1. Download Adobe Photoshop CS2 - free copyright
2. Download Adobe Photoshop CS6 - new version with many outstanding features

Prepare:

Before we start, we need to have the original character image for tattooing, so choose a photo that contains body parts containing tattoos such as arms, abdomen, chest . Tattoos should be taken as *. PNG for convenience during transplantation does not need to delete the background image. As an example here:

Collage:



Tattoo photos:

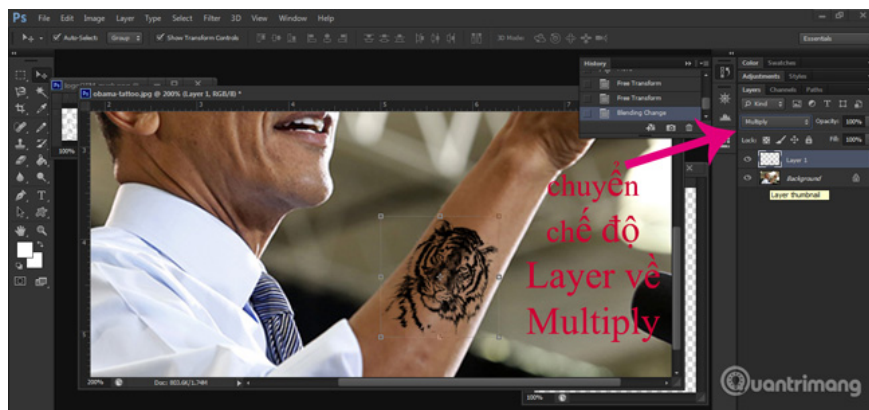


Steps to take:

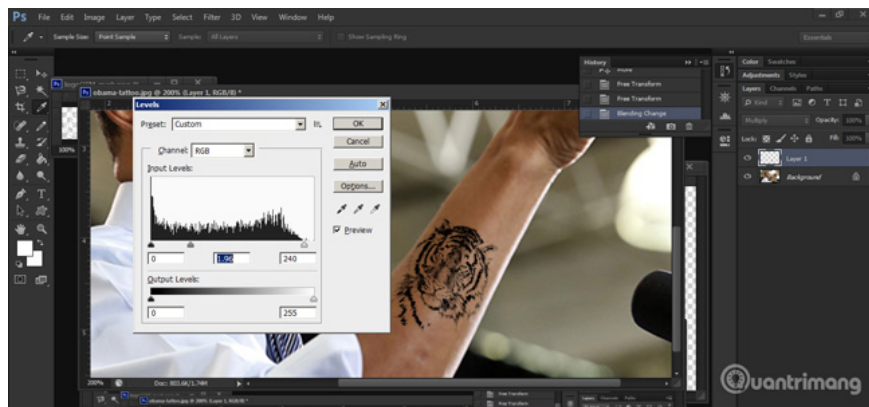
For brevity, I will temporarily call the original image A, tattoo image B. Open photos A and B in Photoshop, then drag and drop photos B into A:



Next, select the Layer of image B and press Ctrl + T to rotate and collapse the tattoo to the required position (note the Shift button to shrink the image to keep the width-to-width ratio), and switch the mode of Image layer B into Multiply. Here I am going to show the tattoo above the character's arm:



Our temporary result will look like the picture above, but it seems that the color of the tattoo is not very realistic. No need to worry, still select Photo B layer and press Ctrl + L to open the dark, light mode control panel:



This depends on the skill and the aesthetic of each different person. And this is my result:



The picture looks cool and cool right?*Good luck!*
