

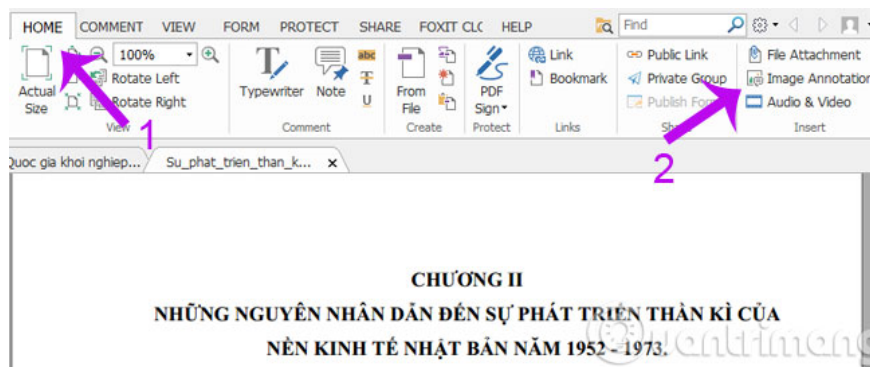

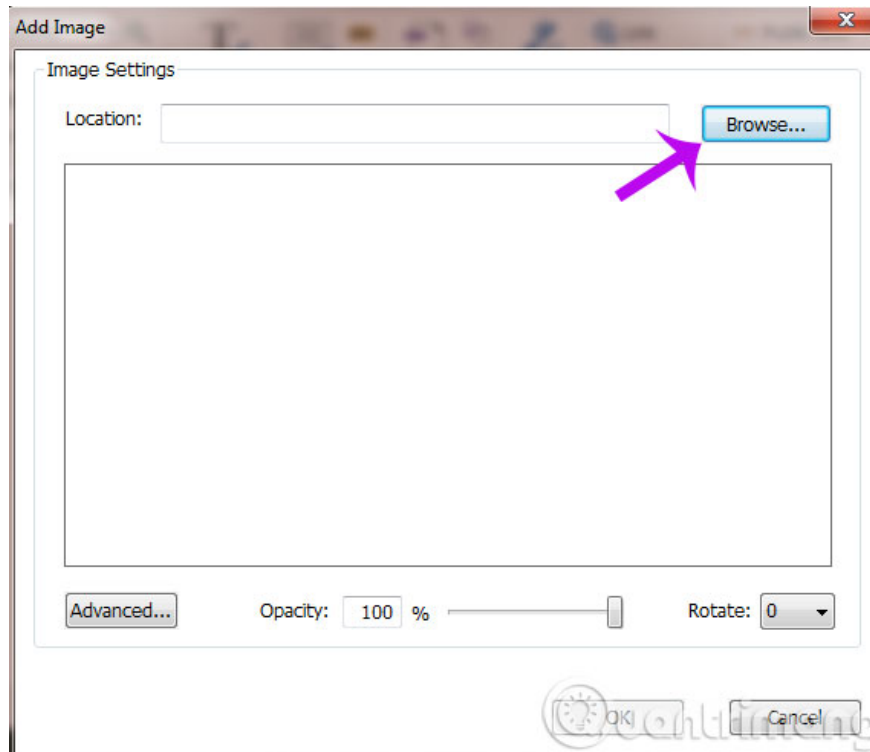

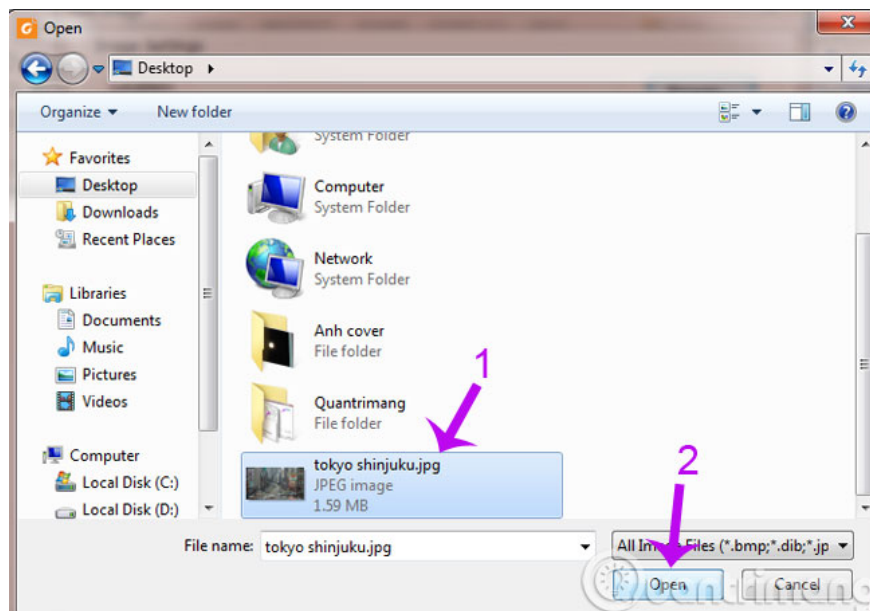
Step 1 : Open Foxit Reader, click on the **Home** tab, select **Image Annotation** .



