In September, at a fashion show by Vivienne Tam, HP made a big splash when it introduced a red 10-inch netbook that was stylized with colorful veins. This is a product designed by Vivienne Tam itself, which should be named HP Vivienne Tam Edition. However, HP did not publish any further information regarding this model.

It is not until this week that the world's largest computer maker officially acknowledges that Vivienne Tam's collaborative netbook model is real, in production and will be available in December, just in time Join the shopping season at the end of the year. HP has also unveiled a separate advertising website for this model, along with the Pavilion dv4t laptop and the all-in-one computer that uses the TouchSmart IQ506 touch screen.

Instead of using the VIA C7-M processor like the Mini-Note, the HP Vivienne Tam Edition Netbook will be equipped with an Intel Atom processor of 1.6 GHz, a 10-inch screen. If you install the Windows XP operating system, this machine will only have a maximum RAM of 1 GB, a maximum hard drive of 160 GB, according to

Microsoft's new regulations. However, until December, when HP officially announced this product, new consumers could know exactly the configuration and price of the device.
