Instructions for connecting Spotify on your phone to your computer

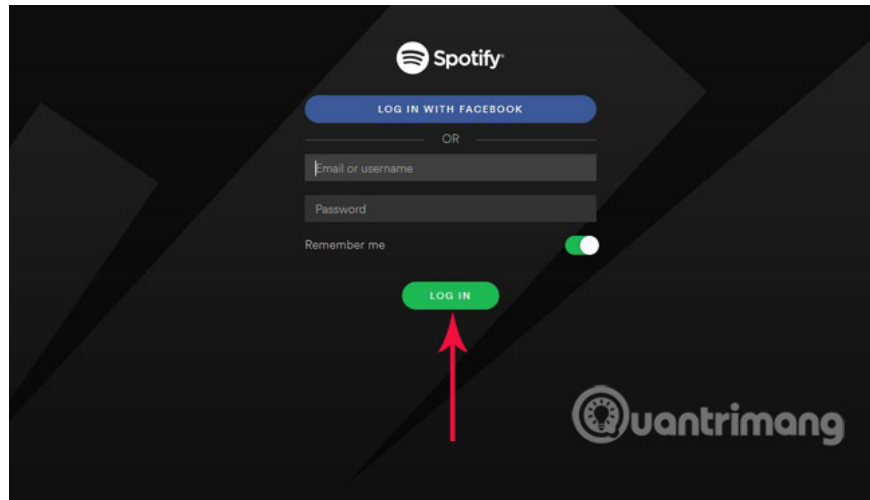
Step 1:

Download and install Spotify on your computer by clicking this link.

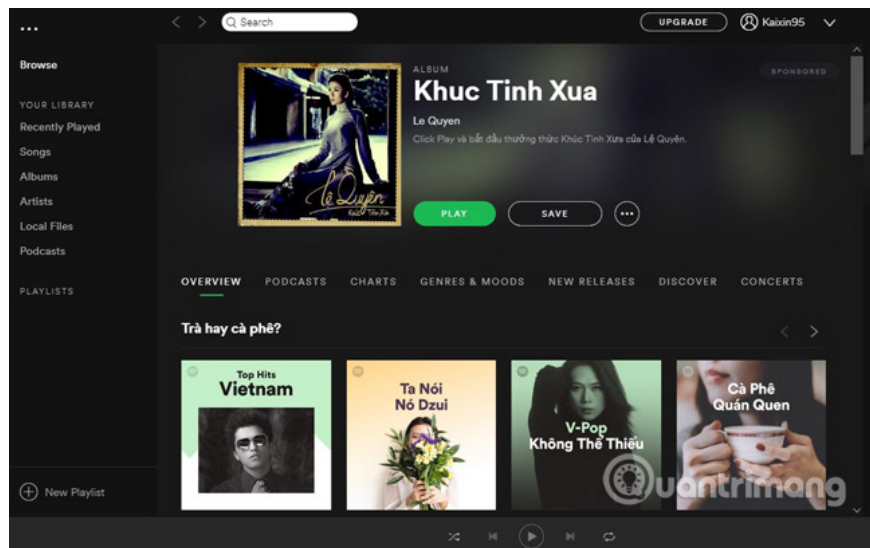
1. Download Spotify software on PC.

Step 2:

When the installation process is complete, open Spotify on your computer and proceed to login to the previously created Spotify account. If you do not have a Spotify account, you can refer to the tutorial How to register a Spotify account to listen to online music to know how to do it.

