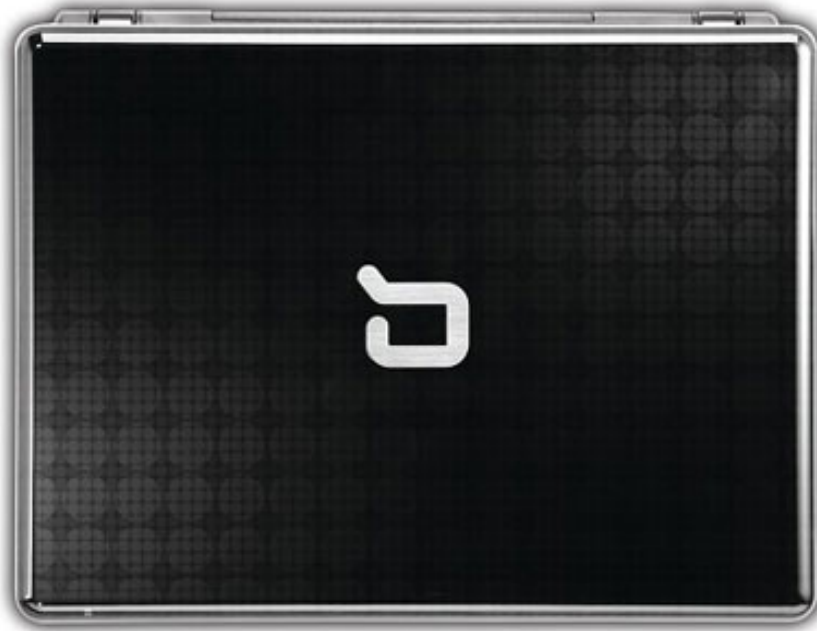

Good impression of Compaq CQ20 comes right from the product appearance, with its sleek, luxurious chassis design thanks to HP's unique Imprint sinking printing technology. In the middle of the lid is the stylized letter Q made from metal, highlighted between the black circular blocks hidden under the metal cover. Although the body is a bit thick compared to the general ground, in return, the users are fully equipped with connection ports and advanced optical drives.

A notable point in the design of this model is that the DVD burner is on the left side, along with the charger jack, Modem, Ethernet and a USB port. The right side is where two USB ports, an HDMI port, a VGA port, SD / MMC memory card reader, ExpressCard / 34 slot, heat outlet and Kensington lock lock are located. The front

edge has headphone and microphone jacks. In addition, on the top edge of the screen, CQ20 is equipped with VGA resolution webcam and two built-in microphones, good support for voice chat with images or participating in remote seminars.

Although the space for the keyboard is not as large as the large ones, the size of the keystrokes is not reduced. Instead, HP has already trimmed down four Home, PgUp, PgDn, and End keys that are often lined up along the edge of the edge to "insert" into the upper row of keys. Therefore, the F1 to F12 keys and ESC, PgUp, PgDn, Home, End, Insert, and Delete keys in this machine are quite small, crowded together in the top row.

The Compaq CQ20's touchpad and touchpad (touchpad) is metal-coated like the Pavilion dv series. It has just contributed to increasing the elegance and sleekness of the machine, while bringing comfort and responsive response when users use the touchpad. Above the keyboard, HP equips Compaq CQ20 with an impressive range of touch keys to activate the media function, turn on and off the wireless connection, turn on and off (mute) and increase or decrease the volume.

Configuration of this model is quite good, with Intel Core 2 Duo T5800 2.0 GHz processor, 1 GB RAM and 160 GB hard drive. CQ20 is built on the fourth generation Intel GM45 chipset, integrated with Intel GMA 4500MHD graphics card, allowing it to run smoothly when processing 3D geometric commands, watching high definition movies or playing games. During the trial, the machine supports watching DVD movies stable with image quality, sound quite impressive.

Like the new HP laptops, Compaq CQ20 is also equipped with 3D DriveGuard hard drive shockproof technology, which helps to ensure data safety in collision situations. Besides the advanced LightScribe direct disc labeling function, however, this function is only available with discs that are pre-coated with a disc burning material. In addition, the keyboard of this machine also has the ability to resist water spills, while the case can prevent scratches during use.

HP Compaq CQ20 has dimensions of 22.6 x 29.4 x 2.8 cm, weighs 1.65 kg. It uses 4-cell battery that can operate continuously for more than 3 hours. The price of this machine on the market today is 849 USD (excluding VAT).
