

Instructions for activating and using Wifi Calling feature on iOS 8

Apple supports adding Wifi feature calling on iOS 8 operating system. With Wifi Calling you can receive or send messages and calls anywhere if your phone has Wifi connection. To enable and use Wifi Calling on iPhone, refer to the following article of Network Administrator.

Wifi Calling allows **iPhone** users to receive or send messages and calls anywhere if the phone has a **Wifi** connection. **Apple** supports adding **Wifi Calling** feature on **iOS 8** operating system. To activate and use **Wifi Calling** on **iPhone** , follow the steps below.

By default, **Wifi Calling** feature on **iOS 8** is disabled, so to use this feature you have to conduct activation. After activating **Wifi Calling**, you can use **Wifi Calling** to make calls as well as send free SMS just need your **iPhone** connected to **Wifi**.

1. Activate the Wifi Calling feature

To activate **Wifi Calling**, first go to the **Settings** app on **your iPhone phone** , scroll down to find **Phone** section and click on it to select.

Click on "**Wifi Calling**" under the **Calls** section.

"**WiFi Calling on This iPhone**" is in **Off mode** , you switch to **On mode**, so you have enabled **Wifi Calling** on your **iPhone** phone.



If for any reason you don't want to use **Wifi Calling** , you can disable it by doing the same steps as you do to enable **Wifi Calling** , but in the "**Wifi Calling on this iPhone**" section , you switch to **Off**.

2. Use Wifi Calling with Continuity feature

WiFi Calling does not work with **the Continuity feature** . You can't make or receive any calls on your **Mac** or **iOS devices** like the **iPad** , , if you enable **Wifi Calling** .

If you are using **iOS 9** and **OS X El Capitan** , you can use the **Continuity feature** with **Wifi Calling** by activating this feature.

You go to the **Settings** app (**Settings**) . Under the **Wifi Calling** option on your phone screen, click "**Calls on Other Devices**".

Next click on "**Add Wi-Fi Calling For Other Devices**" and other devices logged in with your **iCloud** account can make and receive calls normally when **Wifi Calling** is activated.