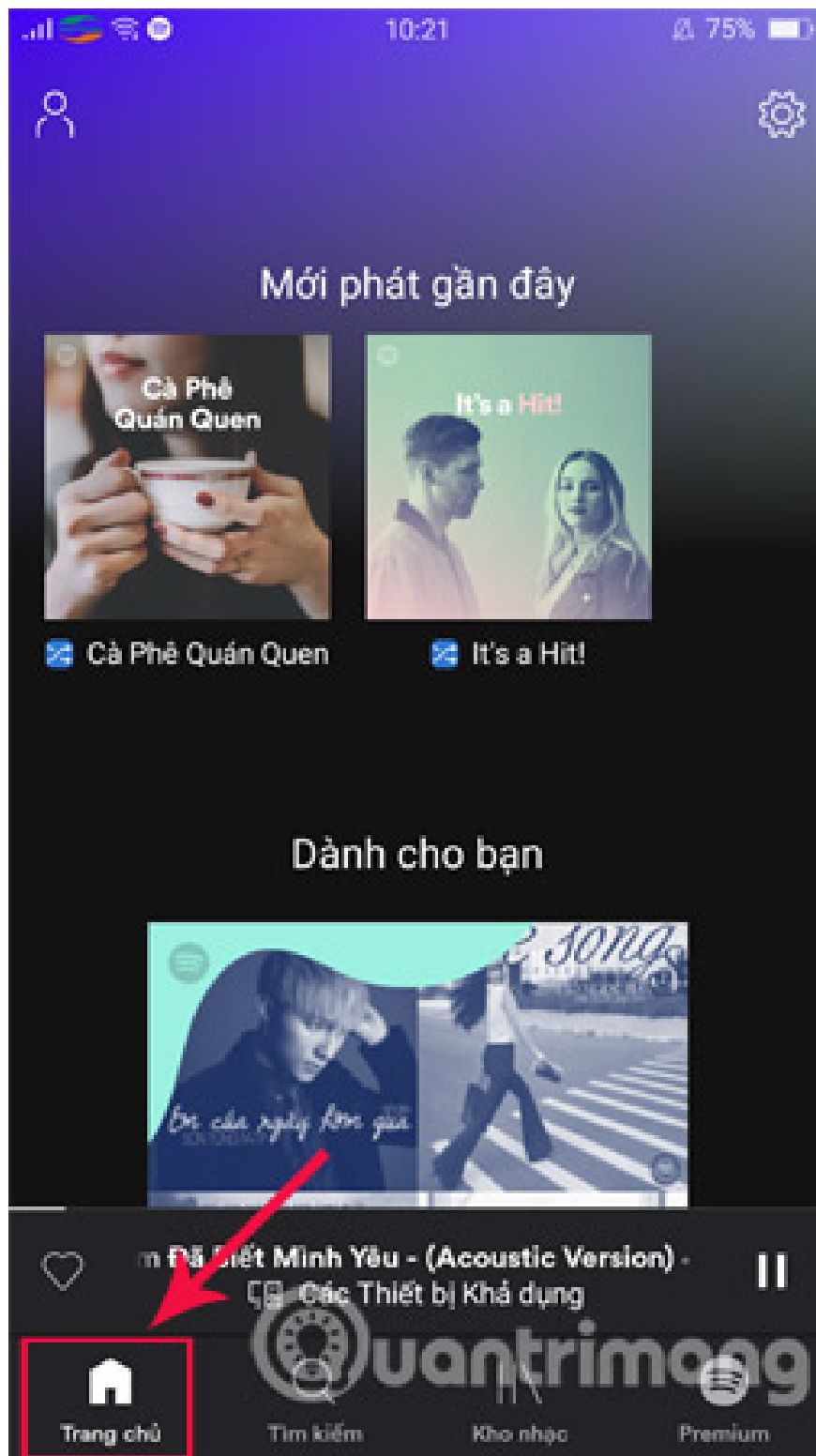


This is the Spotify interface on the computer after successful login.



