The Firefly computer with two monitors has a rather special feature that HP has borrowed from the Voodoo Envy 133: the multi-touch trackpad (multi touch) is placed in an unusual position, not in front of the keyboard. again on the right - making it more convenient for users. This touchpad supports more complex 'commands', like pinch to zoom, scroll .

Imitating from Fujitsu's LifeBook N7010 series, the Firefly also has a 4.3-inch, 4.3-inch wide screen with

800x480 resolution to use for IM chat and other simple tasks without interrupting when users are watching movies. , gaming; and also to save space on the computer screen's toolbar.

The Firefly PC is powered by a massive configuration of gaming laptops, using a quad-core 2.4GHz Core 2 Extreme processor, two Mobility Radeon HD 3870 graphics cards. In addition, it has a 7,200RPM hard drive. 250GB. 4GB RAM.

HP has not yet planned to produce Firefly, though it is still known as a leader in multi-touch screen laptops; and also the famous 'giant' when successfully turning technologies from ideas into reality.
