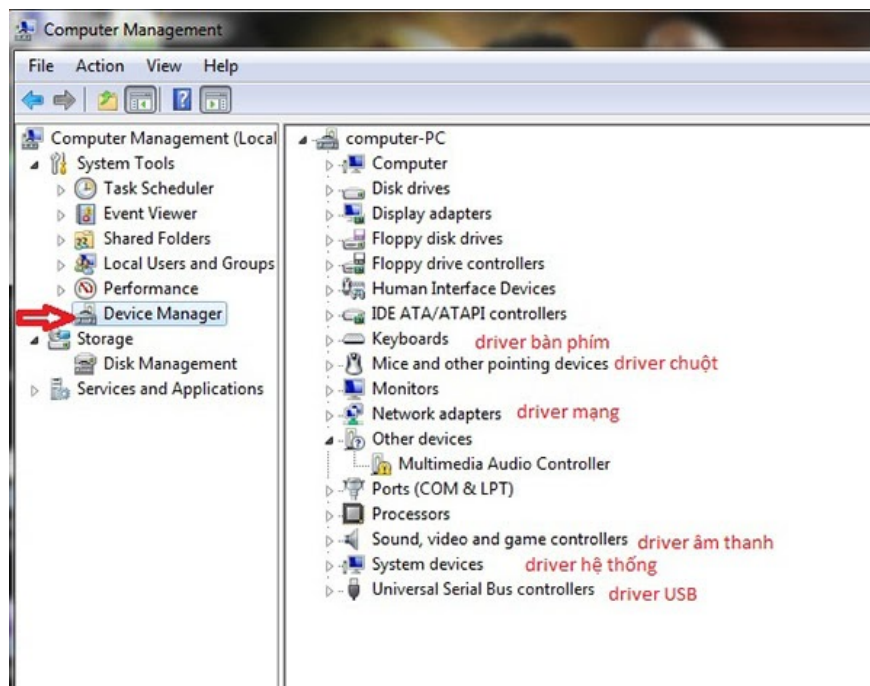


Instructions for Downloading and Installing Basic Drivers for Windows

Drivers are extremely important to help your computer operate. Hoang Ha PC will guide you on how to check and install basic drivers.

Check if the device drivers are installed properly?

The first issue in the content of the **basic driver download and installation guide** that we want to mention is **to check the drivers in your device, see if they are fully installed or not**. Because you will not be able to use the functions of the computer if the drivers are not fully installed. Specifically: all will not work. Besides, even the internet cannot be connected if the drivers are missing.



To check if the driver is fully installed, we will do the following: **Right-click and select the My Computer or This PC icon > select Manage (At this time, the Computer Management interface will appear on the screen) > right-click and select Device Manager.**

Entering this folder, we can check whether the drivers are missing or not. Drivers with a yellow exclamation mark icon mean that the driver on the computer is not yet installed. That means you need to install additional drivers for the computer immediately if you do not want to be interrupted when using a certain feature.

Basic steps to download and install drivers on laptop

To download and install drivers, you can search for drivers from the manufacturer's website. For laptops, you can search for drivers at the following website addresses corresponding to each type of laptop:

- Sony Laptops: <https://www.sony.com/electronics/support>
- Acer Laptop: <https://www.acer.com/vn-vi/>
- Dell Laptop: <https://www.dell.com/support/home/en-vn>
- Asus Laptops: <https://www.asus.com/support>

Depending on the type of laptop you are using, choose the appropriate website to search for drivers. Then proceed to install the driver for the Laptop. First, you need to know the code or symbol of your Laptop model to perform the search. Once you have the symbol, you just need to enter the driver installation page from the manufacturer's homepage.

Specific examples

For your convenience, we will take an example of how to find and download drivers for Dell laptops!

First, you will get the Service Tag code of the Dell laptop located on the bottom of the laptop. Then access the website link: <https://www.dell.com/support/home/en-vn> . On the homepage of the website you just accessed, **you will see a box with the words Enter your Service Tag or Express Service Code. Enter the Service Tag code there and click Submit.**

Next, you will select the Windows operating system corresponding to your laptop. Immediately, the browser page will take you to the list of drivers to download and install.

The final step is to download all these drivers to your laptop and install them. After completing the installation process, don't forget to check again if these drivers are fully installed!

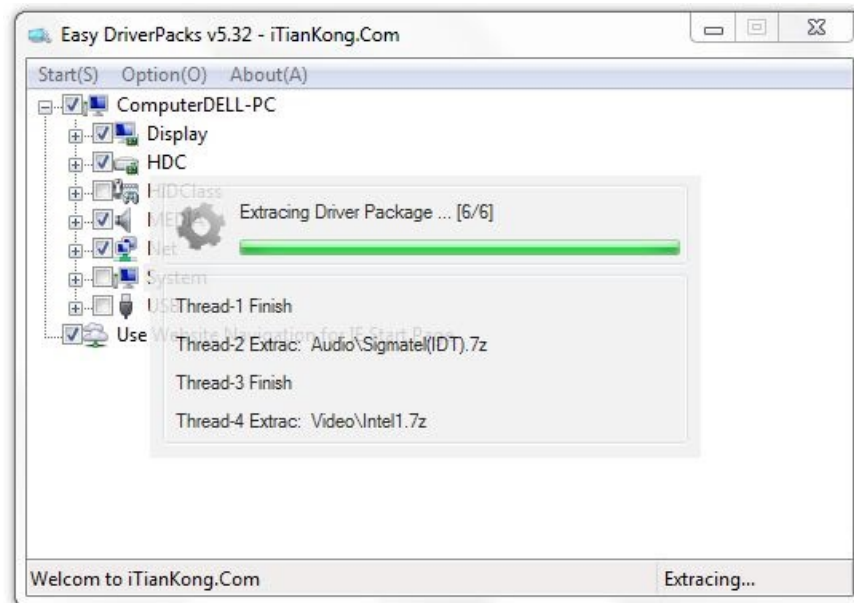


For other laptop models, you also do the same as on Dell laptops. As for PC desktop devices, you open the CPU case **to** see the **Mainboard** name . Then, on the search toolbar, enter the keyword including " **Driver + Mainboard Name** ". Next, you just need to access the manufacturer's homepage link, proceed to download and install.

In conclusion, after checking which **drivers** are missing and need to be added, we will proceed to download and install the missing drivers. By following the instructions for downloading and installing the basic drivers in the article, you will be done.