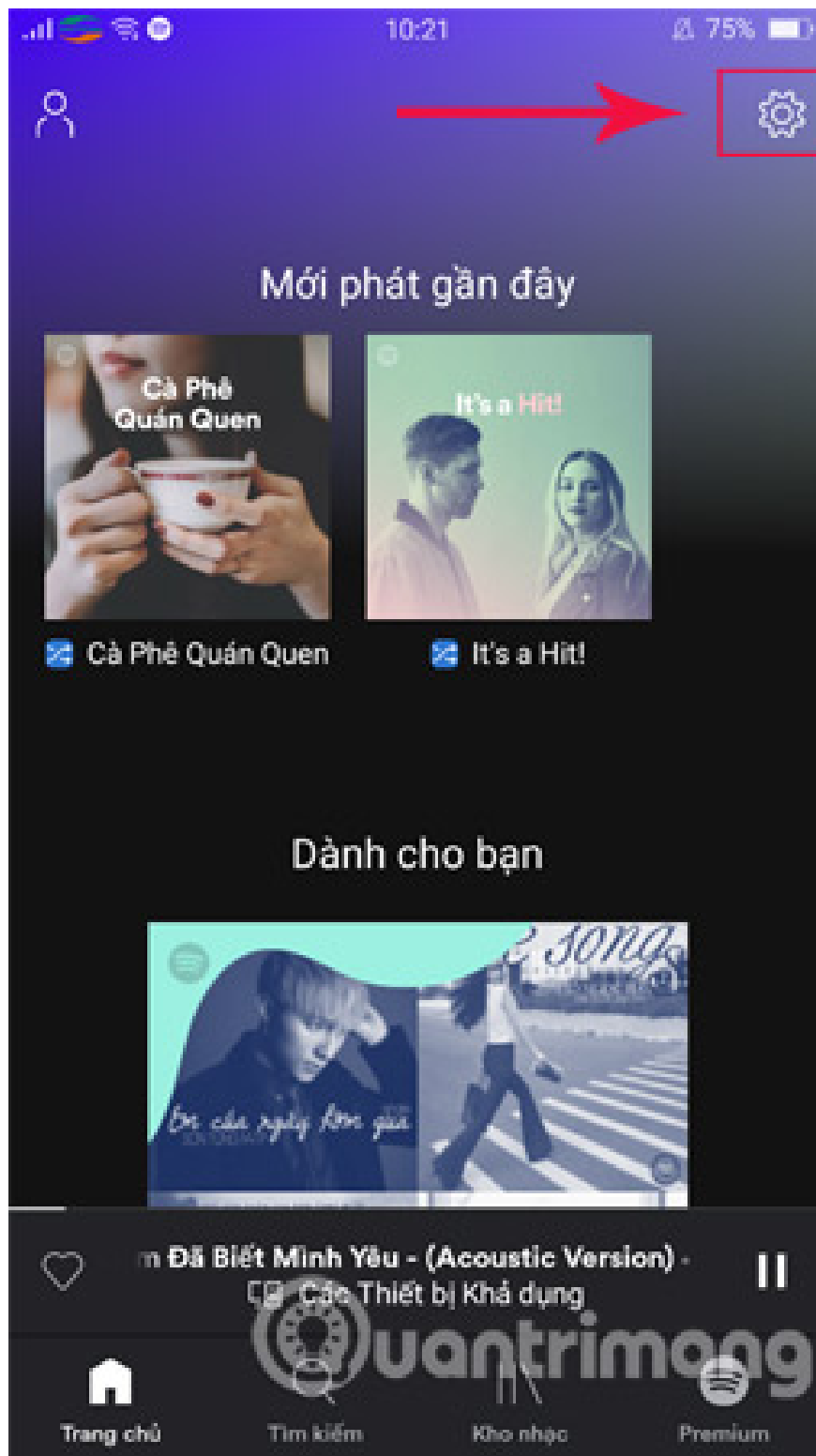
Step 3:

On the phone, open Spotify to access the *home page* of the application.



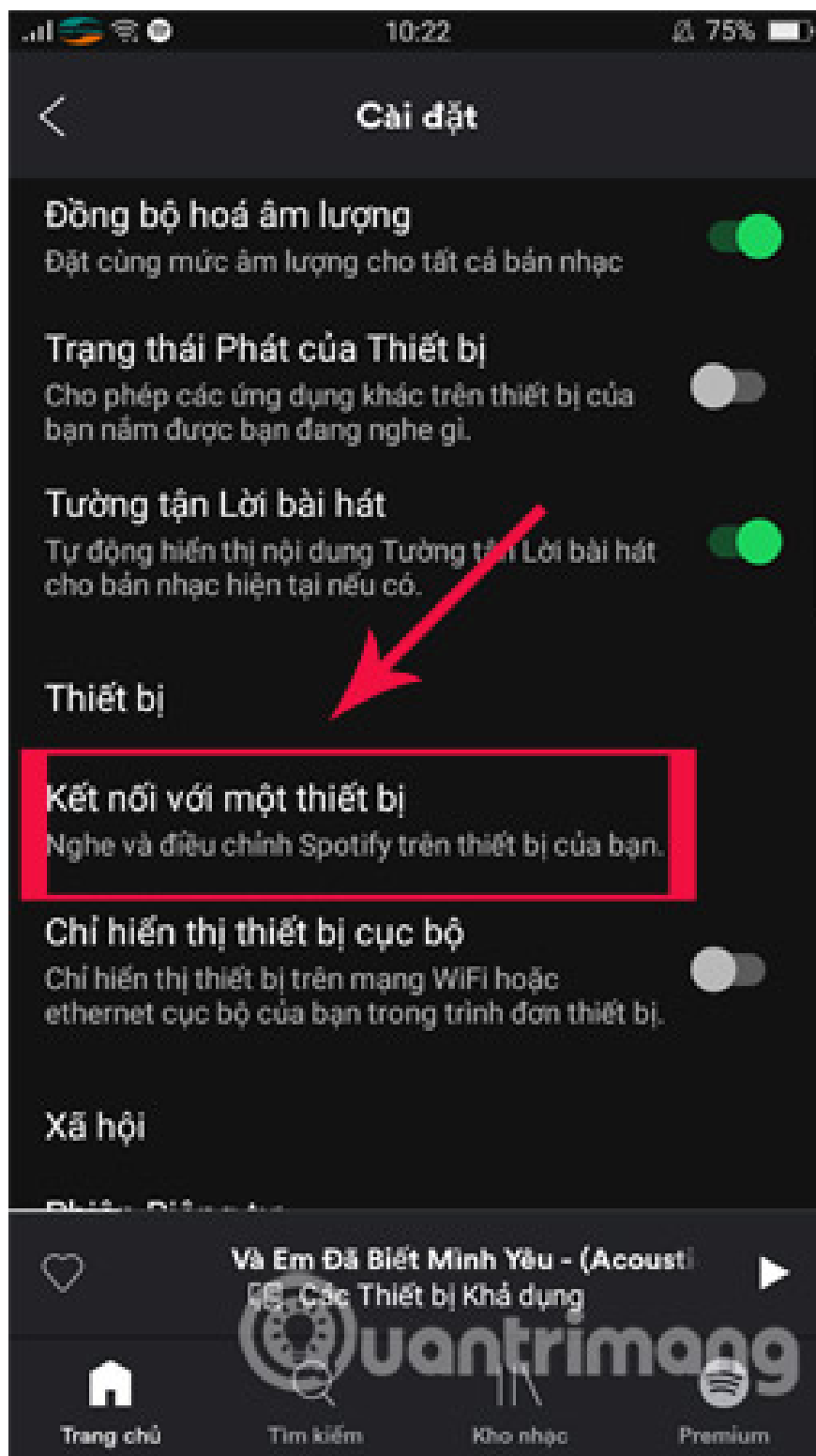
Step 4:

Next, select the *Settings* icon as shown.



Step 5:

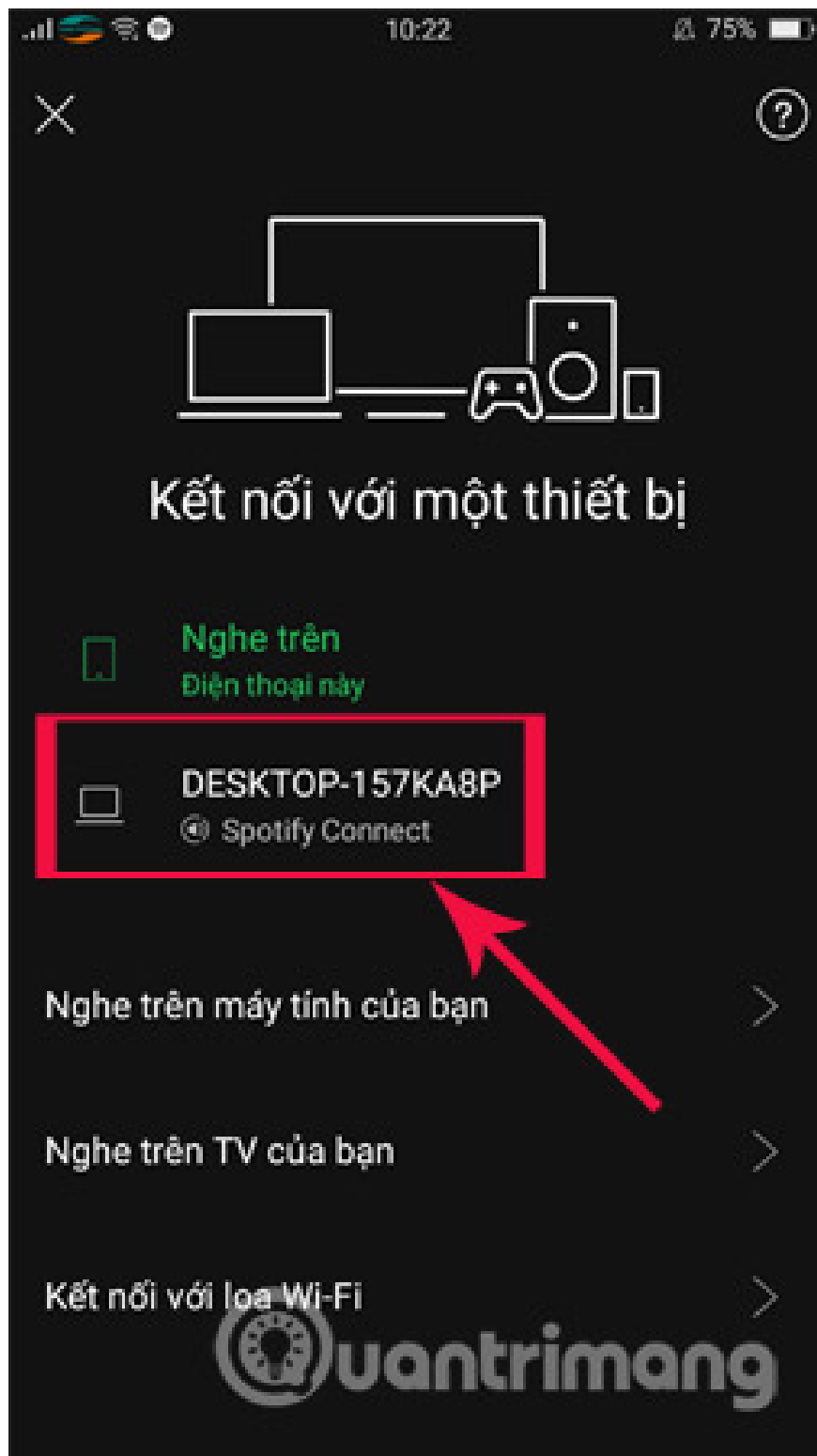
Scroll down under Device search and select *Connect to a device*.



Step 6:

To connect Spotify connection from your phone to your computer, simply choose to connect to the computer name you are using (In addition, you can also choose to connect to the TV or speaker here).

