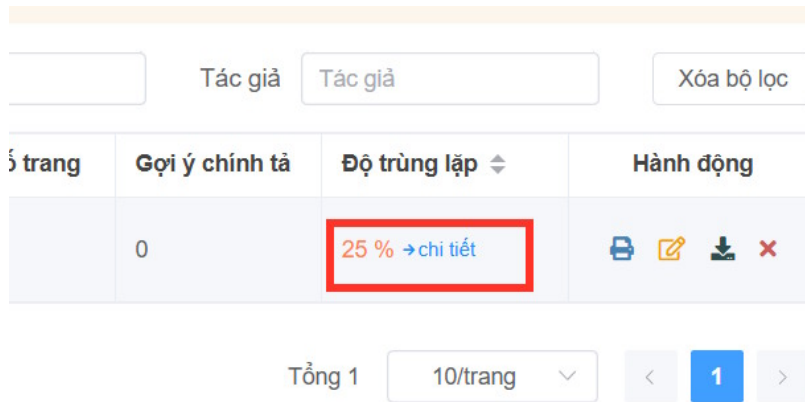

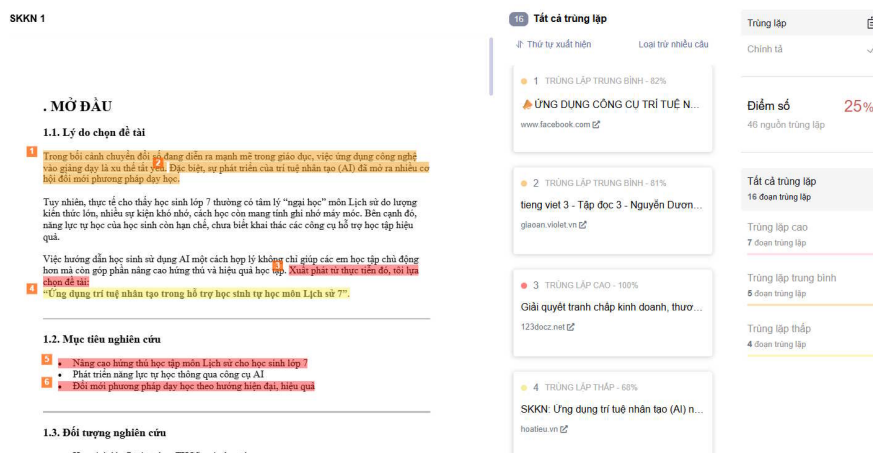

Step 4:

The results will show **the percentage of duplicated content in the Experience Sharing Initiative** . Click "Next " to check the details more thoroughly.



At this point, teachers will see the interface analyzing duplicate content. The content on the left shows the entire written experience-sharing initiative, while the content on the right shows the percentage of duplication that the website has detected.



In the specific comparison section, bold color indicates a high degree of overlap, while light color indicates a lower degree of overlap. For each overlapping item, teachers can see the item's sequence number to compare with the sequence number in the section on the right.

Through this review and evaluation interface, teachers will know how to revise the content of their teaching experience initiative to produce a higher-quality article.
