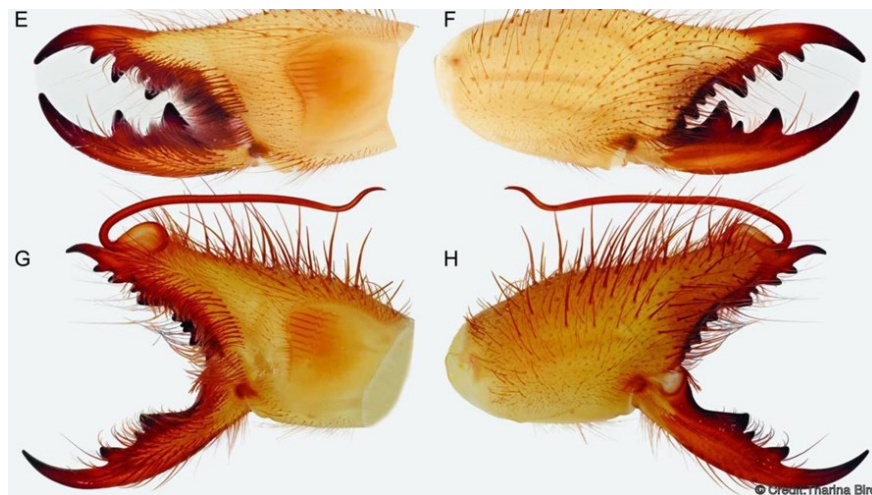

Camel camels are creatures with relatives of both scorpions and spiders, living mainly in the desert.



Although they are called camel spiders and are classified as spiders, they are not really spiders that reside in the scorpion and are also known as wind scorpions.



Their musculoskeletal system has a structure similar to that of a scorpion but has no tail and is shaped like a spider.



They are organisms with the largest set of jaws in body proportions.



With body size up to 15cm, camel spider is also called the giant spider.



Camel scorpions are capable of moving very fast, reaching speeds of 50 km / h and can jump to a height of 2m. They are horrors to every animal in the desert.



Camel scorpions often hunt prey alone at night and seasonally.



This creature has a more scorpion-like prey than a spider. They use sharp teeth like crabs and knives to attack prey. Favorite food of camel spider is insects, rodents, snakes and small birds.



When moving, scorpion spiders emit different sounds to distract enemies and prey.



The camel spider does not have venom, but this frighteningly spider species can take down large animals with one bite.

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
