the main part, it should be concentrated on its position on the stated problem, not forgetting the examples, quotes, facts. In the final part, it is necessary to conclude from everything written above.

The student's literacy indicator is the use of so-called Linking Words in the essay, words that make the text are connected, as well as immediately refer to the selected essay type.

Train write essay parts

Each element of the essay structure has its characteristics as stylistic, so lexical, and grammatical. It is worth learning to write separately accession, separate conclusions, separately - paragraphs. And only then to take for a holistic and connected text.

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
