

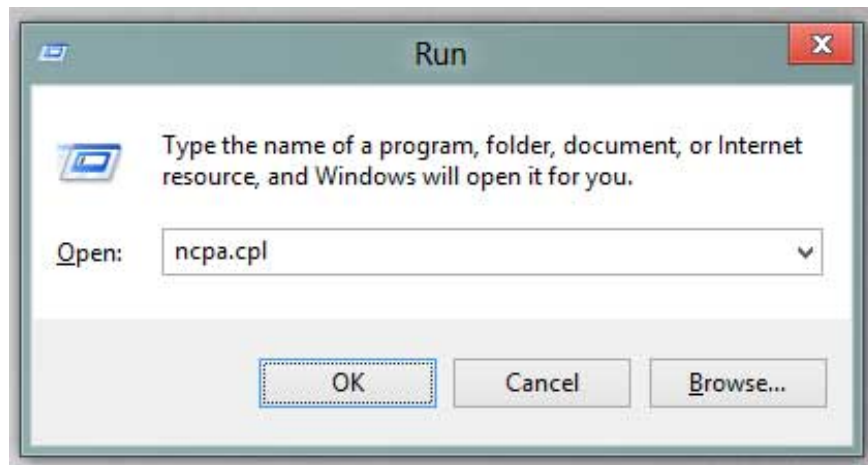

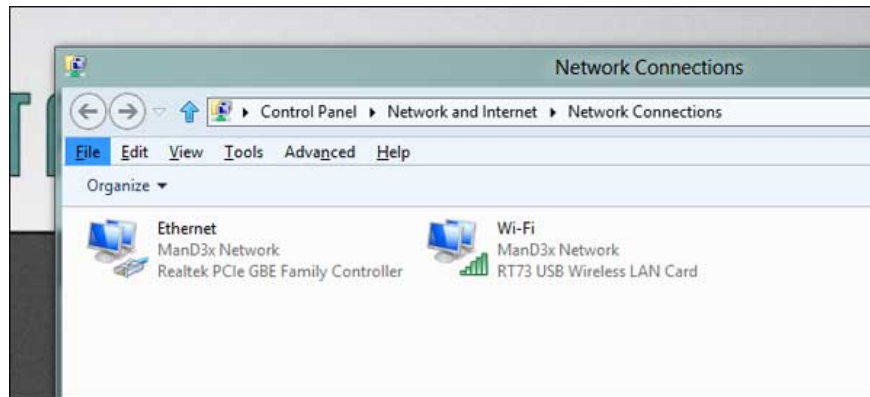

Set higher priority wire connection

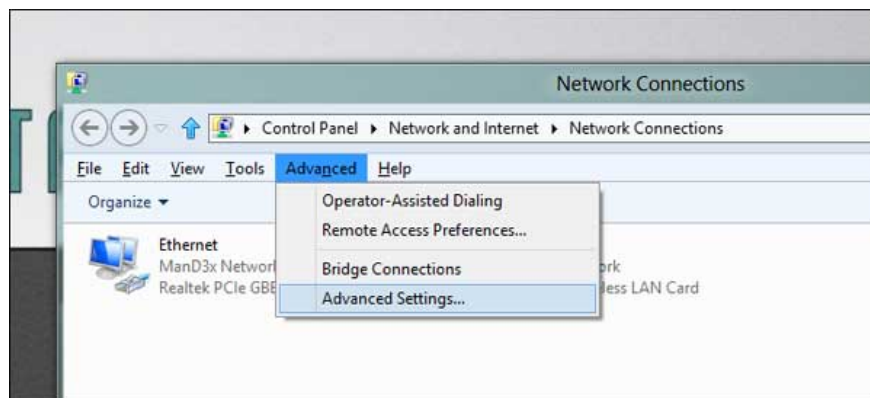
Press the **Win + R** key combination and type **ncpa.cpl** in the Run box and then press the **Enter** key.



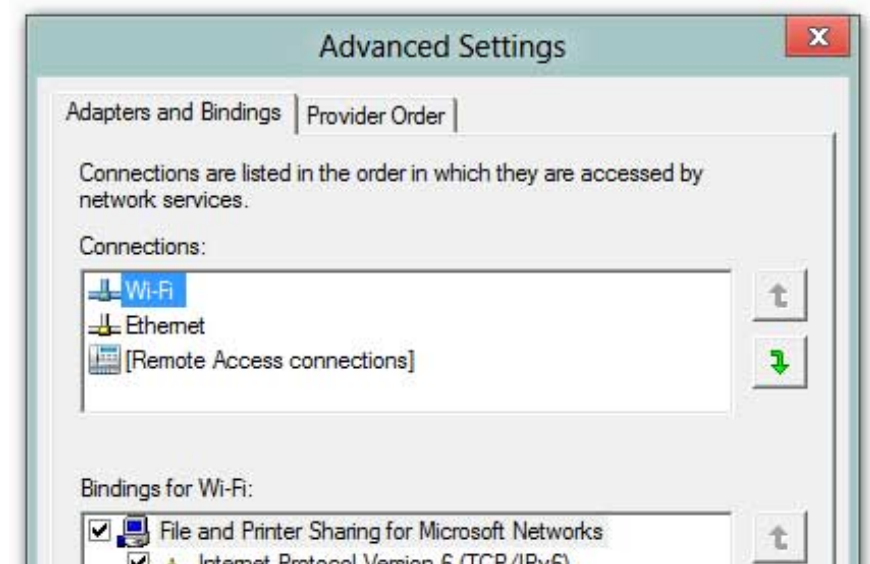
When the Network Connections window opens, press the Alt key to display the classic menu bar (classic menu bar).



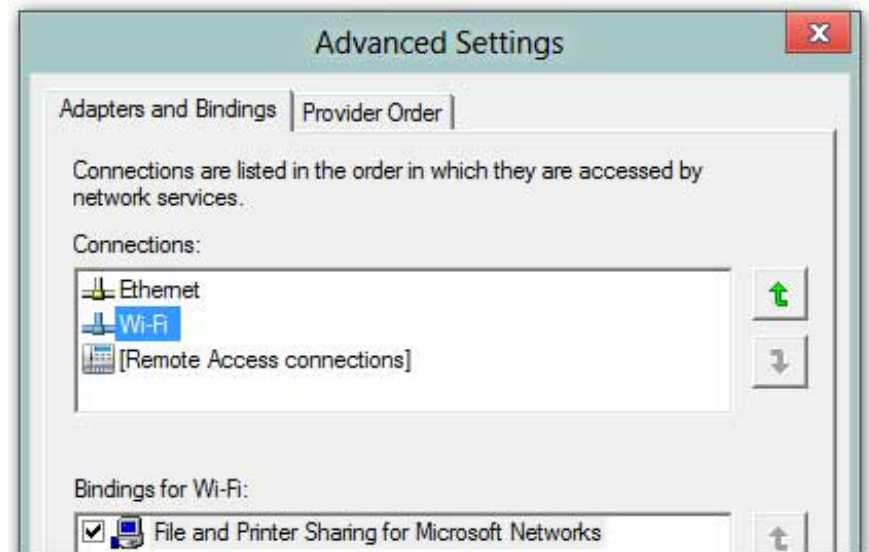
Click on **Advanced** and then select **Advanced Settings** .



Here users will see network connections. To set up a laptop to use a wired connection if available even when connected to the previous wireless network, select Wi-Fi and then click the green arrow pointing down.



The Ethernet connection will automatically be pushed up, so the laptop will treat the wired network connection as the number one priority.
