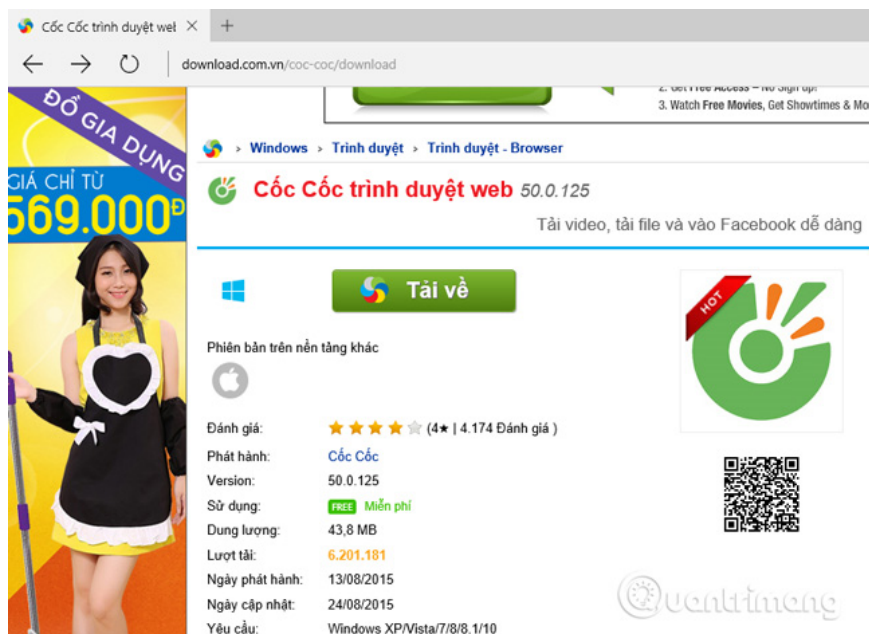


Instructions for changing Microsoft Edge Download folder

Many people said that Edge browser will completely replace Internet Explorer in the future.

Although Edge's browsing speed is much faster than popular browsers, the downside is that the Edge browser still lacks many important features and settings. Edge lacks an important customization option. , it is not yet allow users to change the default Downloads folder when they download the file to the computer.

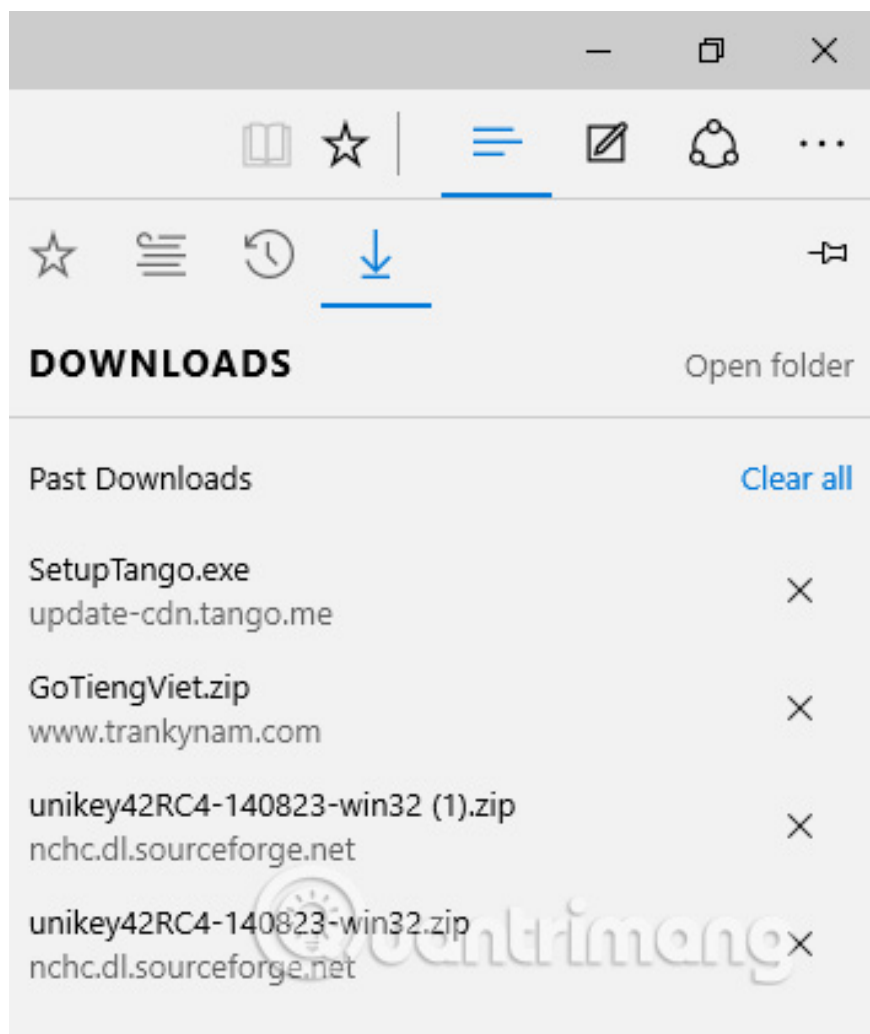


By default, Microsoft Edge will save all users' download files in the **C: UsersUser_nameDownloads folder** , and most of us will be struggling, not knowing how to change this folder. In the following article, TipsMake.com will guide you how to do this on Windows 10 offline.

