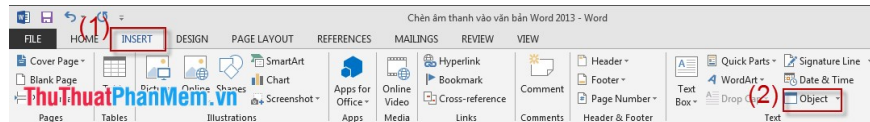


Insert audio into Word documents

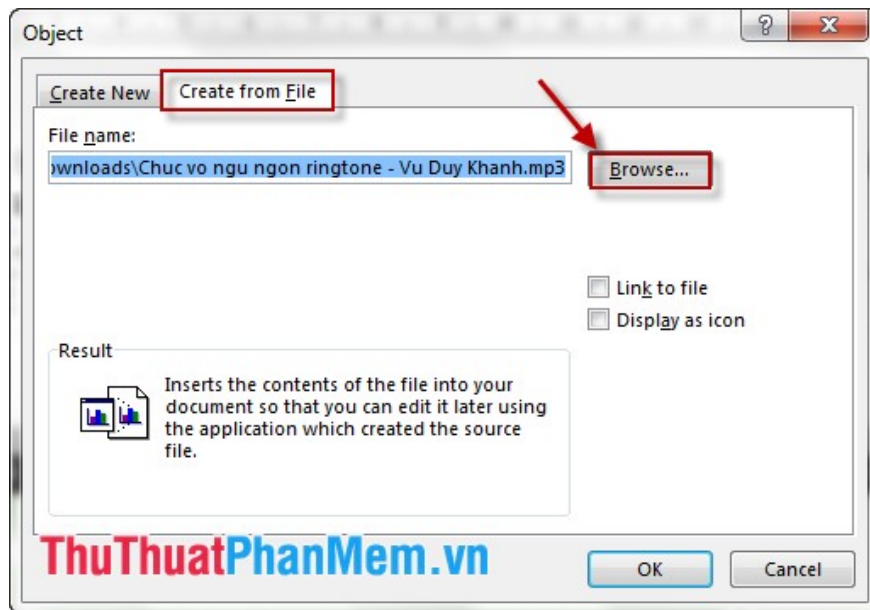
If you want your presentation to be more lively, to attract readers or you want to make specific sound proofs, you can add sound to your text, if you do not know how to follow, follow the article. down here.

Sometimes you want your presentation to be more lively, to attract readers or you want to provide specific audio proof that you can add sound to your text. The operation is very simple but very good effect.

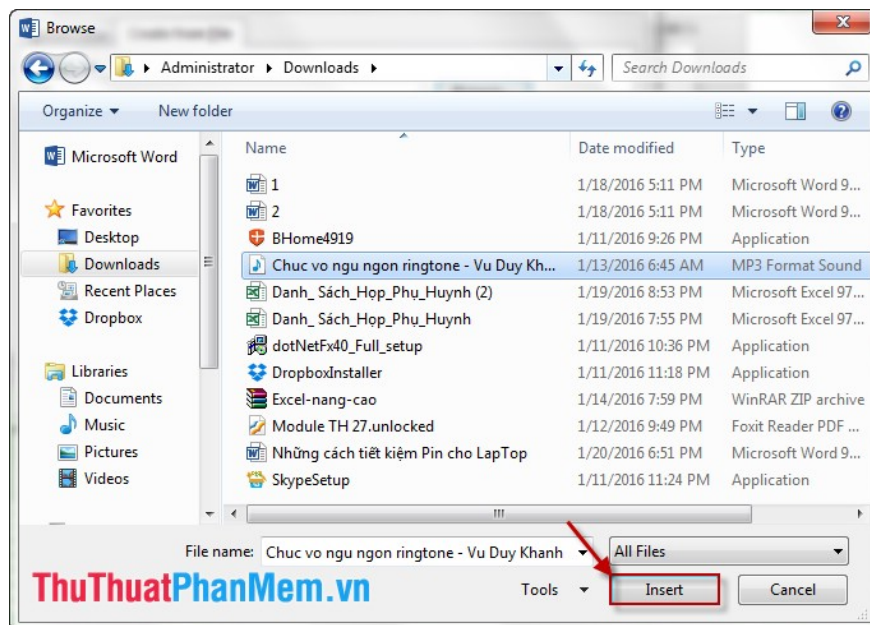
Step 1: Click the **Insert** tab -> **Object** .



