

# Impressive mod Ray-Traced Half-Life 1

This mod was created by modder Sultim\_T to help the original Half Life increase the game's light stats by 10x, you may also notice that Gordon can now also look in the mirror and see his image.

Half-Life 1 is one of the most loved first-person shooter games on PC ever. This is an FPS game associated with the childhood of many people, especially the 9x and 8x generations.

But for current young players, low graphics may not be attractive to players who prefer current top graphics games like Atomic Heart, Son of the Forest, Resident Evil Remake or even Half Life Alyx itself.

For those who have experienced **Half Life Alyx** may know some versions of Half Life 1 and Half Life 2. However, for those who love a top-notch graphics background, Half Life 1 and 2 will certainly not be attractive. players, with the exception of the Black Mesa version.

Therefore, modder Sultim\_T has created a mod that adds Ray Tracing to the game and it is definitely worth it for those who have experienced Half Life 1 to feel excited.

And even for players who have never played through Half Life, if you have never seen the Ray Tracing feature in classic games like this. Basically, this feature will replace the built-in lighting in games with dynamic light rays. It helps to significantly transform the image of the game. You can see the difference in the trailer for the Ray Tracing Half Life 1 mod. Heavy weapons like the Gluon Gun and Tau Cannon are also visually upgraded.

The author of your mod doesn't go into detail on how they made a mod or a machine that you can handle this level of graphics well. But you will at least need a graphics card that can handle Ray Tracing, which means an RTX 20 series or AMD 6000 series graphics card. Alternatively, you can simply download the .zip file on the author's GitHub page fake the mod and copy it to your Half Life folder, run xash3d.exe and voila.