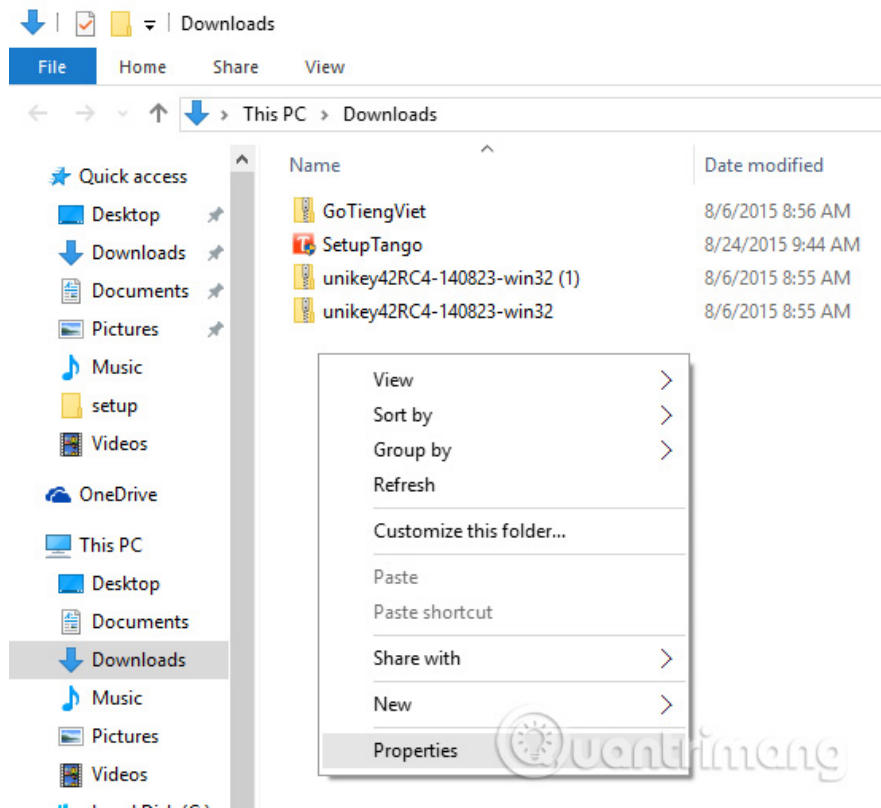
1. On the computer

Method 1:

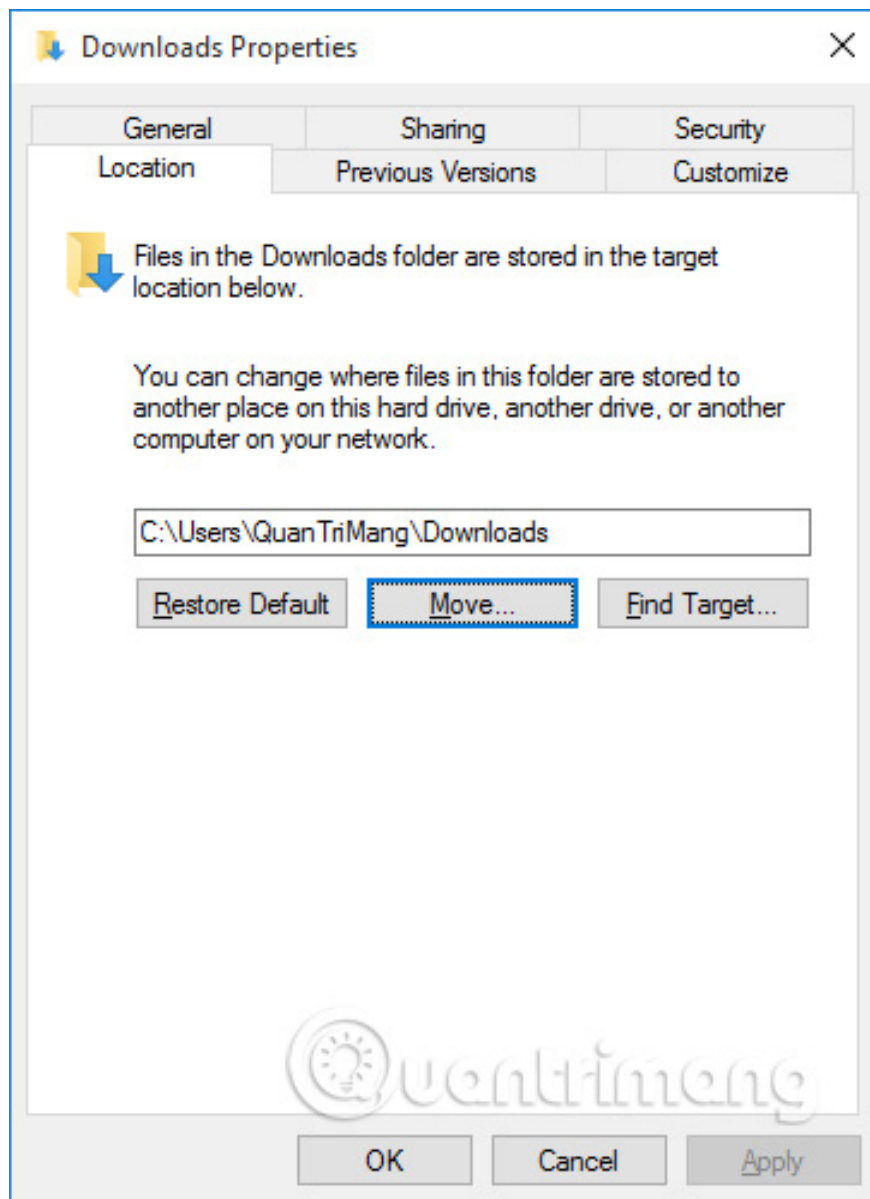
In fact, Microsoft Edge browser uses the system's default Downloads folder, and in theory if we can change this default folder, Edge's Downloads will also change. Open Edge browser, click the Hub icon as shown below to open the Downloads Manager feature, select the link **Open folder**:



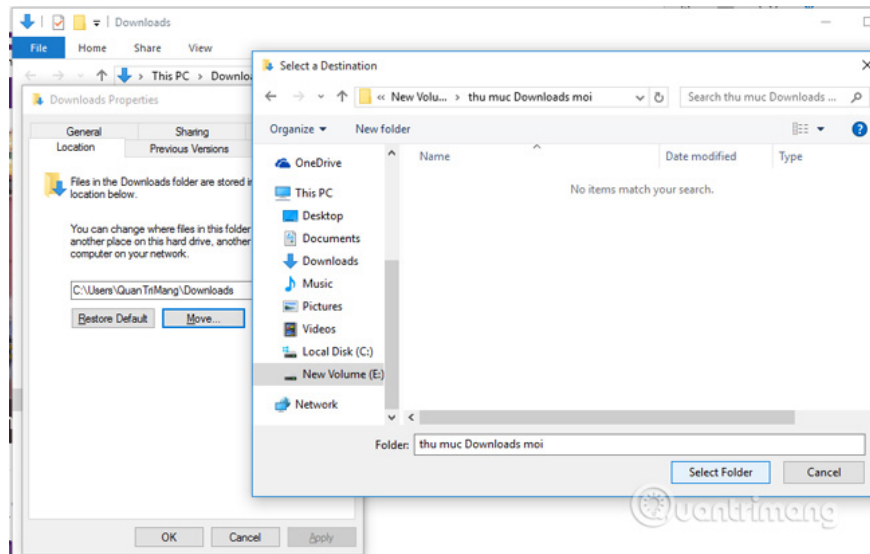
After the **Downloads** folder is opened, you right-click on the blank and select **Properties** as shown below:



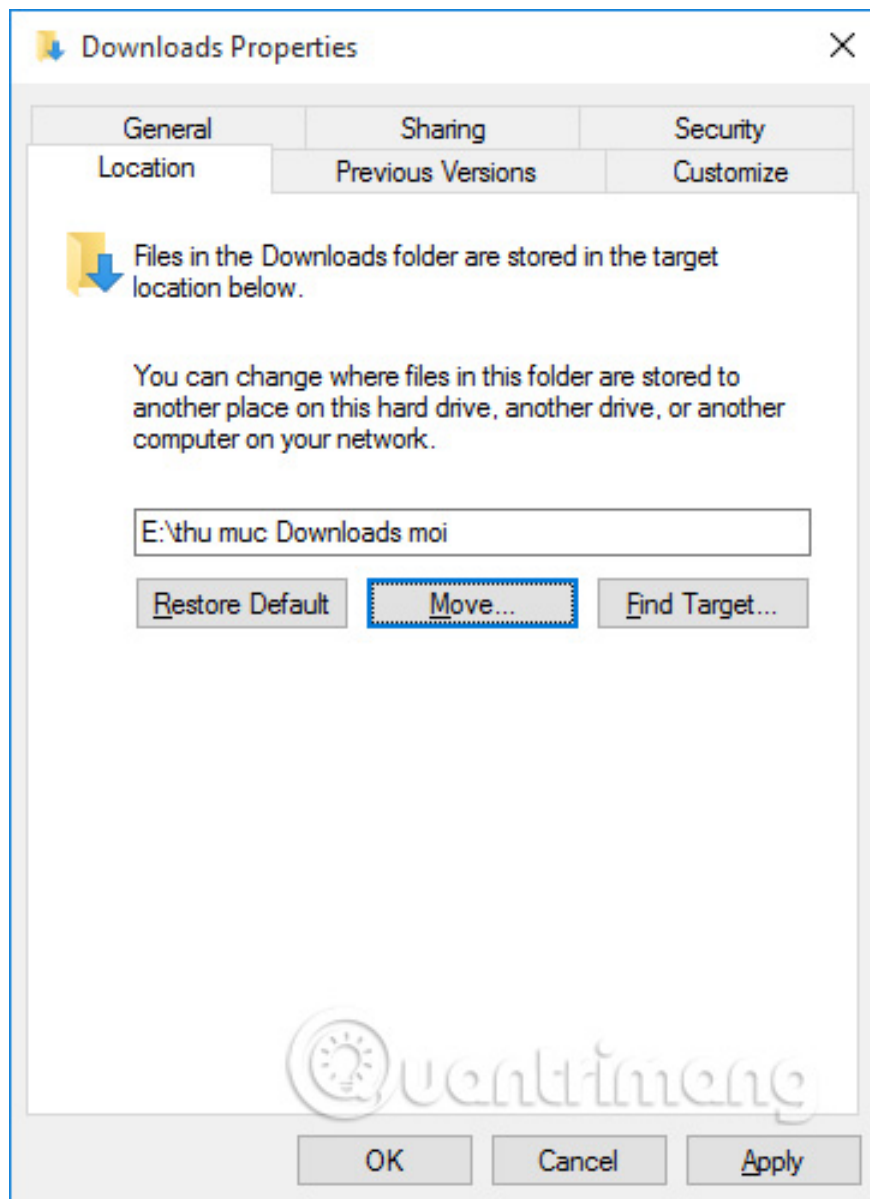
The Properties panel appears, switch to the Location tab and click the **Move** button:



Then point to the folder to be changed, as in the example here, I switch to drive **E** , the folder named: the **Downloads** folder. Then press **Select Folder** :



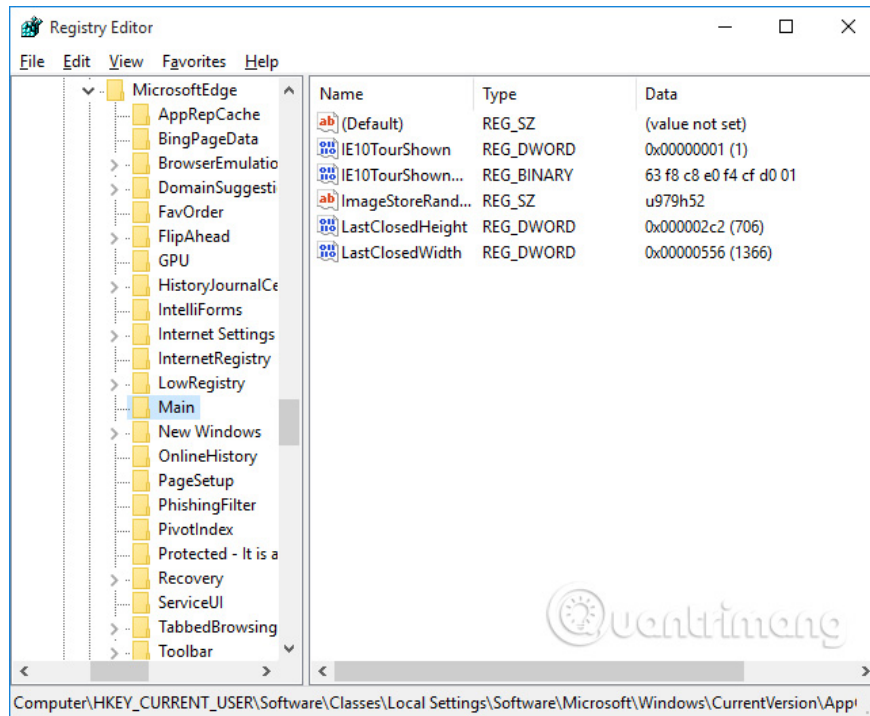
And here. Click OK to apply the change:



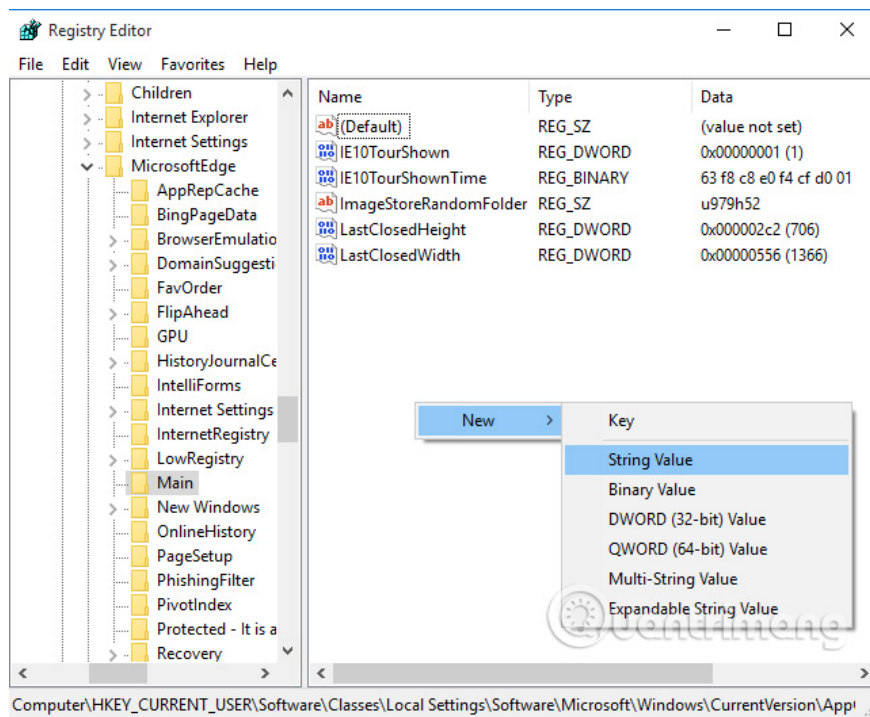
Method 2:

If you don't want to do it this way - interfere with the system directory, you can try it differently - use the Registry. Open the Registry Editor window on Windows 10, we find the key:

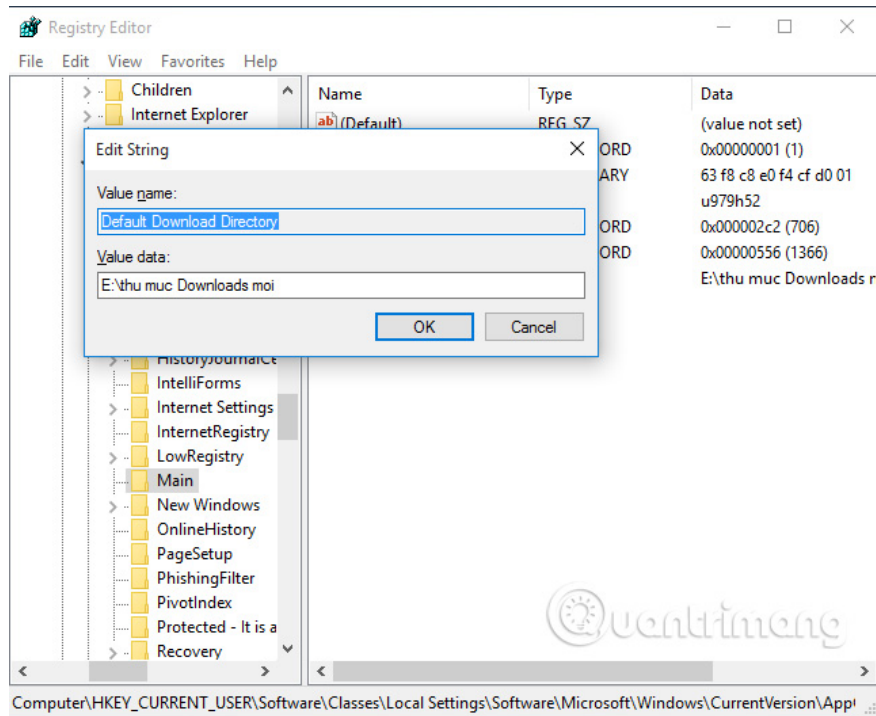

Create a new **String Value** here, name it the **Default Download Directory**, and point to the new Downloads folder you want:



You change it like this, then click OK to finish:

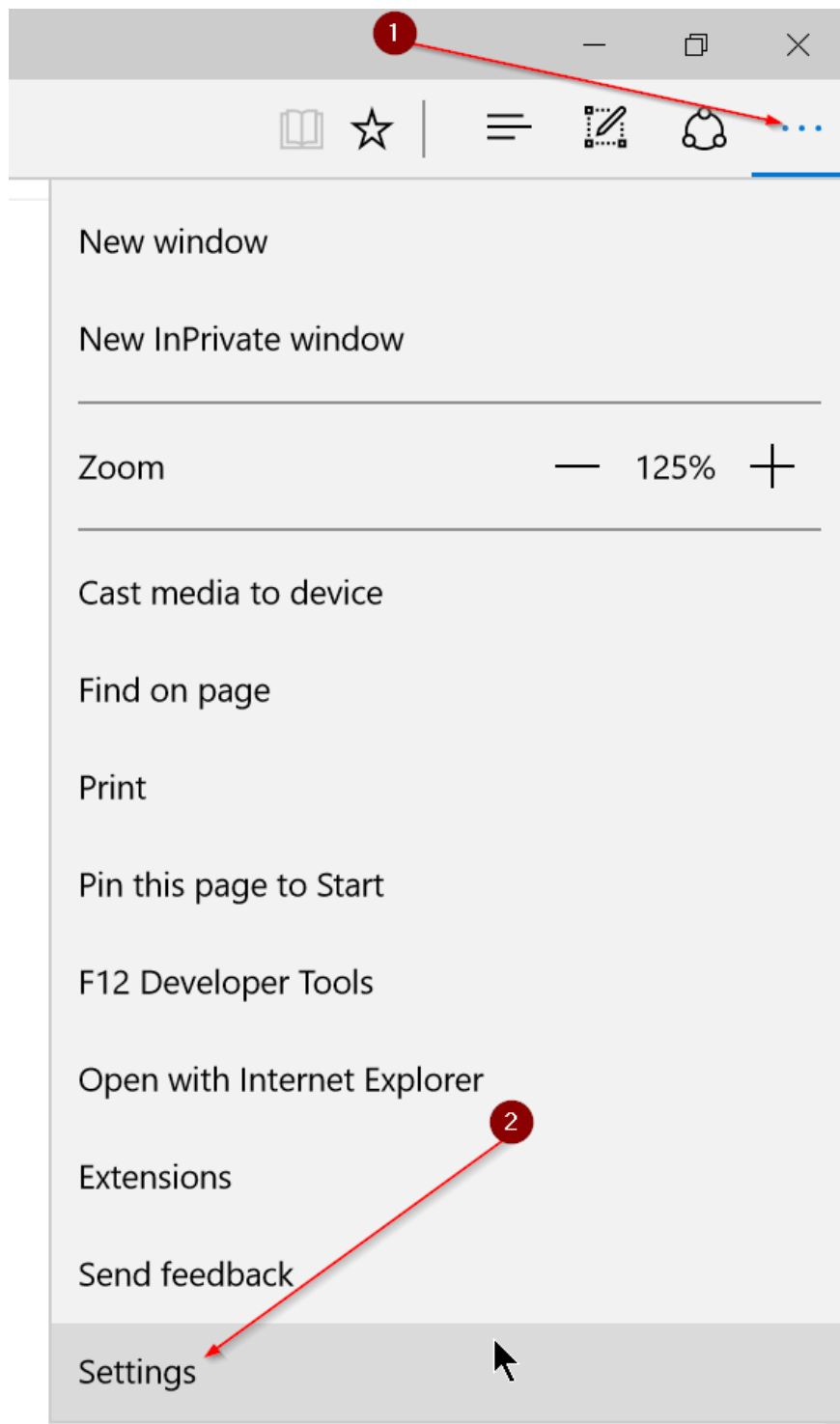


So with just a few simple steps, we have changed the default Microsoft Edge Downloads folder on Windows 10.

2. On mobile phones

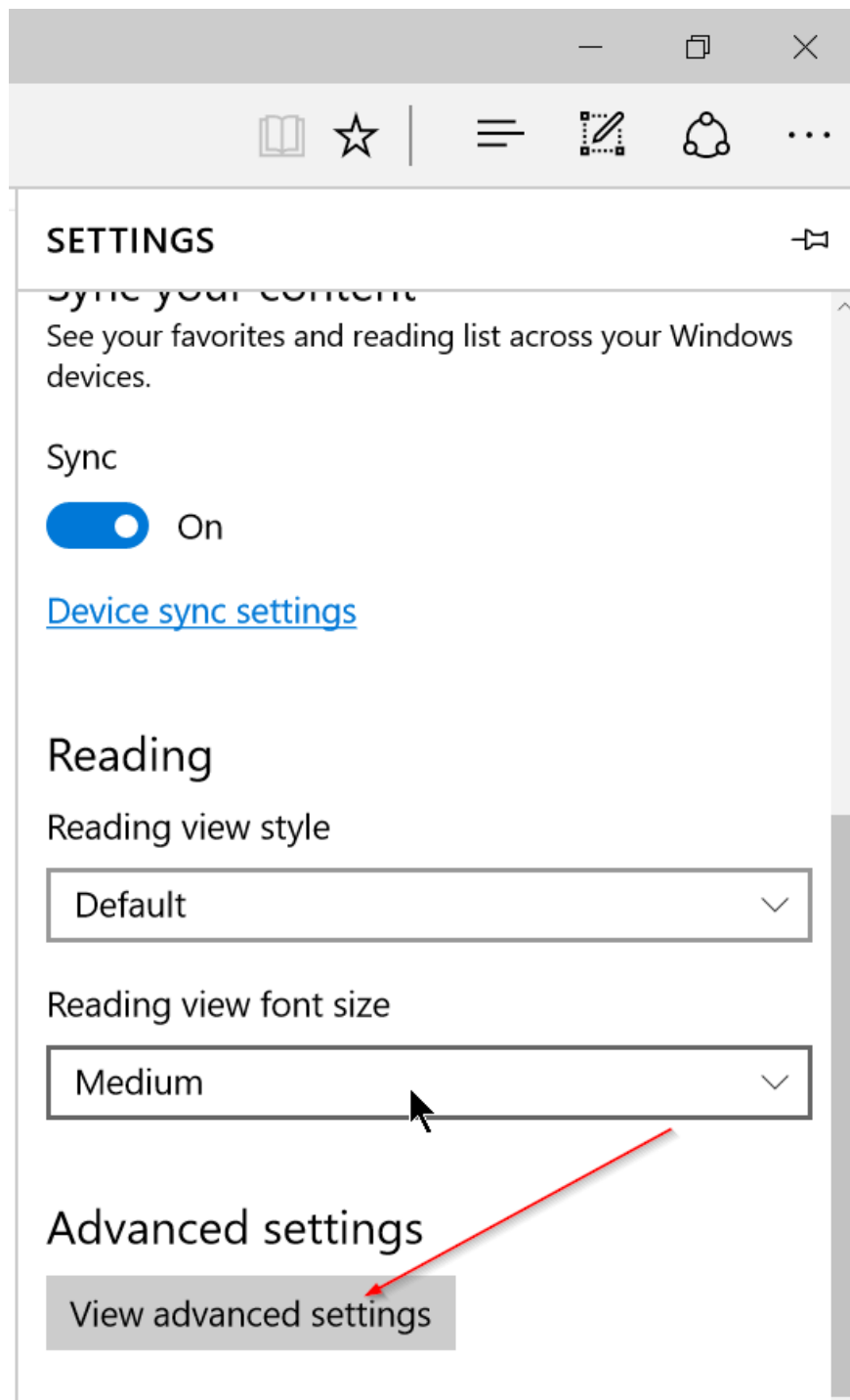
Step 1:

Open Edge browser and then click **More** (icon .) and then click **Settings** to open the settings list.



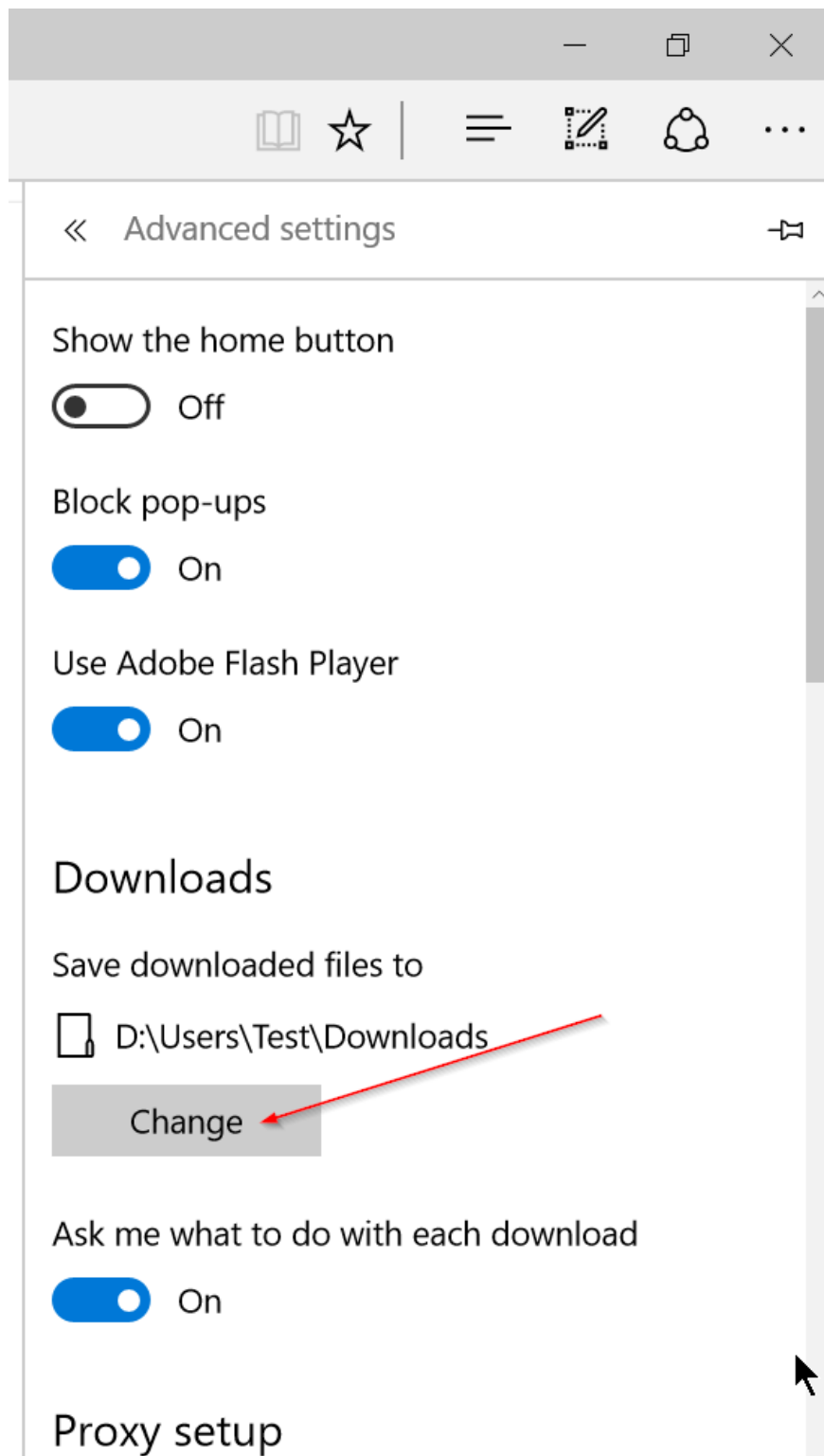
Step 2:

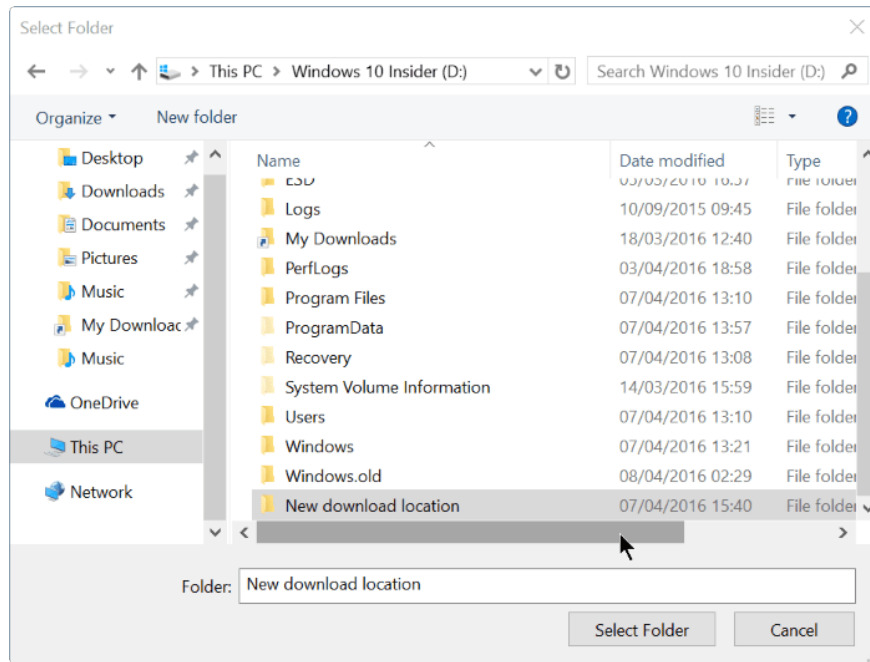
Scroll down to find and click the option **View advanced settings** .