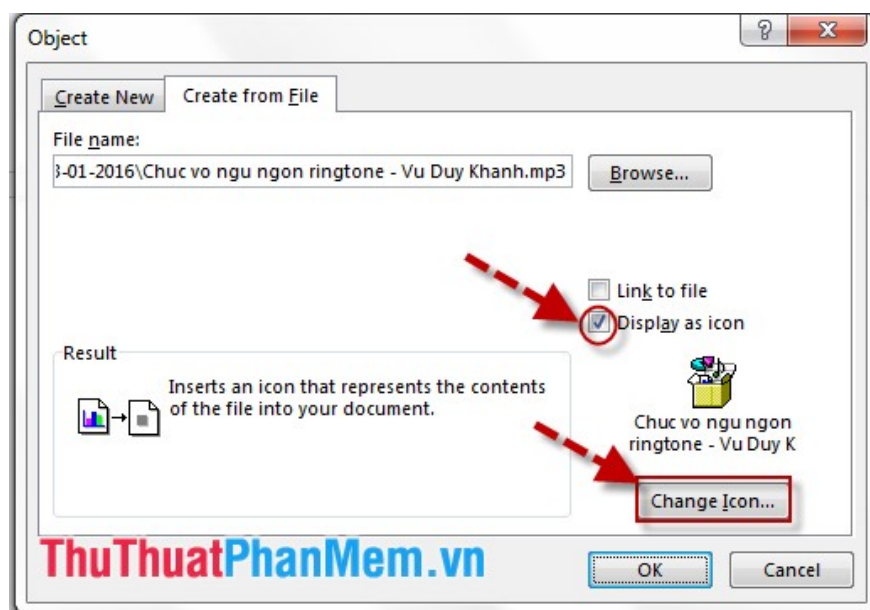
Step 2: The **Object** dialog box appears, select the **Create From File** tab , **File name** -> **Browse**, select the path to the music file to insert.



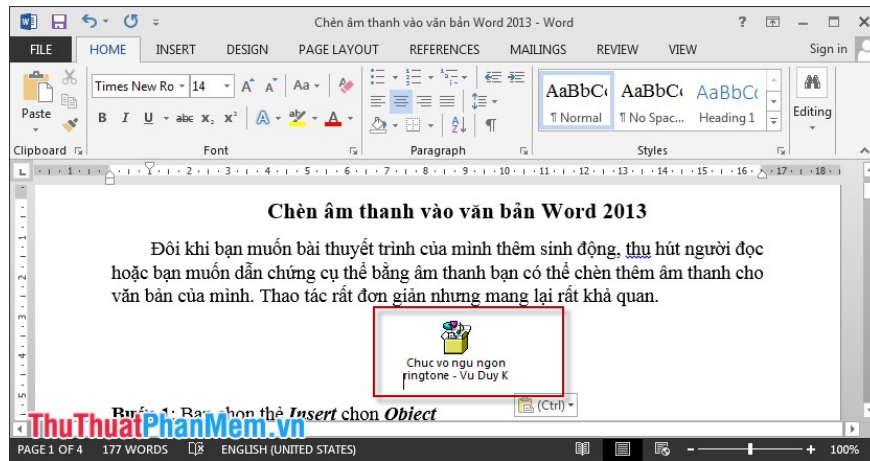
Step 3: **Browse** dialog box appears -> select the **file** to be inserted -> **Insert** .



- You can change the icon displaying music files by clicking **Change Icon** .



- After selecting **OK** , the result:
