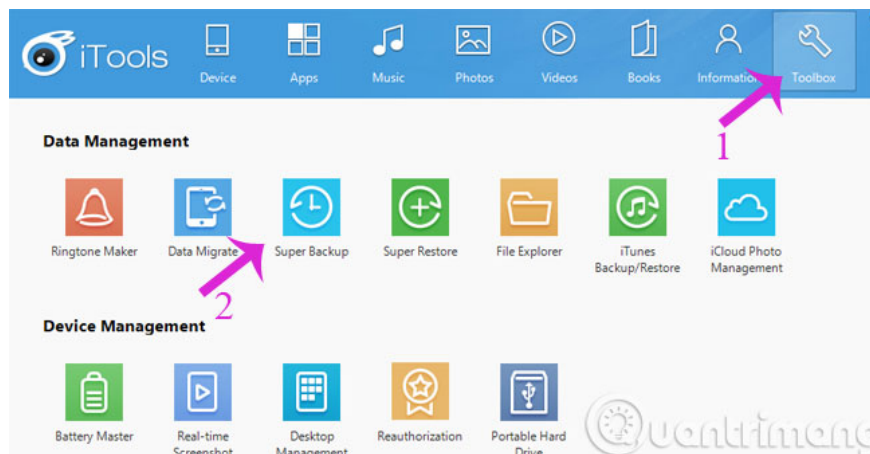

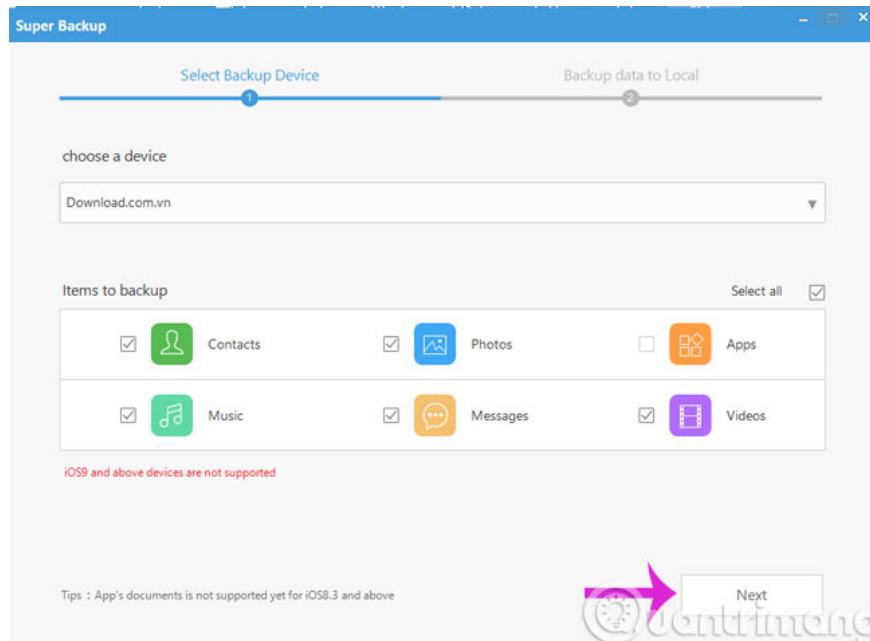
First, you install iTools on the computer and connect the device to the computer with a cable. Then follow the instructions below.

1- Backup data

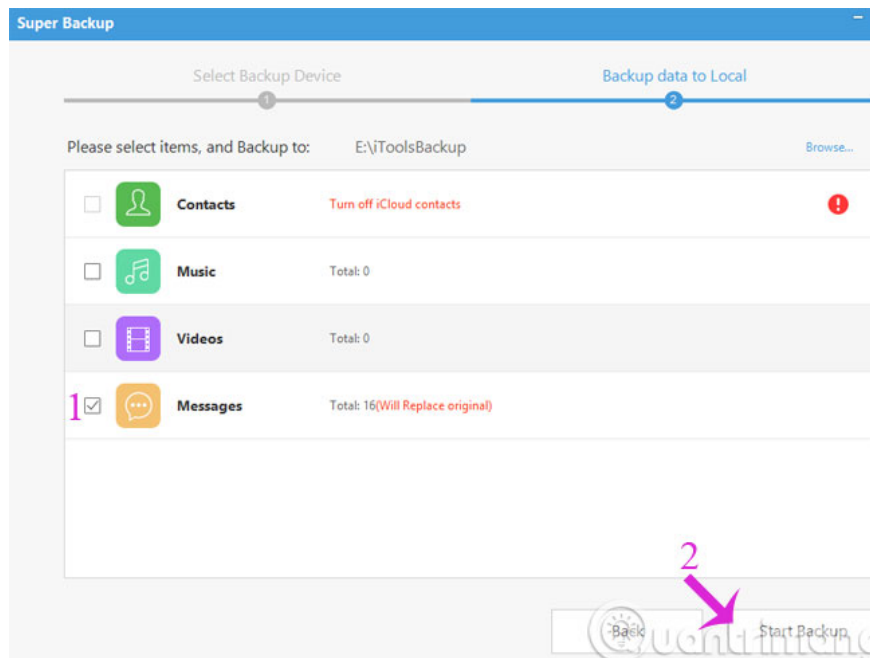
Step 1 : At the iTools interface, press the **Toolbox** menu and click **Super Backup**



Step 2 : Next will appear some information such as device name, backup data. Click **Next** to continue



