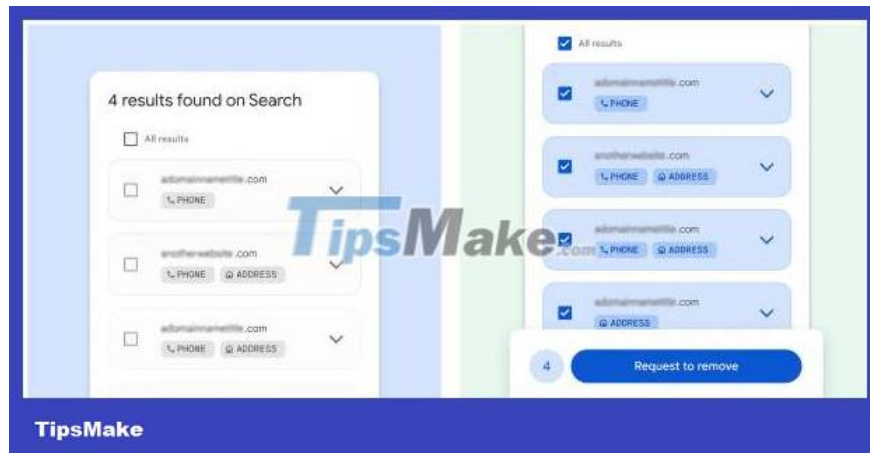

It's worth noting that Google doesn't remove your personal information from the internet, but it does scrub it from Google Search and make it difficult for others to find it. This raises questions about the security of personal data on the internet and how we can protect ourselves from unwanted publicity. Please follow the instructions below to try it out.

How to delete your personal information on Google



1. **Step 1:** Make sure you're signed in to your Google account.
2. **Step 2:** Open a web browser and type the address myactivity.google.com/results-about-you .
3. **Step 3:** Select "Results to review - Results to review"
4. **Step 4:** Click "Get started" and continue by clicking "Next" twice.
5. **Step 5:** Add your personal information, including name, address, phone number and email. You can add multiple entries for each type of information.
6. **Step 6:** Confirm that this is all your personal information.
7. **Step 7:** Choose how you want to receive notifications. You can choose email, push notifications, or both.
8. **Step 8:** Finally, you will receive a notification saying "We're taking a look"
9. **Step 9:** Now, you just need to wait for the notification from Google. When you receive a notification, you can choose to have Google remove it from search results or decide to keep it. The decision is in your hands.

Note: Currently this tool is not supported in our Vietnam region, so this is only information for users' reference.

That's the whole process! Now, you can feel more secure about protecting your personal information on Google.
