With advantages like Therefore, it does not take too long for China's largest technology group to dominate the market and climb to the position of the world's second largest smartphone manufacturer.

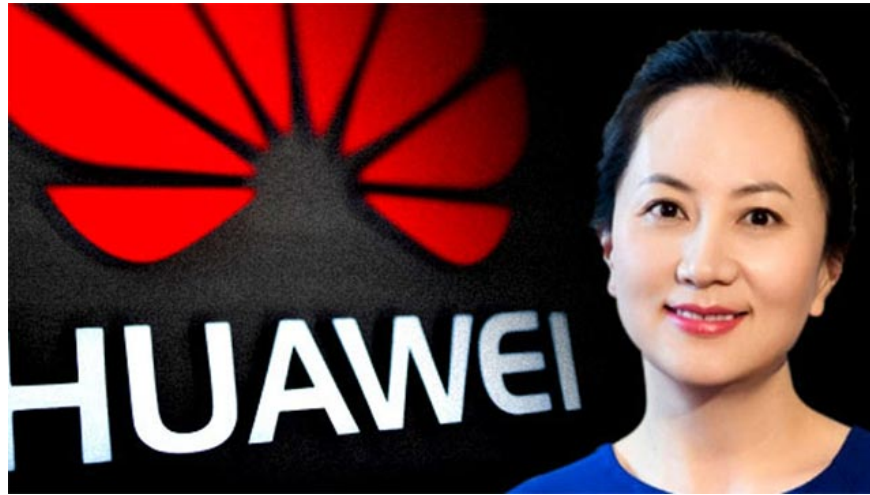


In addition to smart phones, Huawei is also a true 'bug' in the telecommunications industry as one of the top mobile network equipment providers for the world's largest global telecommunications companies. gender, beating many other big names that are decades old in the industry, and it is this business that makes them fall into the sights of US officials. With the accusation of a spy for the Chinese government, as well as a threat to national security, Huawei has occupied an 'important position' on the blacklist of commercial corporations banned from operating in the United States. And this decision has also received a 'enthusiastic' response from many other billion-dollar technology corporations such as Qualcomm, Google, Broadcom, or Intel . pushing Huawei into a situation that may be difficult. The most towel in the company's more than 30-year history, at the same time escalating the tension in the US-China trade war to its peak.

However, the CEO's counterattack until now is only in the media aspect. His daughter, Ms. Manh Van Chau, was also arrested in Canada alleging violations of US sanctions against Iran. The arrest of Manh Van Chau has caused foreign media to pay attention to Huawei. Ms. Manh is not only the Chief Financial Officer of Huawei but also the 'female lover', the right hand of Nham Chinh Phi. Difficulties pile up with Chinese technology tycoon.

With an estimated 'only' asset worth about 3.2 billion dollars, it is not possible to reach the top richest people in China. However, this man has a position that cannot be underestimated in not only technology, but also in Beijing politics.

Nham Chinh Phi is an extremely secretive person about personal life. According to the press, Mr. Nham has been married twice, has both boys and girls, and of course not all of them also live a peaceful life. This is the youngest daughter, Annabel Yao, who just appeared in a luxury party in Paris (France) in November 2018:



Huawei founder Nham Chinh Phi was born in 1944, before the cultural reform in China took place.



Where he lived throughout his childhood, Guizhou, was the poorest province in the country. In 2015, Nham Chinh Phi replied to the BBC that he came from a basic family, but was sometimes considered wealthy only because 'his family is one of the few households with salt to cook daily'.

In a 2019 interview with Chinese media, the CEO said, "I am nobody. I have nothing but good academic achievement. My family is poor and my father is just a mean man. usually '. Perhaps so, Nham Chinh Phi has always been considered a shining example of the hardship of many generations of Chinese people today.



After finishing high school, Nham Chinh Phi passed the Chongqing University around the 1960s and later joined the Chinese Liberation Army Research Institute (PLA) when he was just 30 years old. The period of service in the military environment is the cause of doubts about the 'above-average' relationship between him and the Chinese government. Mr. Nham has also repeatedly denied and harshly criticized him for accusing him and his company of spying for the government.



Nham Chinh Phi shared with Chinese media that he was married twice. There is very little information about his first wife, in addition to the woman named Manh Quan, from a high-ranking official family. Nham Chinh Phi's father-in-law is Manh Dong Ba - a former senior official of Sichuan province. Besides, Mr. Nham also revealed his first wife was a "genuine" Red Guards, even holding the position of political commissioner of the Red Guards - a voluntary paramilitary movement of the house. leader of Mao Zedong. Perhaps because of this reason, Nham Chinh Phi once described his first wife as a "dry and difficult person".

After marriage, two people have a son and a daughter together. Nham's first daughter, Manh Van Chau, was born in 1970 and his son Nham Binh. Manh Van Chau, another name is Sabrina or Cathy Men. The reason why

she did not bring the surname Manh was because Nham Chinh Phi was greatly affected by her father-in-law, he also learned some precious spirits from his father-in-law, so he decided to let his daughter bring his wife's family name . However, Manh Van Chau said that this name was due to changing her self at age 16, and changing her mother's surname. Ms. Manh graduated from Hoa Trung University of Science and Technology with a Master's degree. In 1993, she started working at Huawei. In 2011, Manh Van Chau took up the position of Chief Financial Officer (CFO), and President of Huawei. It is worth mentioning that the strength of the strong grandmother has been completely hidden for more than 20 years. Public opinion is completely unaware of her family status, no one talks about the connection between Manh Van Chau and Nham Chinh Phi, because after all these two people have different families. Until 2013, information about Manh Van Chau's daughter Nham Chinh Phi was revealed for the first time and made the Chinese media wary. Ms. Manh is described as a 'strong and assertive' woman. Huawei's CFO was arrested in Canada on December 1 last year with the alleged claim.



Meanwhile, there is little information about Nham Chinh Phi's son with his wife, except that this man named Nham Binh is working for a subsidiary of Huawei and seems to be 'not interested in the inheritance of the huge fortune and fortune left by his father ' .



The main reason given by Washington authorities for the decision to arrest Ms. Manh Van Chau is nothing but accusing the woman of being involved in covering up the cooperative relationships between Huawei and another company, selling Huawei products to Iran - the country is subject to sanctions from the US. Chinese officials immediately reacted harshly, demanding that Canada release Ms. Manh and the United States to withdraw the arrest warrant, calling it a "violation of human rights".



Nham Chinh Phi recently revealed that he has two more children while serving the Chinese army. However, due to work, he was only allowed to meet his son every few months.

Renewing Africa ended his military service in 1983 at age 39 (according to his widely known background). Move to live in Shenzhen and work in electronics. 4 years later, in 1987, he founded Huawei, with an initial capital of only 21,000 RMB, equivalent to about 5,000 USD at that time.



Nham Chinh Phi's children are still relatively young, and he wants them to work and contribute more to the overall development of the company. The CEO once shared with Chinese media in 2019: 'To participate in the international market and prove that Huawei's success is not due to corruption, I have been working together in the country. after a few months, and very rarely contact children. 'However, Nham Chinh Phi said he was not a strict person for his children, and especially respected their choices.



Under the table, we steered Nham Chinh Phi and other family members, Huawei quickly rose to become the most valuable electronic brand in China many years ago, and brought him \$ 3.2 billion of assets.

Nham Chinh Phi divorced his first wife after 20 years of marriage and remarried the woman named Dieu Lang shortly after founding Huawei. Yuyao is described as 'gentle and considerate'. According to family tradition, she always tries to avoid communication to the maximum extent. Yuyao was only exposed for the first time to the public after appearing in photographs of luxury life taken by the French magazine Paris Match in 2018.



The two together have a daughter named Annabel Yao. Looking at Instagram account, it can be seen that Annabel Yao loves fashion.



The 21-year-old daughter of Nham Chinh Phi has lived the life of a "great lady" literally since birth. Born "sucked gold spoon, money is not a thought", but Annabel Yao did not "play and claim" like many warm boys, and she taught other "rich binary" in China. She is currently studying computer science at the prestigious Harvard University, has a burning passion for ballet and fashion. Nham Chinh Phi has repeatedly praised his youngest daughter who is 'extremely hardworking and eager to learn'. He said Annabel often learned to dance 15 hours a week while at school, and would then do homework until late at night.



Perhaps Annabel Yao is the true "lover" of Nham Chinh Phi, not Manh Manh Chau. The 75-year-old CEO, who has a great deal of interest in his youngest daughter, spends a lot of time 'showing off' about her during interviews, even agreeing to an intimate family photo shoot with Paris Match magazine (featuring Annabel Yao's face), which is very rare for someone who is always tight-lipped about family matters like Nham Chinh Phi.



Just before his half-sister was arrested and arrested, Yao attended a high-class fashion party in Paris called Le Bal des Débutantes.



This is a party that often features 'daughters, ladies' in the super rich world and famous names in the global entertainment industry. Many guests have appeared in Le Bal des Débutantes coming from families of "noble families" in China.

Not only his personal life, Nham's 'spending money' is not as widely known as many other billionaires. Only once was the case of Huawei's owner appearing in public, it was in an article on Paris Match in 2018. The family

of Nham Chinh Phi lived in a "castle" located in Shenzhen, okay. Built to host Huawei, with all the comforts and luxuries that only appear in movies. In this recording, Annabel Yao has repeatedly succeeded in convincing her father to pose in front of the camera - something Mr. Nham rarely accepted.



