

Instructions for backing up individual messages on iPhone

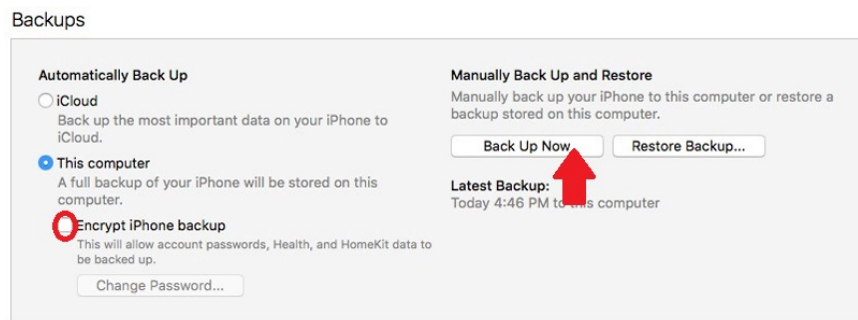
To retrieve important information, backing up messages on iPhone is essential. However, if you back up your messages in the usual way, you will have to go with other types of data such as email, photos, ...

Backing up data and messages on iCloud is essential to be able to retrieve important data when iPhone or iPad device fails. And we can choose to backup each type of different data such as photos, email, contacts, . but with the message does not. When conducting backups and restoring messages on your iPhone using iTunes will always include other general data. This will be a little difficult for users when you need to filter out the SMS or iMessage you need to recover. In the following article, we will guide you how to backup and restore messages on individual iPhone, which will help you get the message you need immediately.

Step 1:

Back up the messages on the source and iPhone iPhone in the same packages as the other data in the usual way on iTunes, but notice that you need to **remove Encrypt iPhone backup** . Then click **Back Up Now** .

Next, we will download iBackupBot software according to the link below, depending on the operating system that your computer is using. Click **Click here to download now** to download the software.

- View, edit and export your files with iBackupBot's built-in plist Editor, Text Editor, Hex Editor, Database viewer, Image viewer, SMS Message Viewer, Notes Viewer, Call History Viewer, Address Book Viewer and more.
- Browse, view and export media files with iBackupBot's built-in Media Browser, media files include: photos from camera roll, voice memo, voicemail, multimedia SMS message and media file of APPs;





Before iBackupBot for iTunes, your only option was to restore all of your files to your iPad, iPhone or iPod touch. Now, you can select, view and even modify files before you replace them on your handheld device.

iBackupBot for iTunes offers additional features unavailable until now. These features include changing some hidden settings of your iPad, iPhone or iPod touch's and even modifying game data. With iBackupBot you'll gain additional control over your device, enabling you to:

- Share data easily with friends or export data to keep a backup copy;
- Maintain multiple backups for you iPad, iPhone or iPod touch;
- Transfer App data files from backup to iPad, iPhone or iPod touch directly;
- Remove a single call history record from your devices;
- Export an iTunes backup to a computer folder for use later.
- Transfer App data files from iPad, iPhone or iPod touch to computer directly.
- Remove recent email address.

