How to create application folders in iPhone

Step 1:

Press and hold the screen until the x icon appears on the icons. Then **press and hold an app icon** and move it to another app that you want to combine into a folder.

Right then you get the folder created by iPhone.





Step 2:

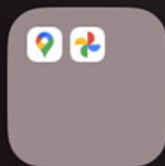
Long press on the folder and select **Rename** in the menu that appears. Now **enter the new folder name** you want to set instead of the default folder name set by the iPhone.

Now we drag the apps into that folder to group them.

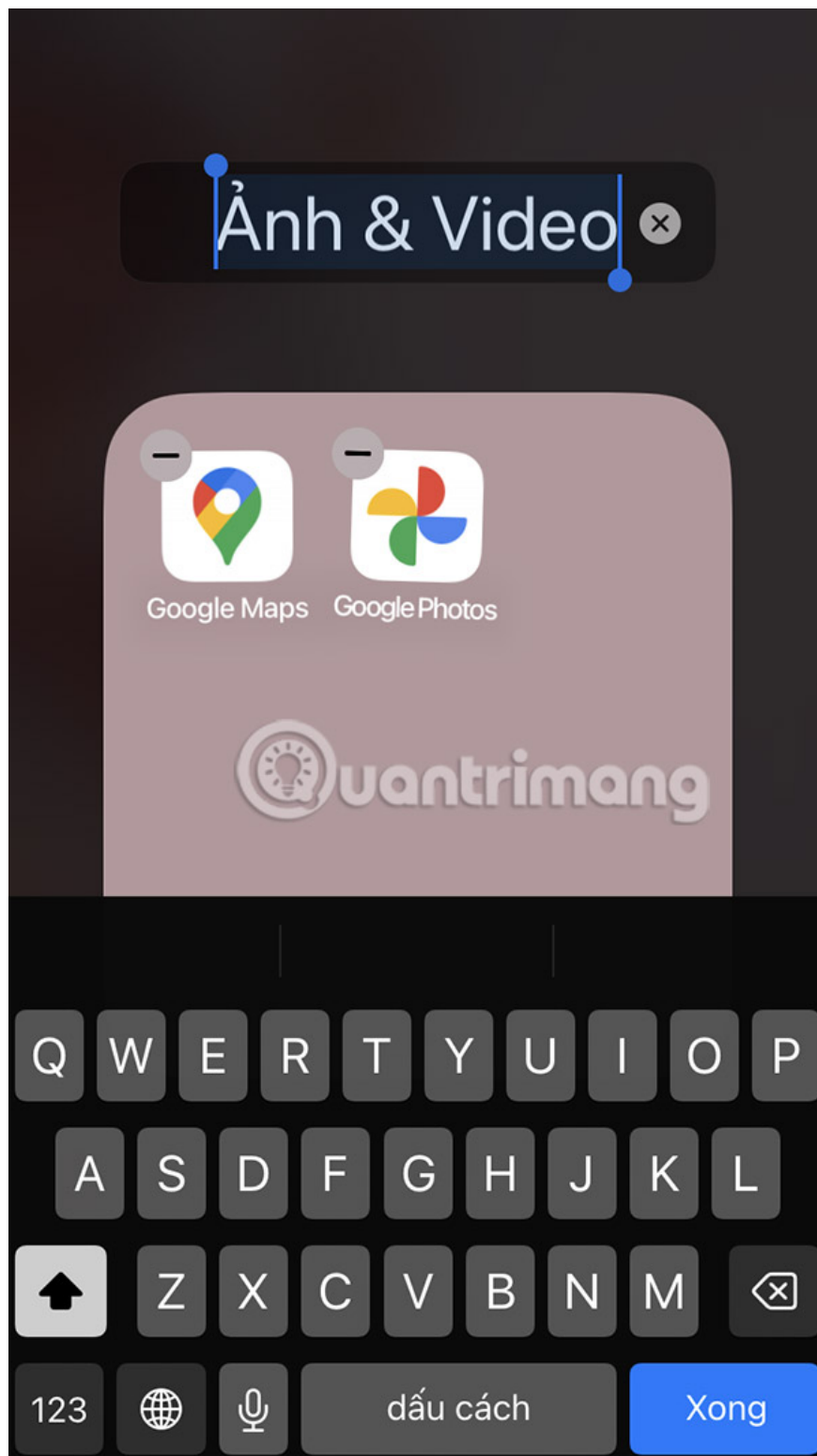

Step 3:

To delete an app in a folder , just press and hold on the app and drag it off the screen .



To delete a folder on iPhone, users simply delete all the apps inside that folder. As soon as you delete the last app from the folder, it will automatically disappear.
