

# HP Chromebook 11 was withdrawn in bulk

The decision to stop selling the new generation Chromebook of HP and Google has been implemented after customers complained about the computer charger.

**The entire HP Chromebook 11 on the market has been withdrawn following the problem of overcharging the battery charger.**
