He also said Apple was "very sorry" to those who thought they had other motives.

Later, Apple launched an old battery replacement program on iPhone 6, 6S, 7, 6 Plus, 6S Plus, 7 Plus and SE for \$ 29 until the end of 2018. They will also offer a battery management feature. more results in the upcoming iOS update, allowing customers to turn this feature off if desired.

'In next month's developer release, we will show users the battery status in use. So it will be very clear. We have never done it before, but after all, we also learned the lesson. We will make it clear to reduce the machine speed to avoid unexpected restart. If you don't want to, you can turn it off. '