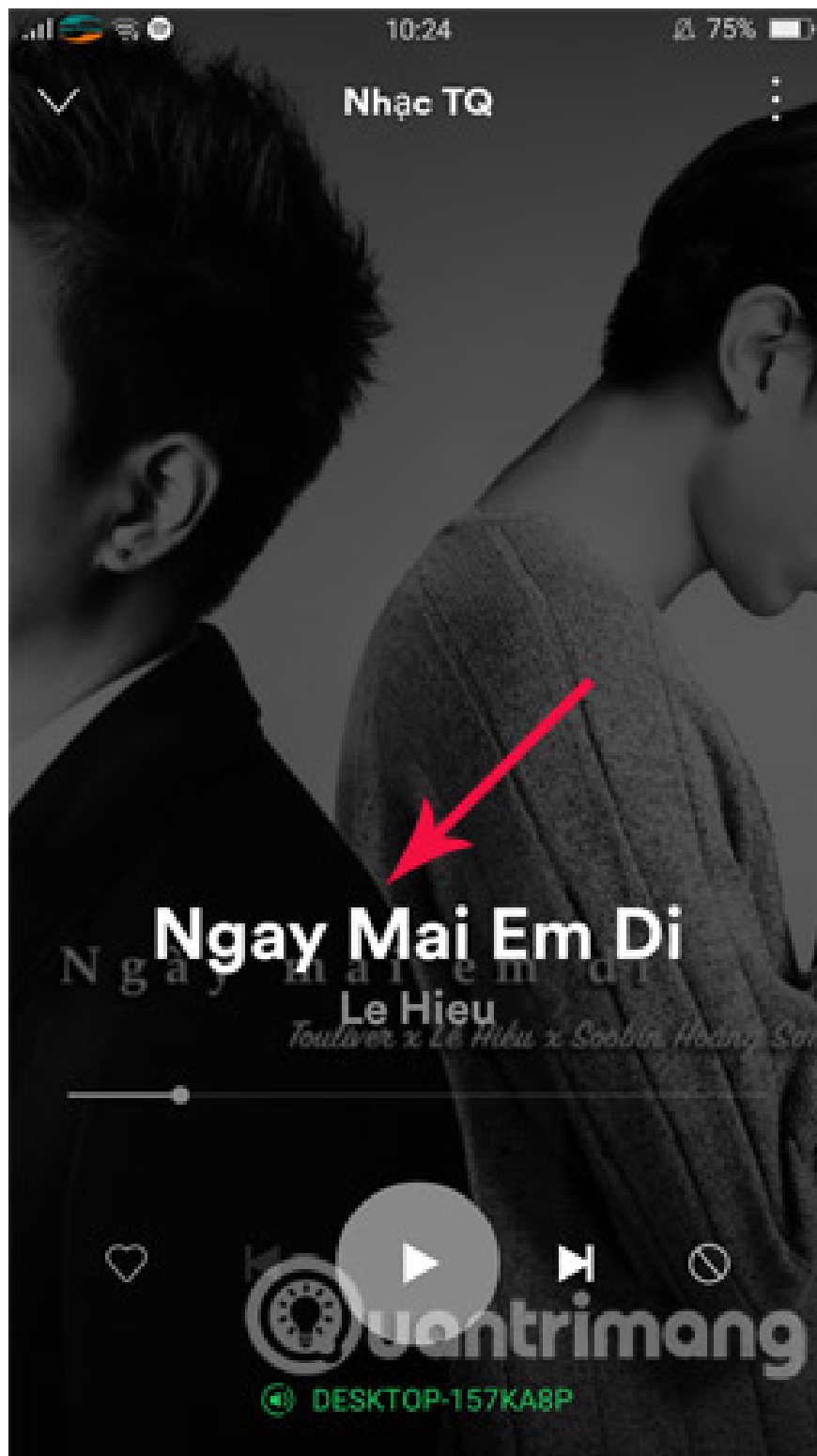
Note : Both computers and phones must connect to a Wifi network.



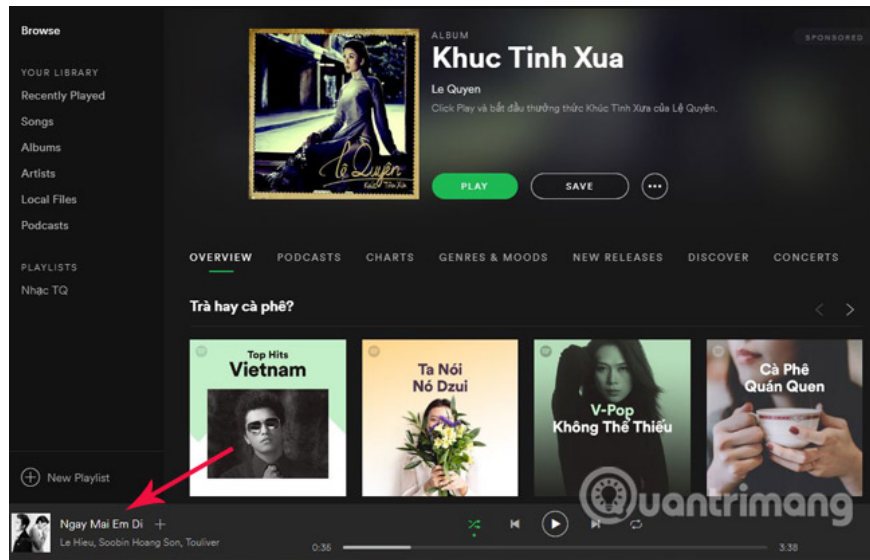
Step 7:

Now, please enjoy the results, open any music on your phone, that song will immediately be played on your computer.

Immediately, the computer will automatically play the song above. So, you can freely control the music playing on your PC with your phone.
