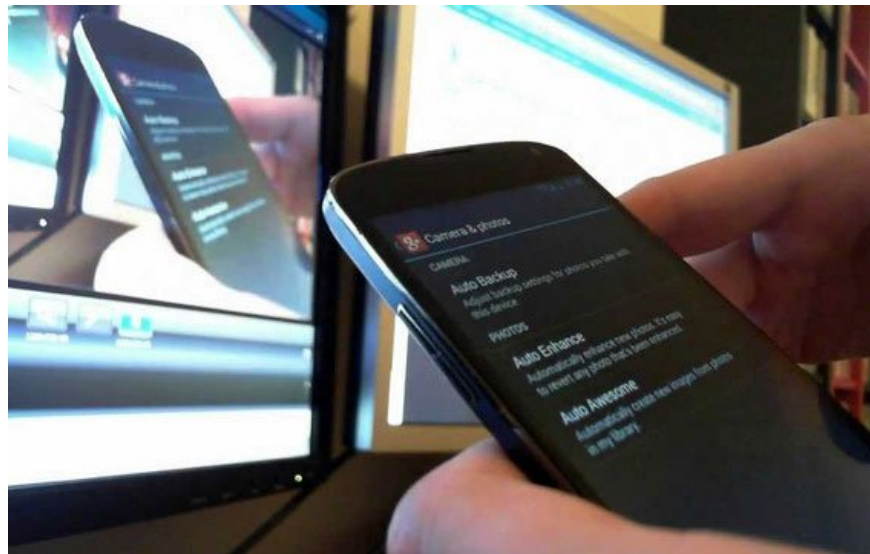


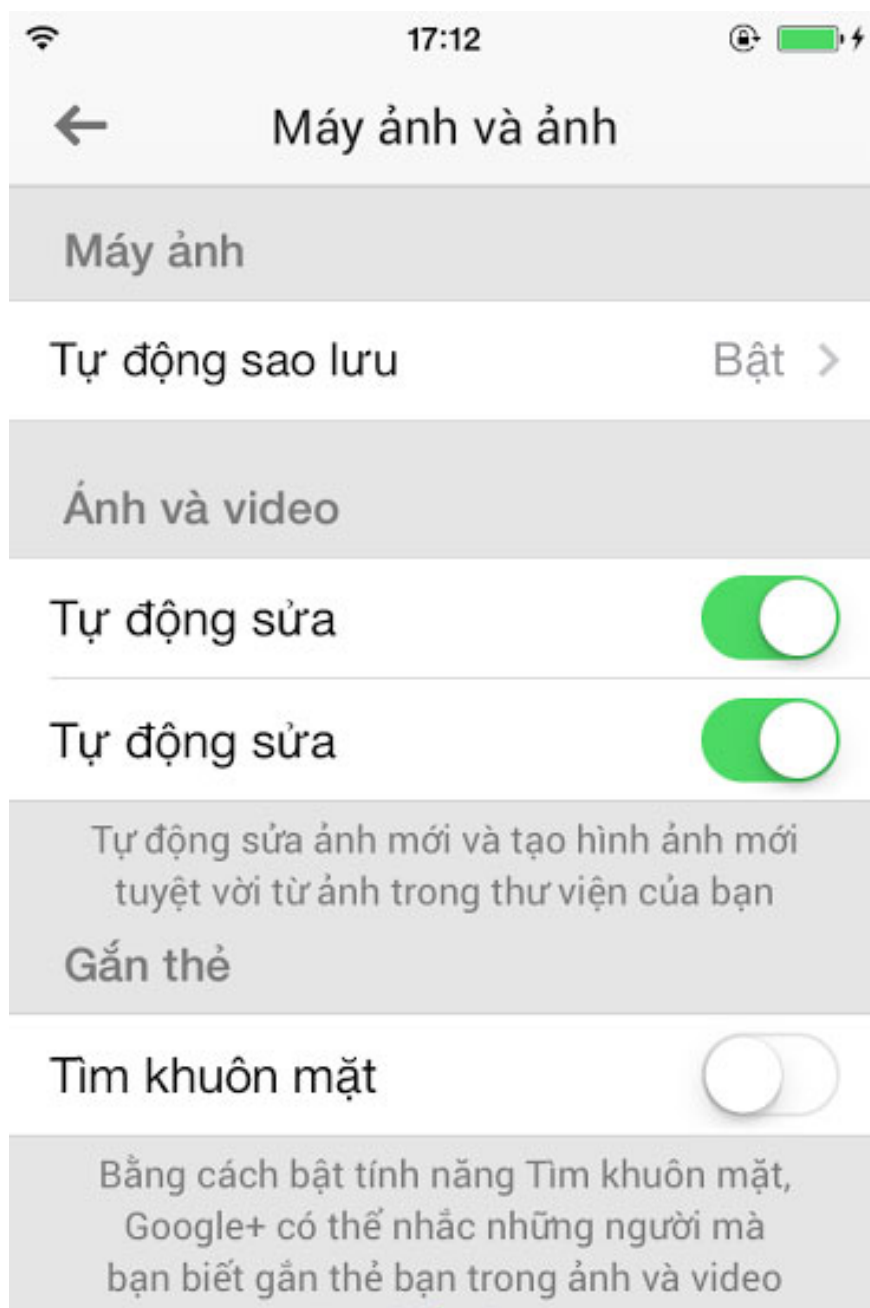
## Insert photos from your phone into Gmail via 'cloud'

