

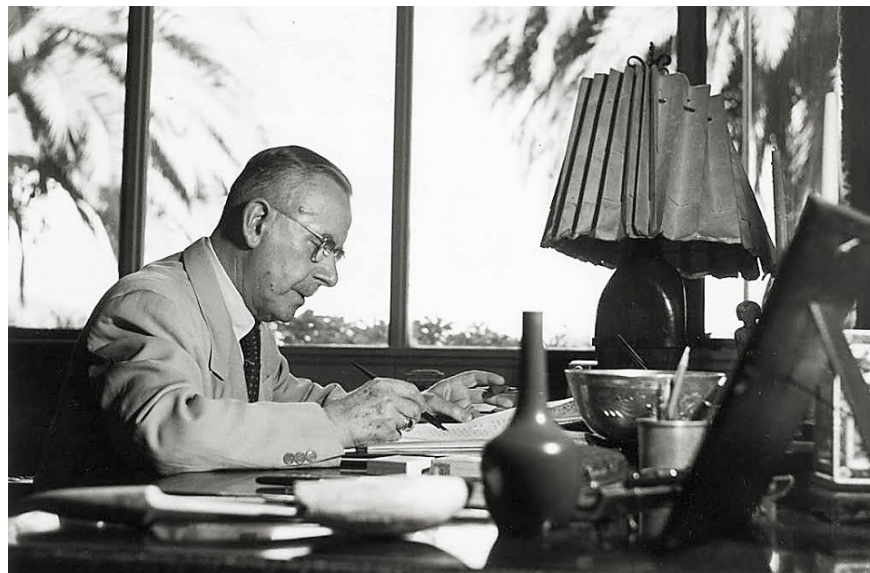
# Inspirational quotes for those who love to write.

However, after all the bitterness, sweetness, and hardship, no one can stop writing. That's why I say, passion and love for words can completely overcome things that seem like the ultimate pain and loss.

Below are 29+ inspiring quotes about writing that will help you find more motivation and confidence to keep the flame of your pen burning. Don't stop, keep writing.

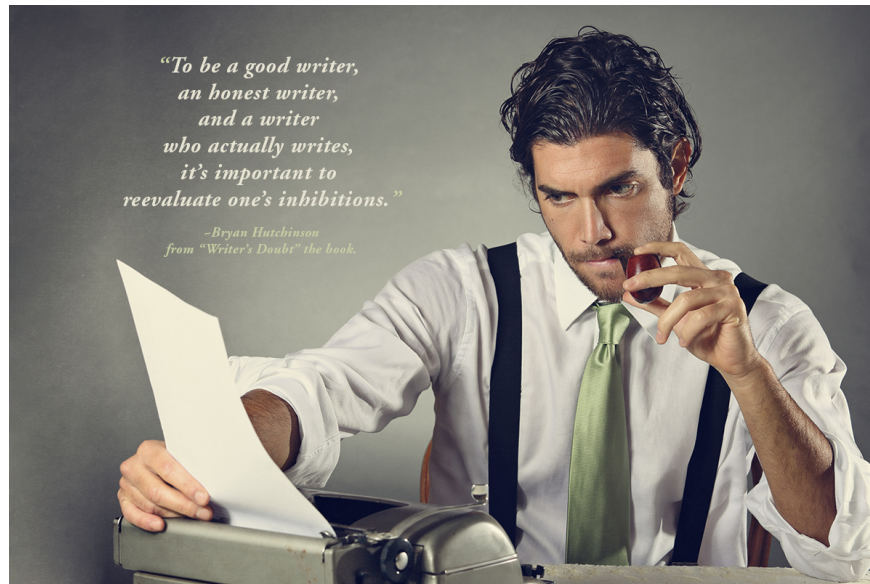
- 1.** I would advise those who aspire to a literary career that before developing their talent, they should wisely develop it in "seclusion" first - Harper Lee.
