

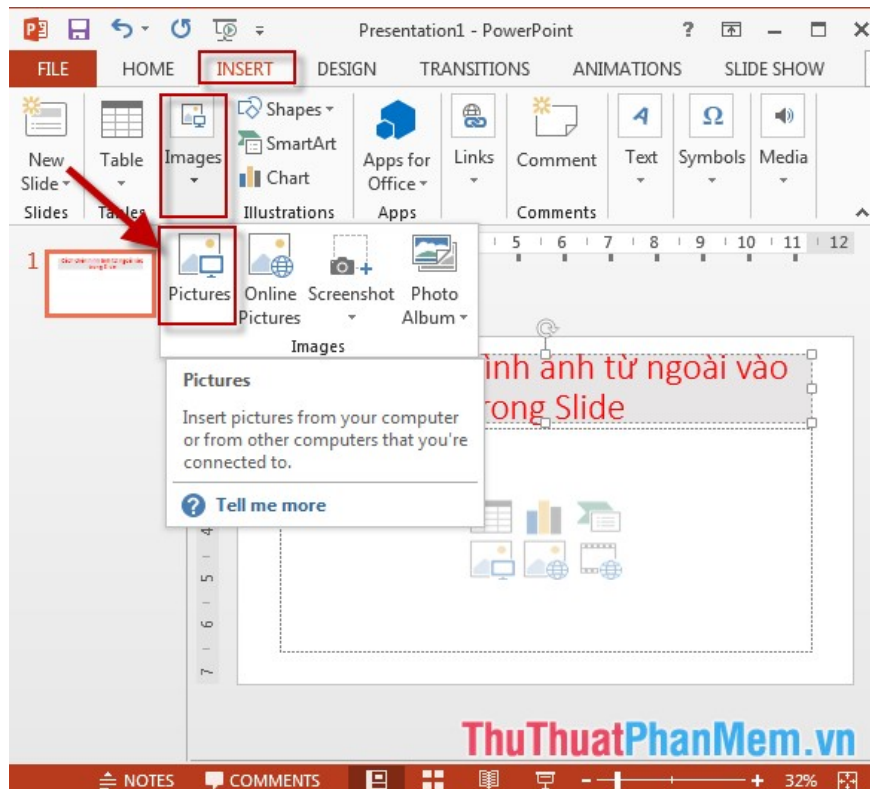
# Insert images into Slide in PowerPoint

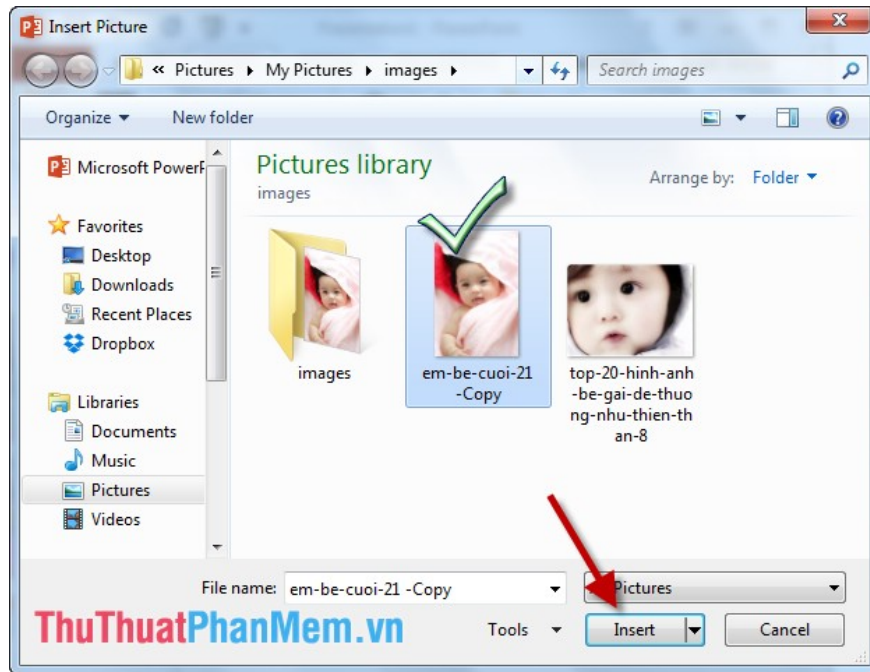
The following article introduces you in detail how to insert images from outside to Slide in PowerPoint.

**Step 2: A dialog box appears that selects the image to insert -> click Insert:**

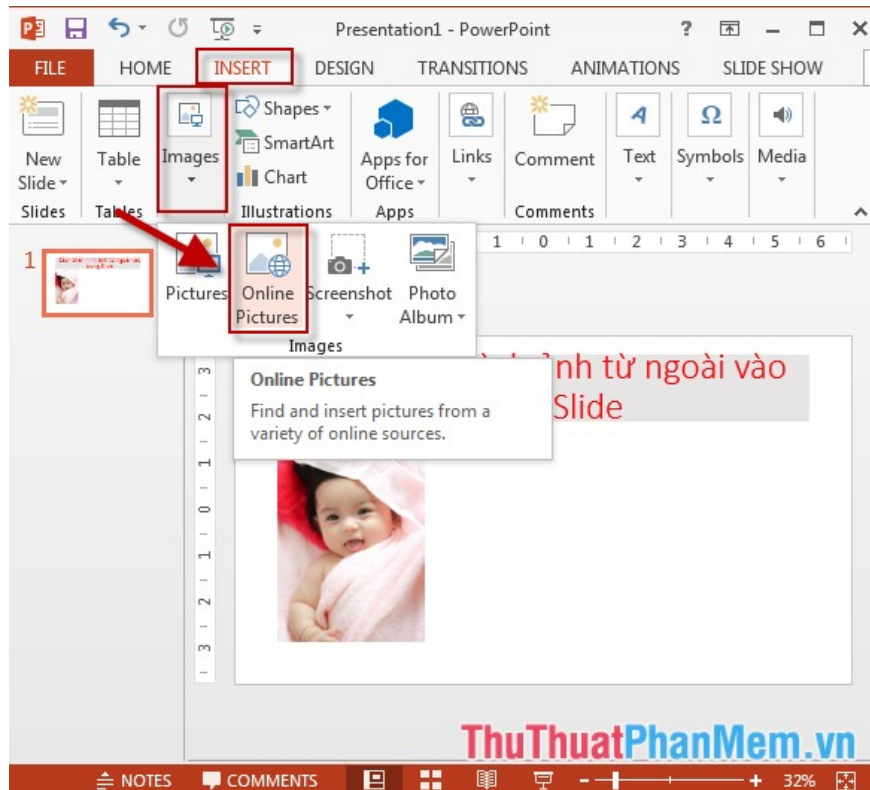


**Step 3:** After inserting, move the image to the position to insert -> the result:

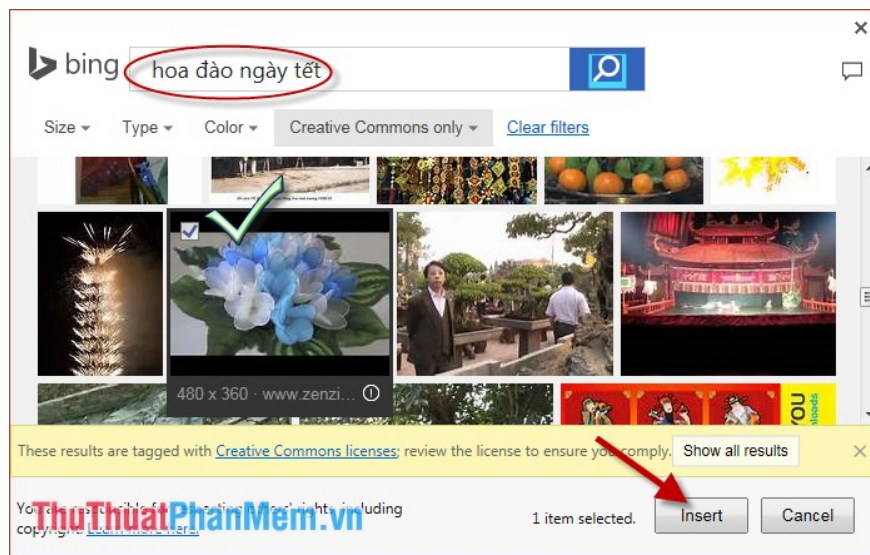


## 2. Insert a word search image online.

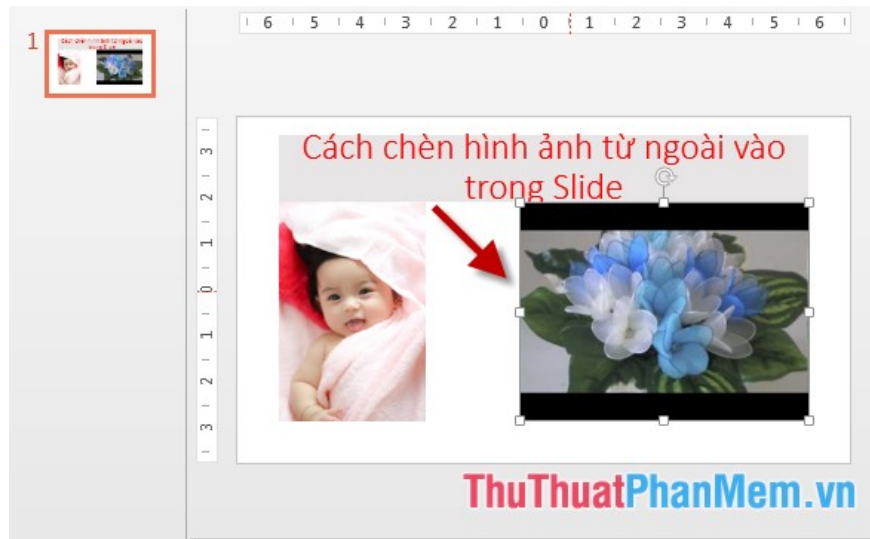
**Step 1:** Go to the **Insert** tab -> **Images** -> **Online Pictures**:
