

Instructions for deleting multiple objects using the image overlay method in Photoshop

This method removes objects that need to be eliminated by using overlapping images. The image areas of the deleted object are replaced with empty image areas.

To remove the distracting object in an image in Photoshop, we can use manual tools like Clone Stamp Tool, Patch Tool, Spot Healing Brush Tool. However, these methods are not applicable to photos of streets or public structures because there are too many people moving. Removing those objects manually and recreating the deletion area will be very difficult.

However, you do not need to worry because the video below will guide you in detail how to handle images with many objects to remove in Photoshop. This method is called image overlay mode.

This method helps us to remove objects that need to be eliminated by using overlapping images. With this method, the image object areas to be deleted are replaced with empty image areas.

This method helps you to erase many objects in a photo quickly and produce impressive results. However, it also has the drawback that you need to take a lot of photos to be able to overlap and replace each other. Another requirement is that the images must be fixed at an angle.