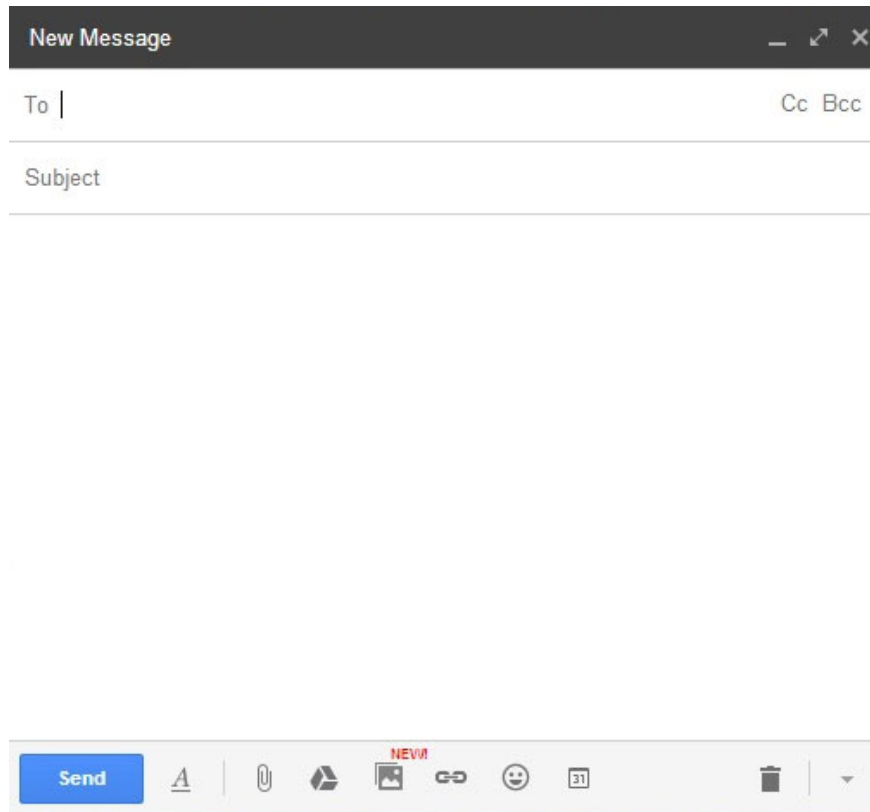

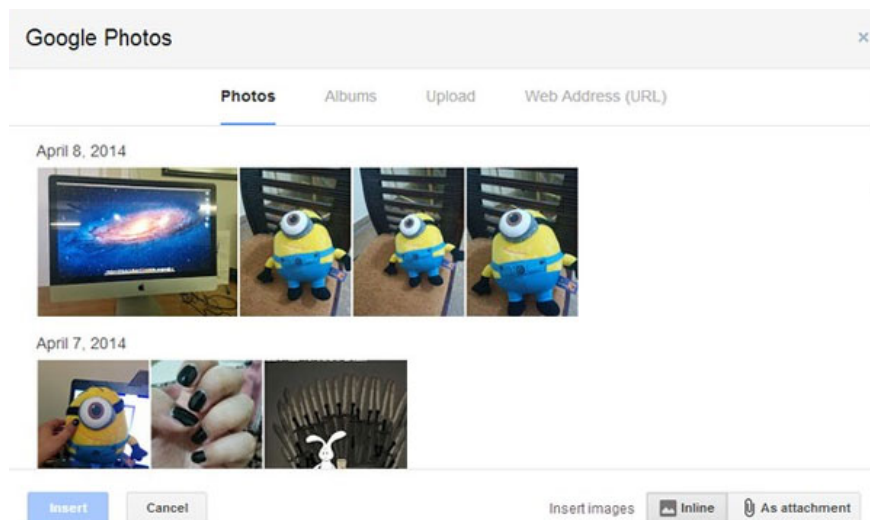
Users use this feature by first installing the Google Plus application on their iOS or Android device, then turning on the automatic backup feature for the app by visiting the **Settings settings section**. > **Camera and photo**> click '**Enable**' in the **Auto backup** option of the **Camera** section.



You now access Gmail on the web and launch the editor. You will see a new action icon appear.



When clicking on it, a Google Photos image insertion window will appear and display the newly uploaded images automatically from the device via the Google Plus app. Please select the image you need and click **Insert**



This feature is quite useful if you want to quickly insert a photo from the phone without connecting the phone to the computer.
