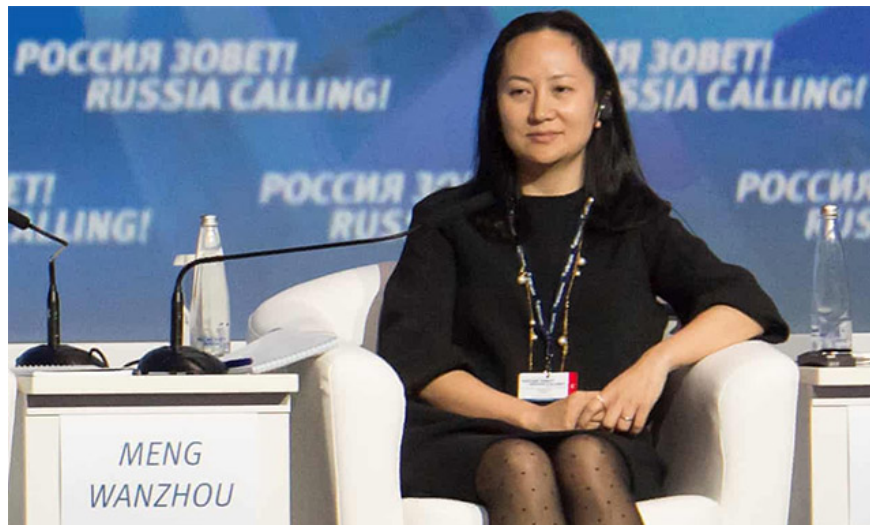


## Huawei will invest another \$ 2 billion in network security in the future

Currently, it seems that the United States is Huawei's biggest 'enemy'. It all still depends on the views of the United States and its allies, but investing in network security is certainly a smart and necessary step for Huawei at this time.