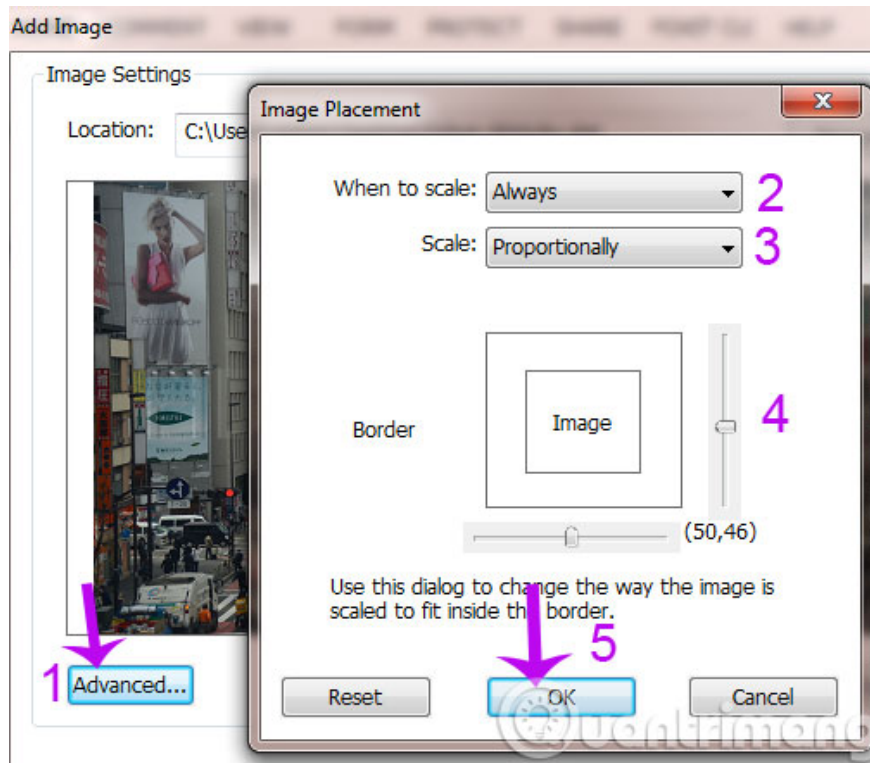
Step 2 : Move the mouse to the position where you want to insert the image, circle the place where the image will appear, and then the **Add Image** window will immediately appear, click **Browse** .



