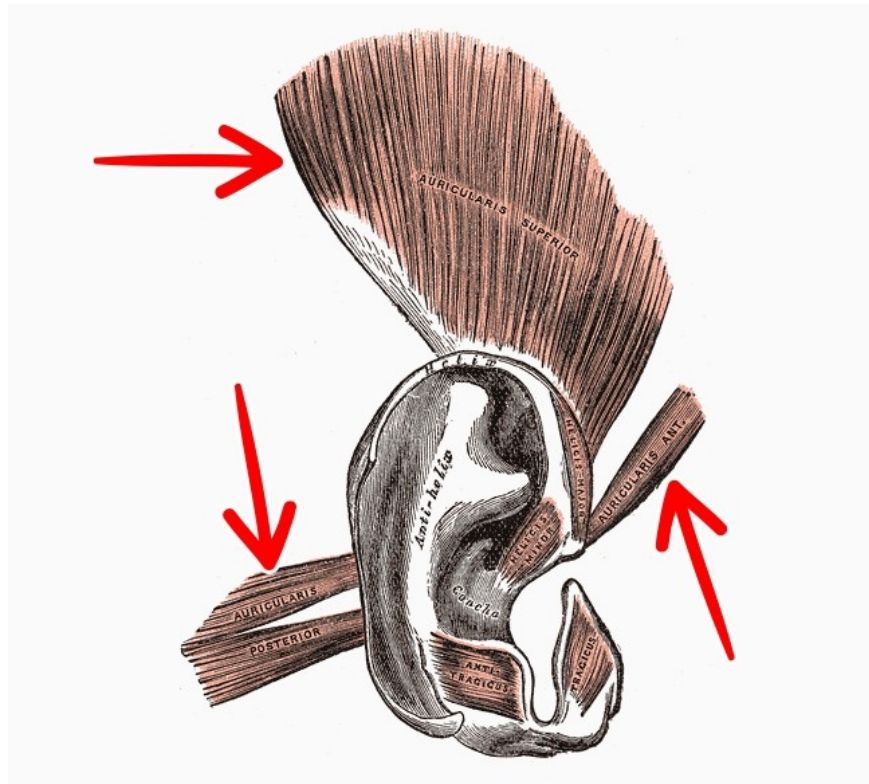
1. Hair / hair

The ear muscle Auriculares is the outer part of the ear, has a rotating function, adjusts the ear to focus the hearing on the location of the particular sound.

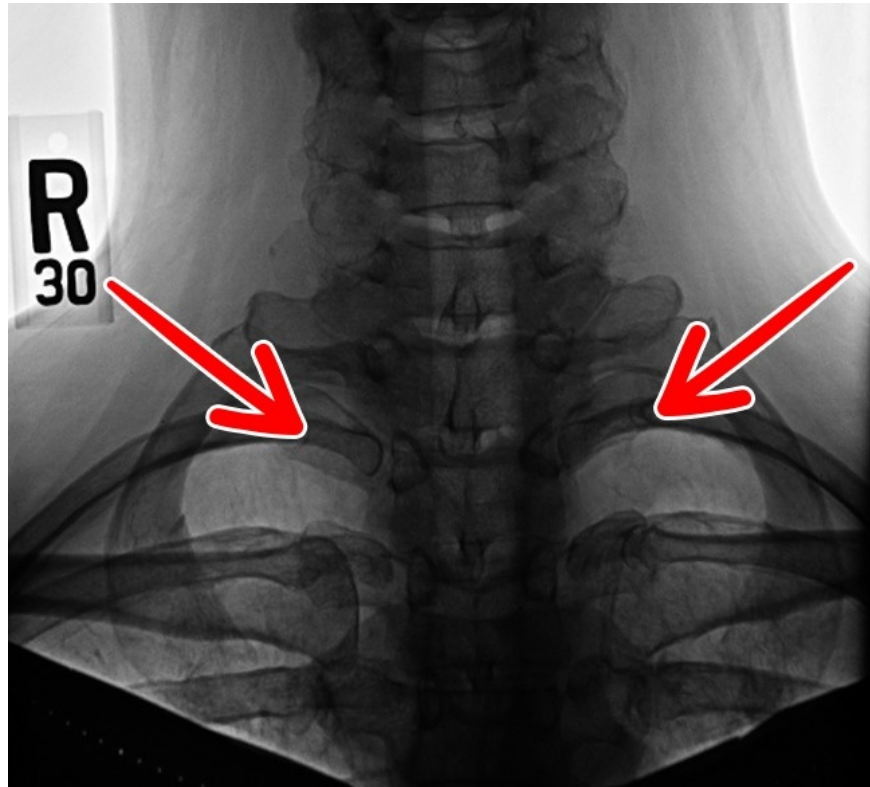

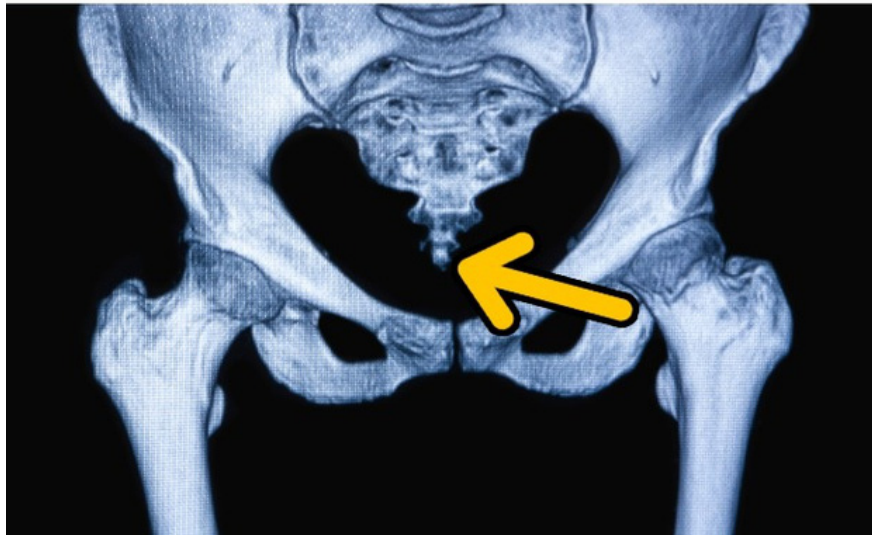
5. The number of toes is reduced
