

HP added 2 Envy models equipped with Ivy Bridge

The new HP Envy 4 and Envy 6 are available today with screens smaller than the previous Envy models, and will likely use Ivy Bridge chips.

Maybe two new models will be as thin as the Envy 14 Specter.

There is not much information about the detailed configuration of the Envy 4 and Envy 6 models. However, according to the HP support site, this will be two new versions of the models that have been shipped before, with smaller screen sizes.

Meanwhile, many expect that these two devices will be the latest Intel-equipped processors, Ivy Bridge. According to the official announcement from Intel, Ivy Bridge chips will be officially available in high-end laptop and desktop products from April 23.

Until now, HP has not released any official information on the launch date or the selling price of these two new computer models. Envy's "family" includes Envy 17, Envy 15 and Envy 14 Specter models.