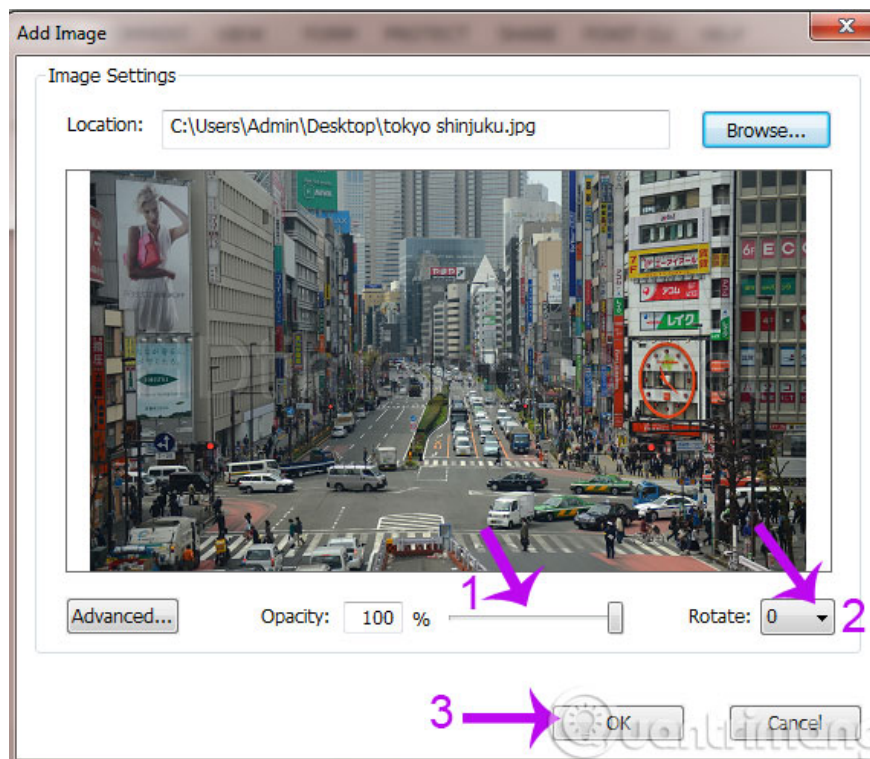
Step 3 : **Open** window appears, select the image to insert, click **Open** to open the image.



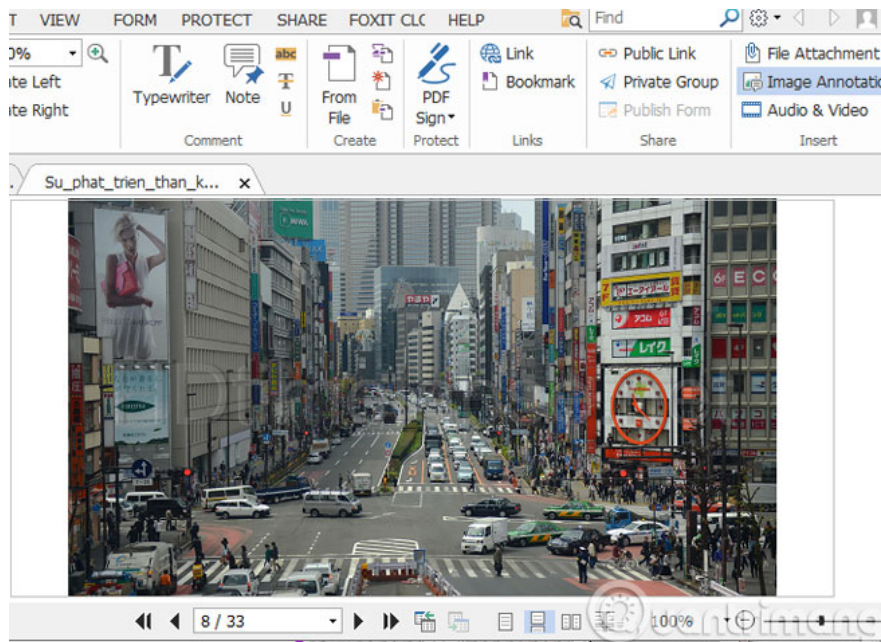
Step 4 : Click **Advanced .** to adjust the image position, **Image Placement** window appears, you can customize the border size, position the image, then click **OK** :



Step 5 : Customize the image definition in the **Opacity** section, rotate the image in the **Rotate** section. After customizing, click **OK** .
