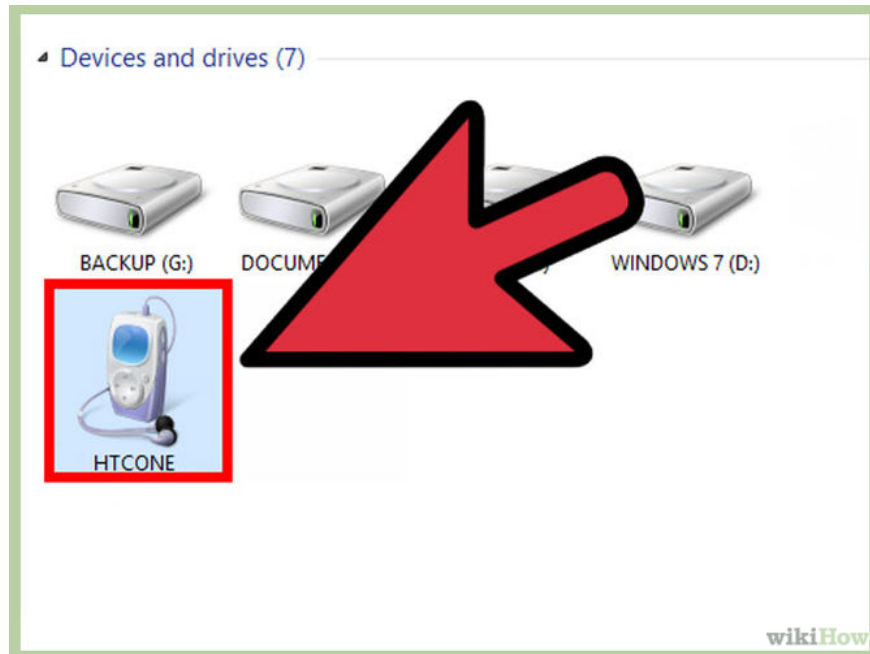
Step 1: Connect the USB cable



Plug one end of the USB cable into your HTC One phone and the other end into your computer.

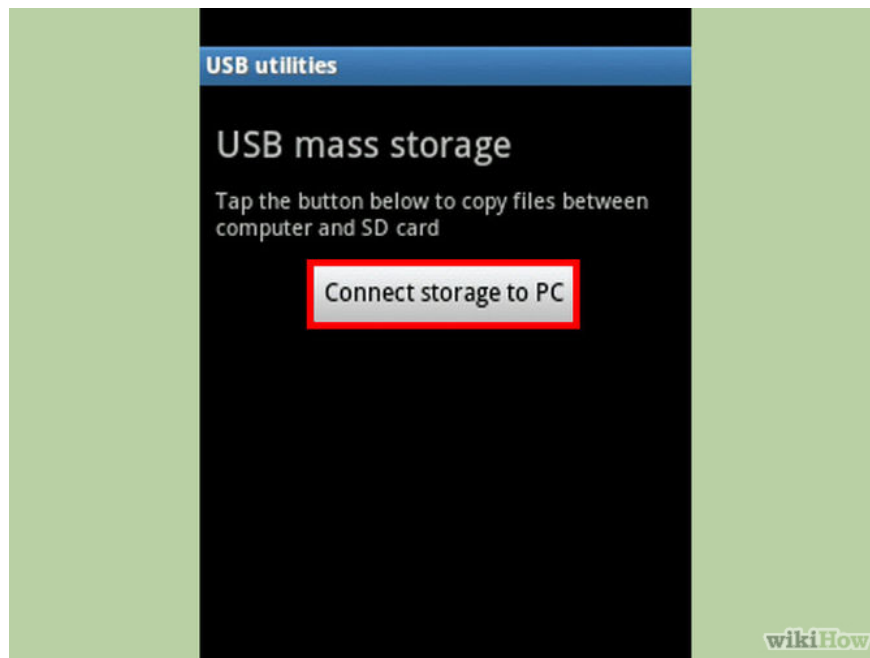
Step 2:



Wait a few minutes for the computer to detect your **HTC One** device.

- If your computer is running **Mac OS X** , you can find your device on **Desktop** or a new search window.
- If your computer is running **Windows** operating system, go to "**My Computer**" , you will see your HTC One device.

Step 3: Select the connection type



On an **HTC One** phone, you can choose one of the following connection types:

- **Only charging** : This option is simply charging your battery.

- **Disk Drive**: This option is only activated when you use an external storage device. You can copy files from phone storage to computer and vice versa.

- **HTC Sync Manager**: This option will connect your phone to the **HTC** application on your computer. This app is called **HTC Sync Manager**.

- **Media Sync**: This option will allow you to sync your phone into a multimedia application on your computer.
