HP released a total of 3 new models including **Zbook 14**, **Zbook 15** and **Zbook 17**. Of these, **Zbook 14** is "*ultrabook standard workstation*" thanks to its thinness. This promises to be a formidable rival to Dell's **Precision M3800** . Meanwhile, the **Zbook 15** model has a "*terrible*" screen resolution option *of* up to 3200x1800 pixels. And **Zbook 17** is the most advanced model. Both 15 and 17 inch versions are equipped with Intel's high-speed Thunderbolt port.



Three new HP workstations will be equipped with Haswell processor, the latest graphics card from AMD and Nvidia. Zbook 15 and 17 are now pre-ordered, while Zbook 14 will be sold by the **end of October** .

In addition to mobile workstations, HP also upgraded its Z-series to its Ivy Bridge Xeon chip and Thunderbolt 2 port.