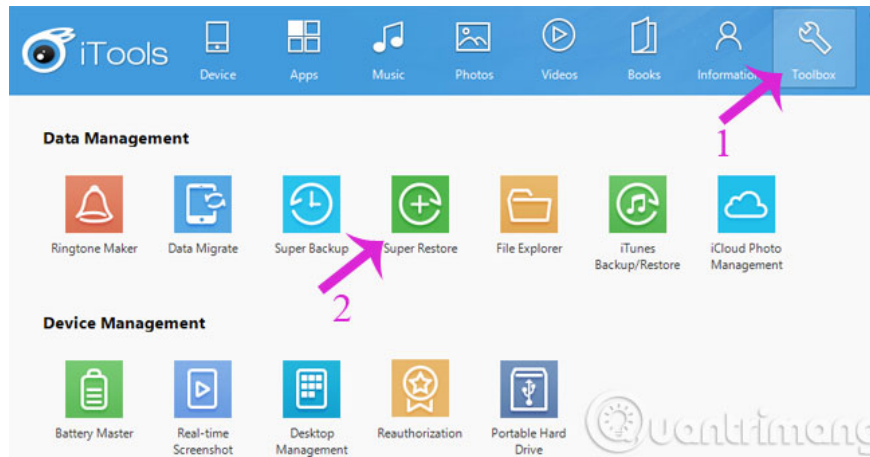
Step 3 : Please select the data to backup and click **Start Backup**



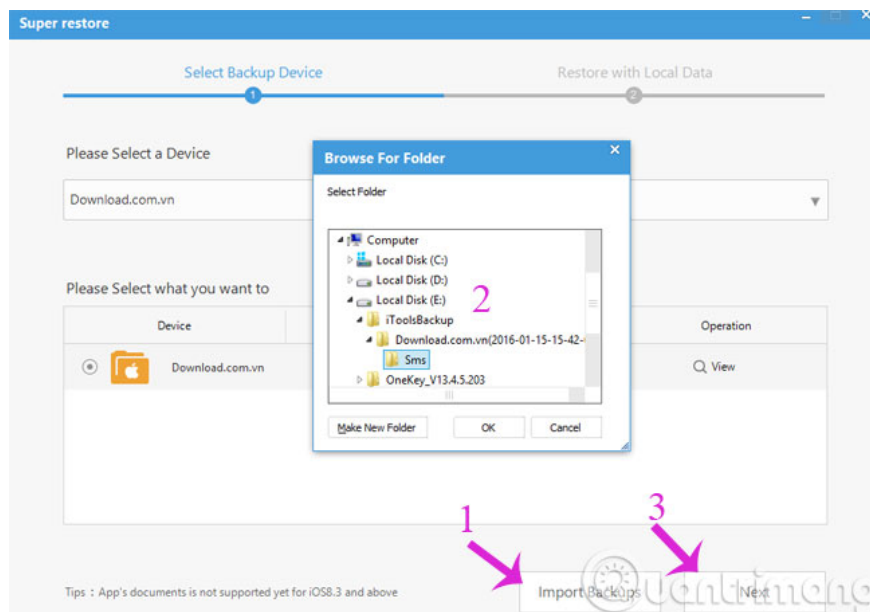
You wait a few minutes for the data to be saved to the computer.

2- Recover data

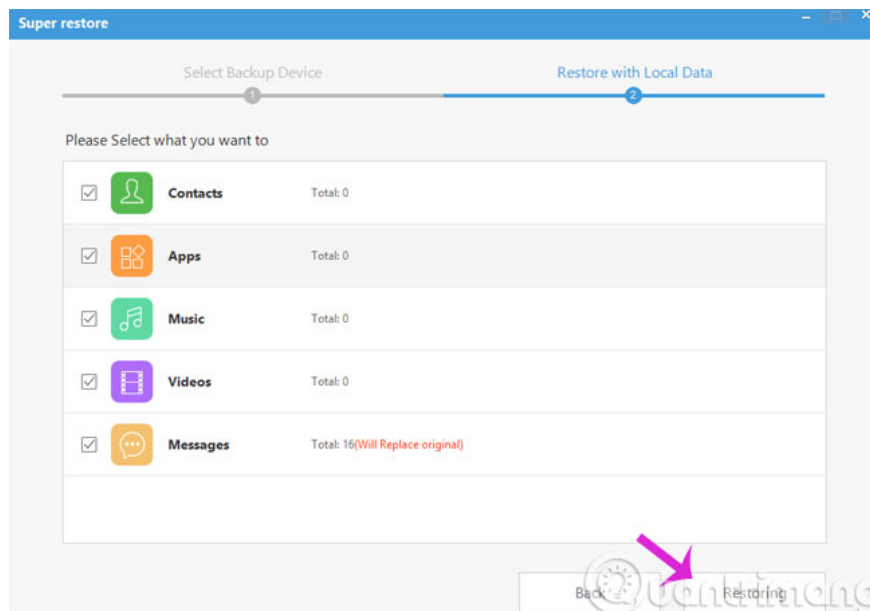
Step 1 : Open the iTools application, click on the **Toolbox** menu and select **Super Restore**



Step 2 : In the next interface, click **Import Backup** and then locate the **backup** file above and click **Next**



Step 3 : Finally, you just need to select the data to backup (if there are many) and then click **Restoring**



You also wait a few minutes for the data recovery process to complete.
