Accordingly, the incident was discovered just off the southern coast of Aland island, the Baltic Sea discovered by explorer Jerry Wilhelmsson and his team of colleagues during the mission.

' *When I dive to this position, in front of my eyes is a ship wrecked for 27 meters, still anchored. And especially the discovery of hundreds of bottles in the package has not yet been opened,* 'said explorer Jerry Wilhelmsson in a statement.

' *It is one of those shipwrecks that rarely keeps intact undersea cargo* ' - The expedition shared with the Local site.

According to marine archaeologist Marcus Lindholm, this is a relatively small **commercial ship** that can be operated around 1850-1870.

Now the expedition team has reported this incident to the local authorities and they are granted the right to open **mysterious bottles** on this ship. The team will work with archaeologists to analyze the water in the boys and will provide the latest information in the near future. And this is a very important clue to find out where the

origin of the ship comes from.

Earlier, in April 2016, a 1600-year-old shipwreck was found in central Stockholm next to Skeppsholmen Island. Then in July 2016, a 340-year-old Kroman royal ship was also found in the waters near the island of Baltic Öland.
