

Instructions for canceling download of applications are suspended on Android

You are relaxing with your favorite Android smartphone and deciding to download your 100th app. Afterwards, however, Android Market suddenly crashes and the application you are downloading may get stuck and freeze.

1. Delete the jammed download application on Android

You are relaxing with your favorite Android smartphone and deciding to download the 100th app. However, Android Market suddenly crashes and the application you are downloading may be stuck and closed. What's worse is that you can't cancel or delete the stuck application.

You will say "No need to worry", "I just need to turn off the phone, turn it on, that's all." But the stuck application is still "stubborn" on your Android.

Now what to do?

Whether you are using the latest operating system or tools such as Jellybean or Eclair, the solution is to access Application Manager via the setup application and clear the cache or data, stop or close Obligatory. Do all the above if you're not sure.

2. Use the download manager to delete jammed apps downloaded from Google Play Store

For newer Android phones, the application is downloaded via Google Play Store. To clear the cache and stop forcing apps on Play Store, go to the **Settings** section, usually with the icon like a gear. On Samsung Galaxy running Android 4.3, to go to **Settings**, select **More** on the menu.

From the **Application manager** tab, you will see a list of all your applications displayed, usually divided into four columns: Downloaded applications, SD card applications, running applications and all applications. In all apps section, scroll down to **Google Play Store** and select it. You will see a range of options here. Usually you choose **Clear cache** and **Force stop** to stop the application or you can try clicking **Clear data**. The best way to delete active applications on Android even if you don't even know it is still running (because it is not displayed in the background) is on the running applications section.

3. Use the download manager to delete jammed applications downloaded from Android Market

For older phones use Android 2.1 with Android Market, go to **Settings** on Android phones.

Select the **Applications** section, then click **Manage applications**, you will see a list of applications on your Android phone. In case all your apps are not displayed, tap on the menu icon and select **Filter** to show your filter options. Select **All** to display all the applications you have installed.

When all apps are displayed, scroll down to **Market** and select it. You will then see a range of options. Now click **Clear cache** and then **Force stop**.

The above instructions hope to fix the freeze download application on Android phones. If that doesn't work, you can also try **Download Download** and click **Clear data** then **Force close**.
