Instructions for creating an Apple ID account for children

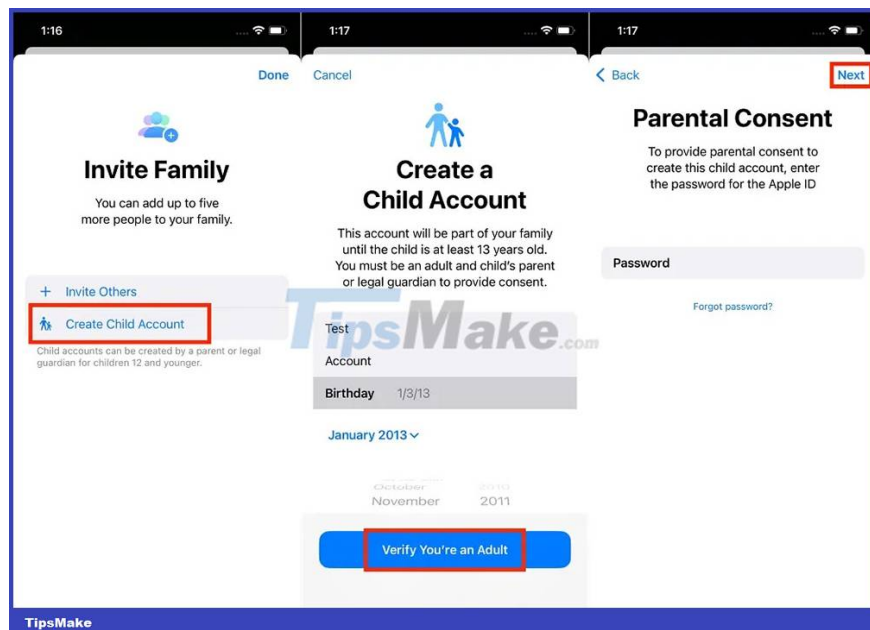
Step 1:

At the interface on iPhone, click Settings and then select your Apple ID account. Next, click on Family Sharing below and select the add member icon in the upper right corner.



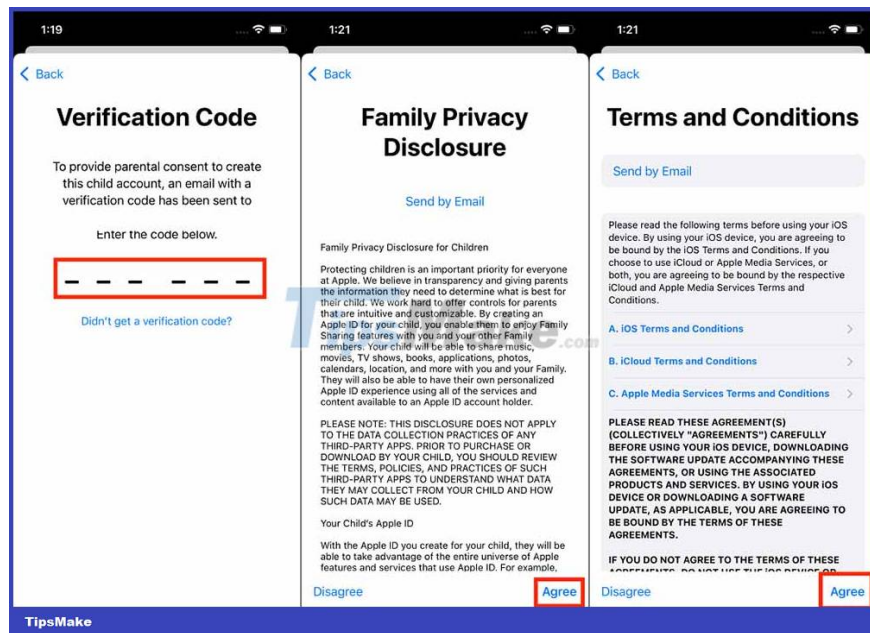
Step 2:

Now click the Create Child Account button, then fill in the child's information and click Verify You're an Adult to confirm the adult. Now you need to enter the password for your Apple ID account.



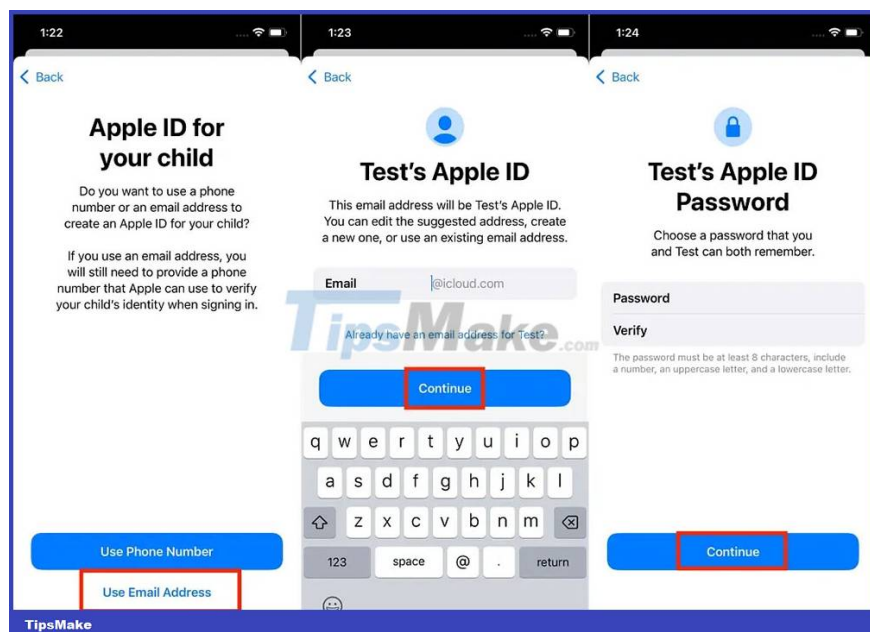
Step 3:
