Recently many HP computers have built-in keyloggers on the driver, so users have to quickly find ways to update. This is the guide to update HP drivers.

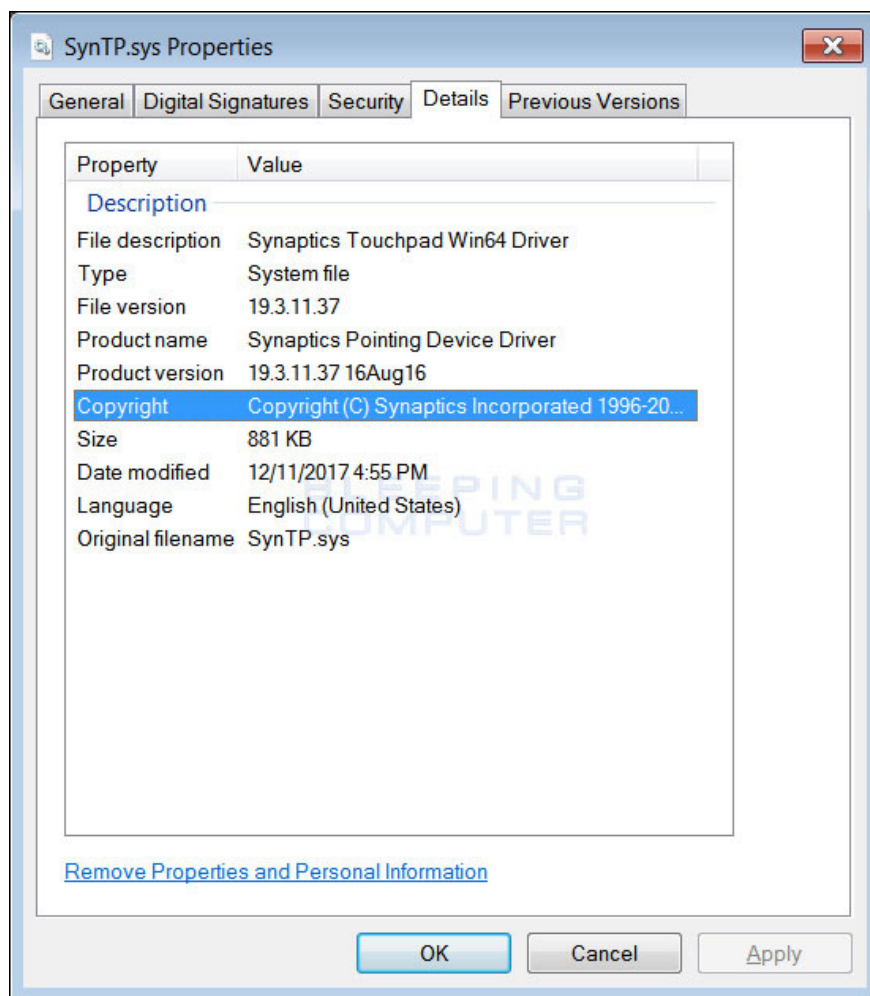
Recently many HP computers have built-in keyloggers on the driver, so users have to quickly find ways to update. This is the guide to update HP drivers.

In fact, because the debug code is left behind, the Snaptic driver on some HP models leaves the keylogger on the user's machine, although it is disabled by default, the hacker can still turn on in just a few simple steps.

If you are using an HP device, you should check if your laptop has a driver containing a keylogger.

First, go to the **C: WindowsSystem32drivers** folder and see **Propertoos** of the **SynTP.sys** driver .

If the version is **19.3.11.37 16Aug16** , it means that the current driver has a keylogger. In this case, quickly download the latest driver for your laptop from the HP Support page. <https://support.hp.com/us-en/document/c05827409>

Even if the version you are using does not stick with the keylogger, you should also update the driver if your model is listed in the list of versions with the possibility of installing another keylogger.

After updating, SynTP.sys will replace with a new version without keylogger.