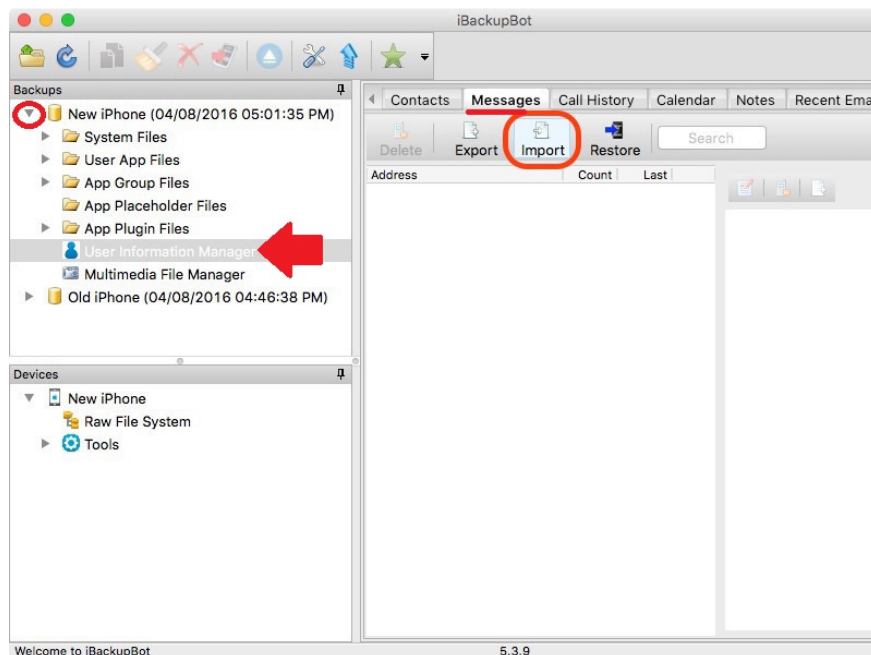

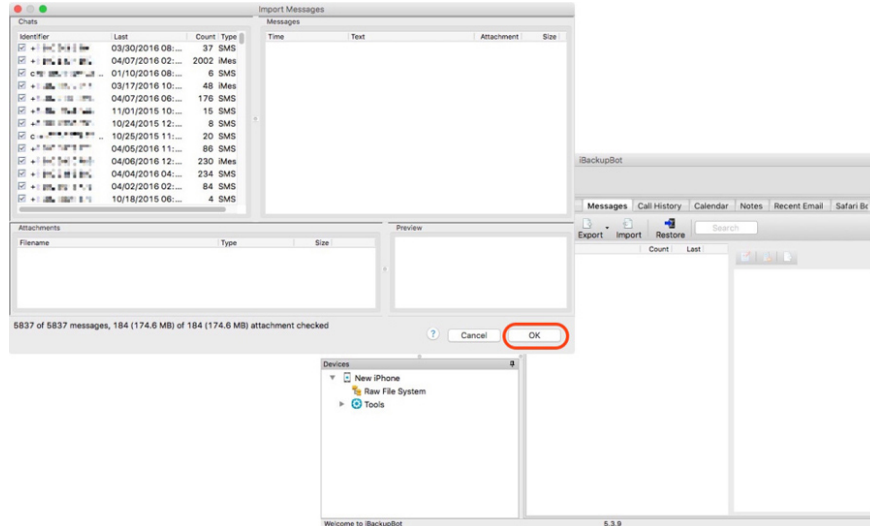
Step 3:

Next we start the iBackupBot software. At the main interface, we will click on the **User Information Manager** item of the destination iPhone on the left of the interface as shown below. On the right interface, readers continue to click on the **Messages tab** and click the **Import** button.



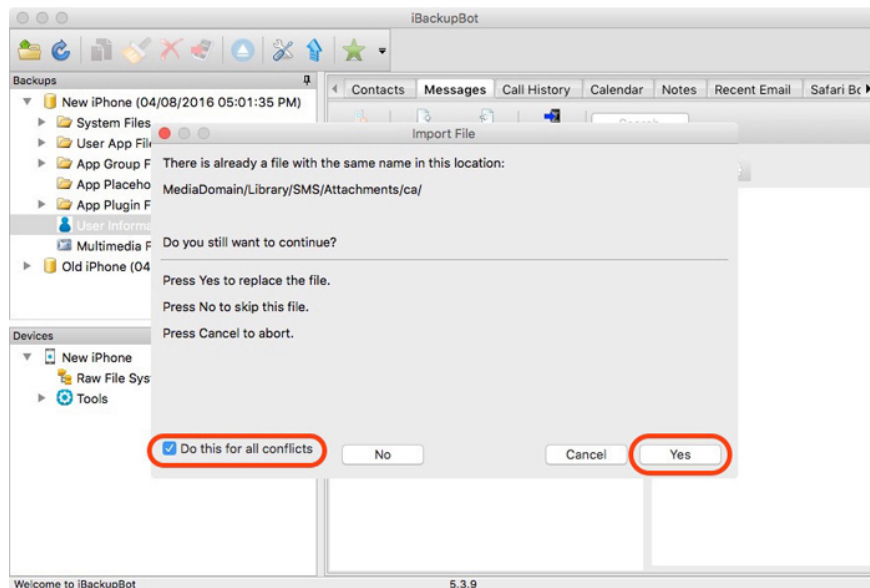
Step 4:

A new dialog box appears. Let's select the data backup package from the source iPhone and click **OK**.



Step 5:

Next, the user selects **Do this for all conflicts** and clicks **Yes** to complete the merging of iPhone messages into the new data package.

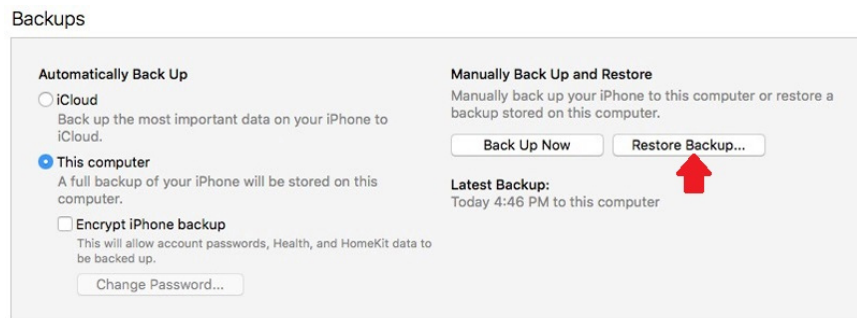


Continue clicking **OK** to complete the process.



Step 6:

Next, to restore the message to the destination iPhone, at the iTunes interface, users simply need to click **Restore Backup** . on iTunes.



Then select the backup message of the processed iPhone and click **Restore** below.



So you have finished backing up messages on individual iPhones with iBackupBot tool. With this tool, users will have instant data recovery messages including processed SMS and iMessage, without adding other data types in the backup.