Step 3:

Under Download, click the **Change** button, then select a folder where you want to save downloaded files.

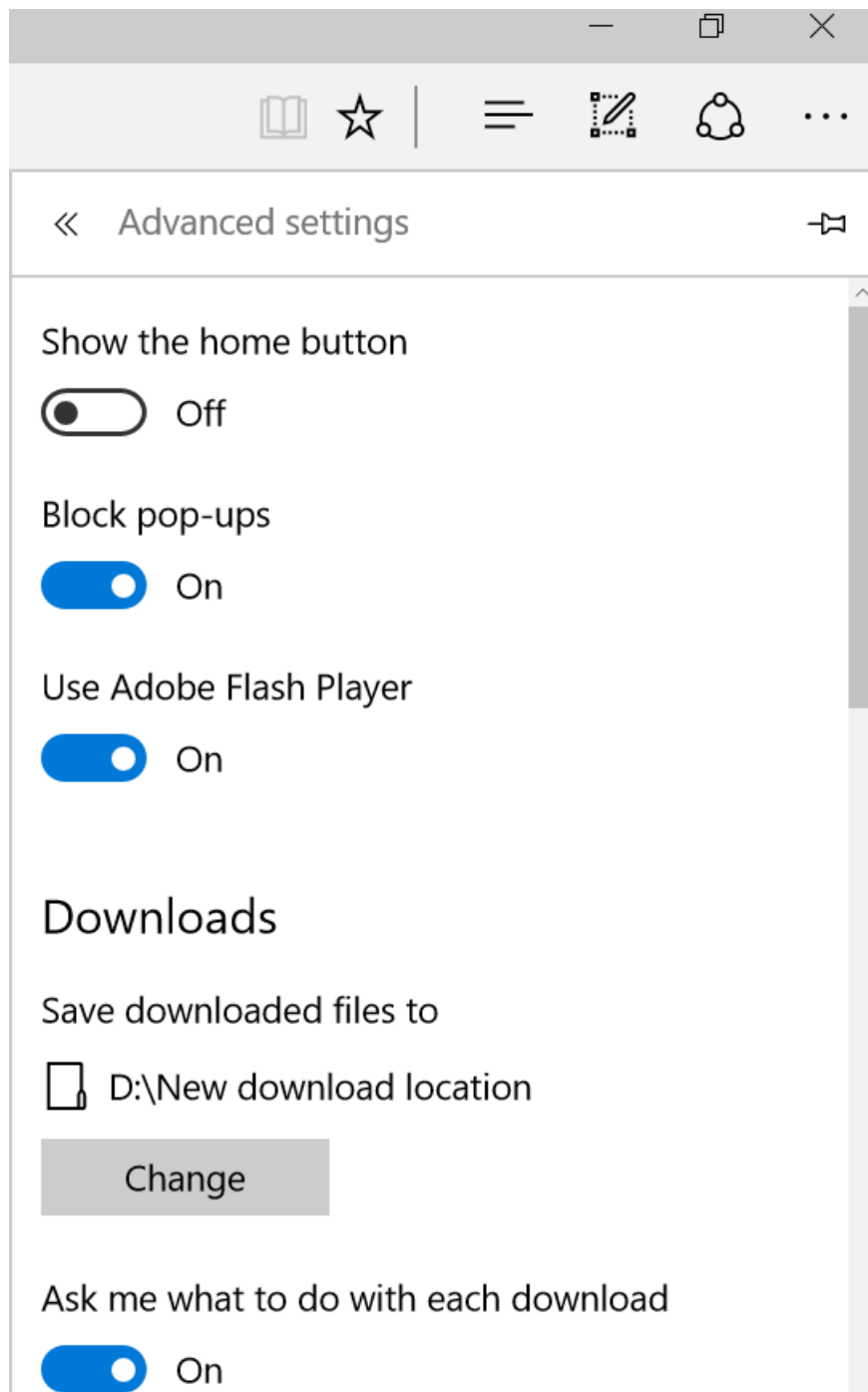




Good tip:

Under the **Advanced settings** section there are a number of options for the Edge browser to stop asking to select a folder to store files every time you download a file.

Turn off the **Ask me what to do with each download option** so that Edge browser automatically saves the files you downloaded in the default download folder.



In case your Windows 10 drive is "bulged", you can move the Download folder to another drive to free up disk space.
