

Instructions for drawing nose characters Anime, Manga standard

To know the exact position of the nose on the face, you can refer to the Guide to drawing face of female Anime characters and male Anime characters.



The position of the nose on the character's face

The nose of anime and manga characters tends to be smaller and sharper than reality. Of course you can also variation the nose for a variety of styles. At that time, it was simple to draw, but it was possible to change it according to the "**realistic**" style for a more **realistic** look. Follow the following instructions.

How to draw Anime - Manga characters

Draw the nose like reality

Drawing the nose looks real, it will be quite similar to the traditional painting art. This style nose will have more curves, paying more attention to every detail.

With a **view from the side** , draw a line outlining the original shape of the nose, draw the nostril in front of the tip of the nose, and draw the bridge of the nose with a gentle curve.

With **3/4 face view** , you also begin by sketching the main shape of the nose. Express the tip of the nose with a curve just below the nasal bridge. Depending on the angle, you can draw one or both nostrils. Usually the nostril is farther away will draw smaller.

For a **frontal view** , draw both sides of the same nasal bottom, draw the bridge of the nose, the tip of the nose in the opposite direction to the light source in the drawing context.

Draw anime character's nose, Manga based on shadow and light

Another way to paint the nose for anime and manga characters is to use light and shadow to create a nose shape.

From the side , you draw the nose roughly like the example above, but the tip of the nose is slightly more pointed.

With a **3/4 view angle** , you can draw the overhanging nose that doesn't see the bottom of the nose, except when the light comes from below, you draw over the top of the nose.

Most of the time, under normal lighting conditions, the nose will have a shadow on the bottom and opposite side of the light source. So, if you draw the nose from **the perspective** and the light source comes from the upper left corner, you will draw the ball at the bottom and right of the nose. If the light comes from below, then you paint the ball over the top of the nose.

This style will be appropriate if you want your work to keep the pros but still somewhat anime and manga style. This way of drawing is also used when displaying a close-up of a character's face.

Draw the nose of Anime and Manga characters in the usual way

To draw the nose of anime and manga characters from **the side view** in the most popular way, you draw a small trailing line check ? in the vertical direction and no need to draw nostrils.

Do the same for **the 3/4 face angle** but the ? check mark is smaller to represent another angle. You can also draw a small curve or a dot to represent the tip but don't draw the top curve.

With a **perspective** , draw a ball of the nose on one side, or a vertical line in the middle to represent the nostril. Also depending on the style of story you want to draw, even for simplicity you may not need to draw the character nose

Above are some suggestions when drawing the nose for Anime and Manga characters. However, you can completely create your own nose styles with different styles, different views according to your preferences. However, don't be too fussy and still follow certain characteristics of the anime style. Good luck!
