

Instagram allows you to remove your followers if you find them annoying

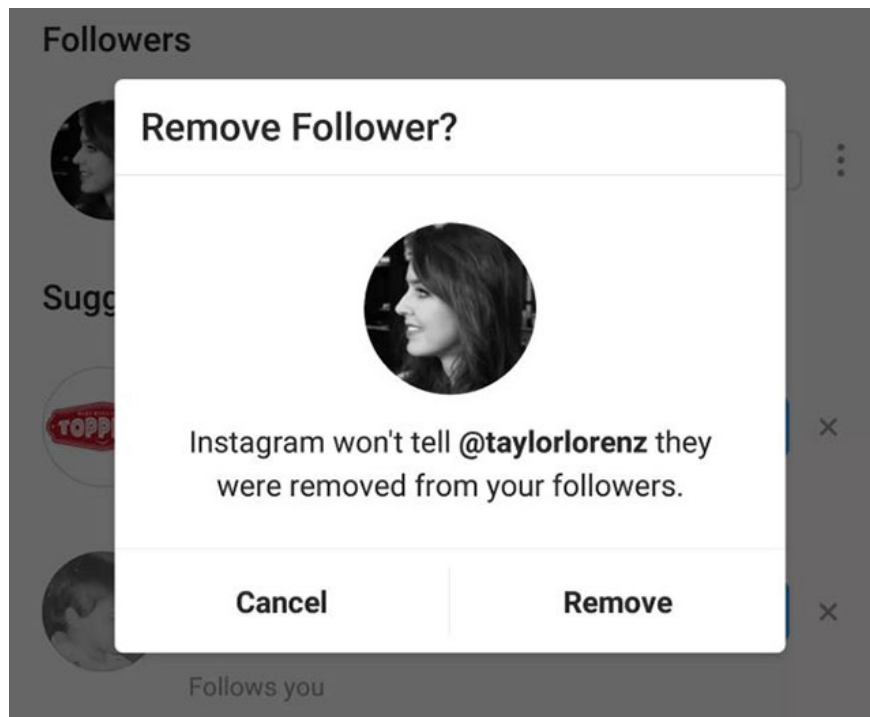
Not as stressful as blocking users and also more flexible than switching to a personal account.

When you leave your Instagram account public, you cannot prevent others from viewing the image you post. Even if you block someone, they just need to open an incognito window or view your account without logging in.

Therefore, Instagram offers a new feature for users to control their own list of followers, allowing anyone to be removed from this list if you don't want them to bother.

Individual account users have long been able to delete followers, not allowing them to view their photos. But now even a public account can do this. Rumors of this feature have been available for several months and are being released for testing. The Instagram representative also confirmed this and will provide more detailed information when the official feature is released.

Instagram also indicates that users deleted from your watchlist will not receive any notifications.

At the end of May, Instagram released the Mute feature that allows them to continue to follow others but no longer see their posts on Feeds, quite useful for acquaintances that you are afraid to cancel following but don't want to see your posts they. With this feature, users have a little more control over their followers.

To see if you have this feature, go to the Profile page of the person you want to delete, open the 3 dot icon to the right of the user name and see if there is a Remove option.