Responding to the 'strange' decision in an informal interview, the CEO said: 'When Annabel came up with the idea of ??a family photo shoot, I was the first to support and allow her. They upload those photos online. Annabel's mother thought that I would refuse this request, but I did not. Rather, I could not and did not want to refuse. Throughout my life, I owe my children too much, and the only thing I can do now is to take time to make up for them. Because of that, I always support my daughter in every decision, so that she can focus on learning and mastering her own destiny. '



Chinese media are now rumored to be rumored to be married for the third time to a former assistant named Su Wei. However, in the most recent interviews, the 75-year-old CEO affirmed that Yuyao is his current and only wife.

Although saying that she wants to ease her relationship to make up for her children, Nham Chinh Phi has repeatedly expressed her dissatisfaction with the direction and some decisions that her first two children have chosen. He thinks that running Huawei needs decisive thinking, long-term determination and vision, and "none of my family members have the right qualities to lead Huawei in the future, because so, they will never be on the inheritance list.



However, it seems that the eldest son Manh Van Chau is proving his father was wrong. The advancement and contributions she made at Huawei are clear evidence for that. Manh Van joined Huawei in 1993 and took only 18 years to rise to the position of Chief Financial Officer - one of the nuclear positions, playing an extremely important role in the operation of the technology giant. this giant. At the same time, she is also the replacement of Mr. Nham as Vice Chairman of the company in March 2018. If you do not possess true talent, even if it is the daughter of the head, Manh Van Chau might not be able to hold on to such important positions.



Like his father, Manh Van Chau lived quite closedly and therefore, not many people knew about her private life. The vice president of Huawei's family is said to own a magnificent mansion in British Vancouver, Canada. According to local press, Manh has 2 children.



The arrest of Manh Van Chau caused international tension to culminate between the United States and China, and created an unprecedented outcry in the world's most populous country, requiring Canada to release fellow people. when the US side had to withdraw the arrest warrant. For its part, Chinese officials said all the upcoming measures would depend on US actions as well as warn Canada that "serious consequences will be taken for this wrong action."



1. Huawei will invest another \$ 2 billion in network security in the future

Manh Van Chau has appeared several times in courts in Canada and is at risk of being extradited to the United States. At court, Ms. Manh's lawyer revealed that her client had some serious health problems, including hypertension, digestive disorders and chronic insomnia.



Ms. Manh wrote to 188,000 Huawei employees, telling them that she was fine. Manh Van Chau wrote in the letter: "My inner mind has never felt so peaceful and so steadfast."

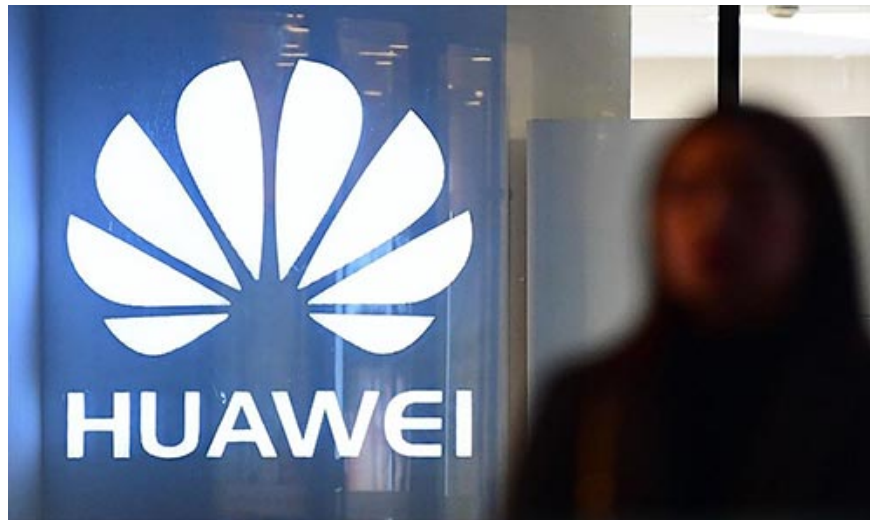

'We have accepted the sacrifice of personal and family interests to come to a unified common ideal, which is to make Huawei the world's leading corporation. To achieve this ideal, the conflict with the US is only sooner or later,' Nham said in a press release. When asked about the anticipation of a crisis that has never ended with Huawei, Nham Chinh Phi said that it is the head of the white house who is responsible for answering this question.

So it can be seen that the war between the US and China and the difficulties that Huawei faces will not soon end soon. This will be an important test and is particularly powerful for Nham Chinh Phi and his company. If Huawei can overcome it, it is undoubtedly worthy of the position of the challenger of the technology world. Let's wait and see!
