

Installing Windows XP in 2018 is like this

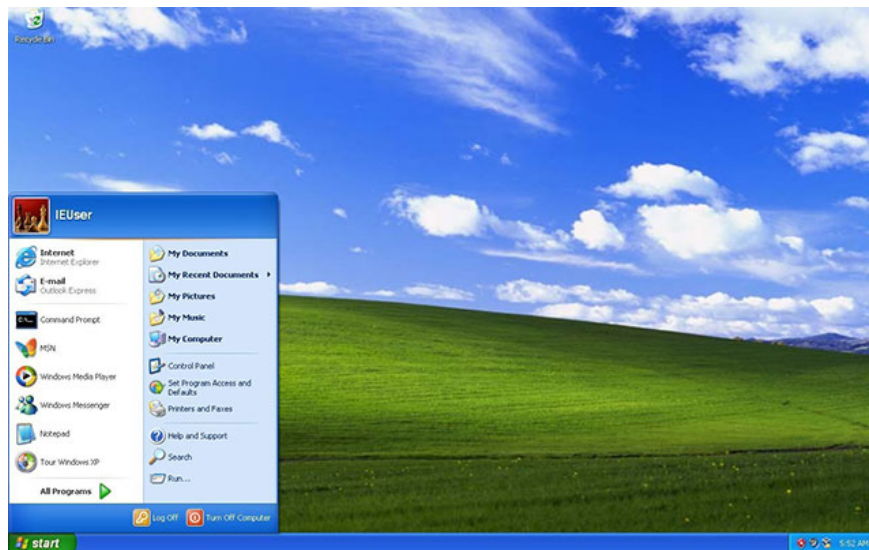
Windows XP was born no less than 17 years ago.

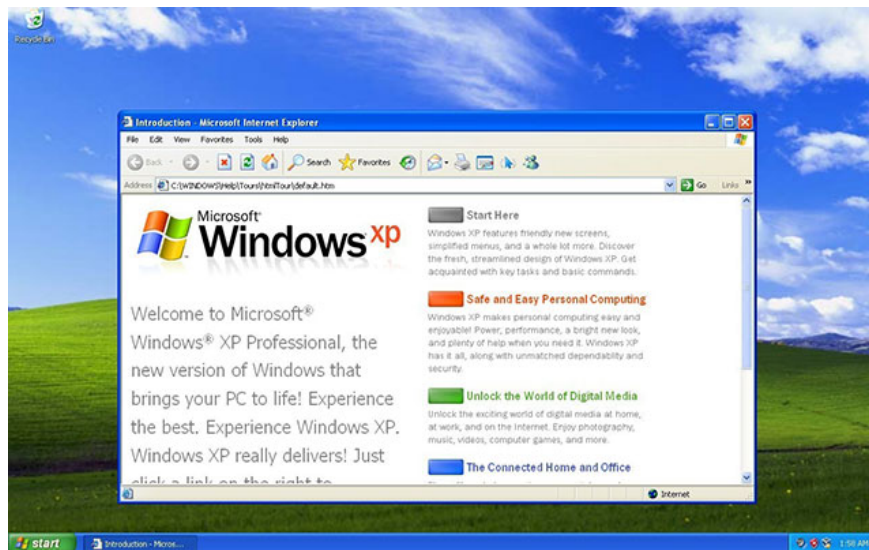
The old space of the operating system was more than 17 years old

The device runs pretty fast, the application opens in seconds, what is needed can still be found and used. For example, Firefox has released ESR that still works on Windows XP, or you can try Vivaldi 1.0 even if it is no

longer supported for updates. There are also media player software, email, security software .

However, it must be said that in addition to the benefits of being used in such a closed and simple environment, Windows XP is not suitable for other purposes. Because it is not updated, security patch, this OS is easy to be targeted by hackers and it is very easy to hack. Perhaps it is more appropriate to use offline, text editing or watching music videos, not to the Internet.
