The new Funlove virus was discovered last week hidden in a device driver software downloaded via HP's FTP server. BitDefender informed HP about the return of the virus.

The business is a testament to the unusual existence of files infected with malware, "said Bogdan Dumitru, chief technology engineer at BitDefender.

The Funlove virus aims to gain administrator-level access on Windows NT systems to grant remote access, read and edit files on the infected system every time the user logs on. system. Funlove can infect Windows 9x / ME / 2000 systems.

HP has no official comment on this event.
