

# Install Adblock, an add-on to block ads on Google Chrome and Firefox browsers.

Download and install Adblock on your Chrome or Firefox browser to block automatic ads on websites you visit on your computer. Each browser has a different version of Adblock. Refer to TipsMake's instructions below for how to install Adblock.

Currently, there are many applications that help block ads on popular web browsers like Google Chrome or Firefox. Some notable utilities include Super Ad Blocker and Adblock. Super Ad Blocker is a super tool for detecting and blocking all forms of online advertising such as in-app, slide-in, flash, rich media, pop-ups, pop-unders, spyware ads, messenger ads, etc., and also blocks malicious software like viruses, spyware/adware included in those ads.



However, the most frequently mentioned extension is still Adblock Plus, a tool that helps you block ads on Chrome and Firefox. Simply installing this extension can immediately resolve the issue of ads constantly appearing while browsing the web.

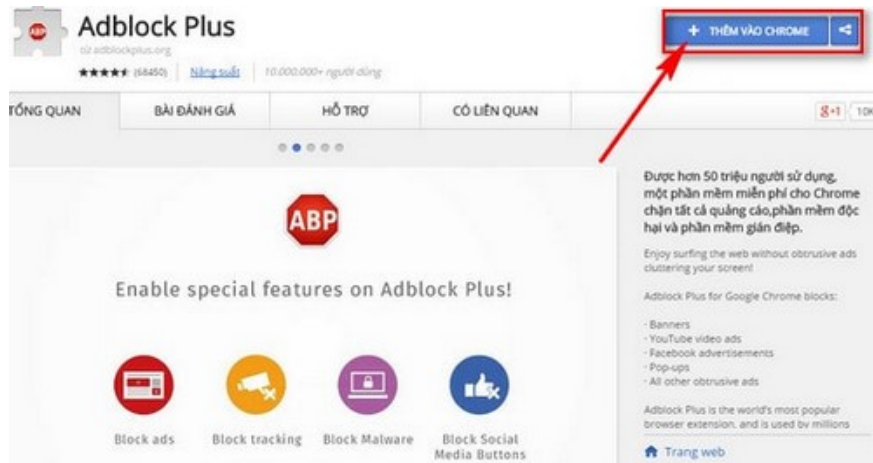
## **Tools needed:**

- **The latest version of the Adblock Download extension**

- Firefox and Google Chrome browsers. If you don't already have them, you can download and install the latest versions of **Firefox** and **Google Chrome** on your computer.

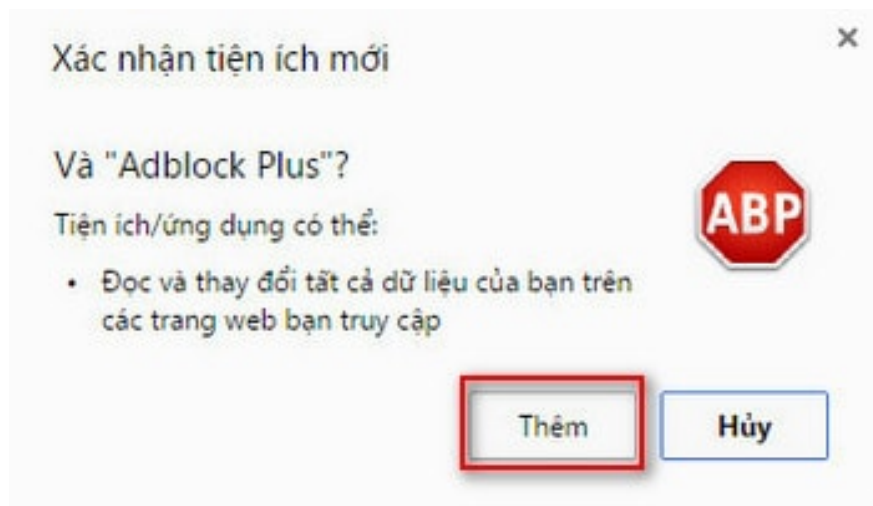
Instructions for installing Adblock Plus for Chrome

**Step 1:** First, you need to download Adblock Plus for Chrome. Click on "**Add to Chrome**".



Install Adblock Plus for Chrome and Firefox.

**Step 2:** The browser will then display a dialog box asking you again if you want to add it. Select **"Add"**.

Instructions for installing Adblock Plus on Firefox

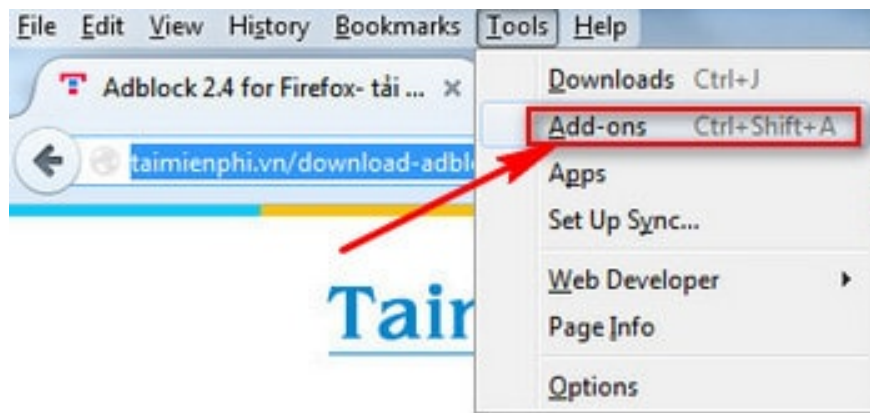
*Step 1:* Similar to the initial installation for Chrome, first download Adblock Plus for Firefox and select **"Install"**.

Just wait a moment and the extension will be installed.

*Step 2:* After completion, to check if Adblock Plus has been installed for Firefox, go to **Tools -> Add-ons** to verify.



Go to the Extensions section and you will see that Adblock Plus has been installed.
