

# How to enable Passkey access for Windows 11 apps

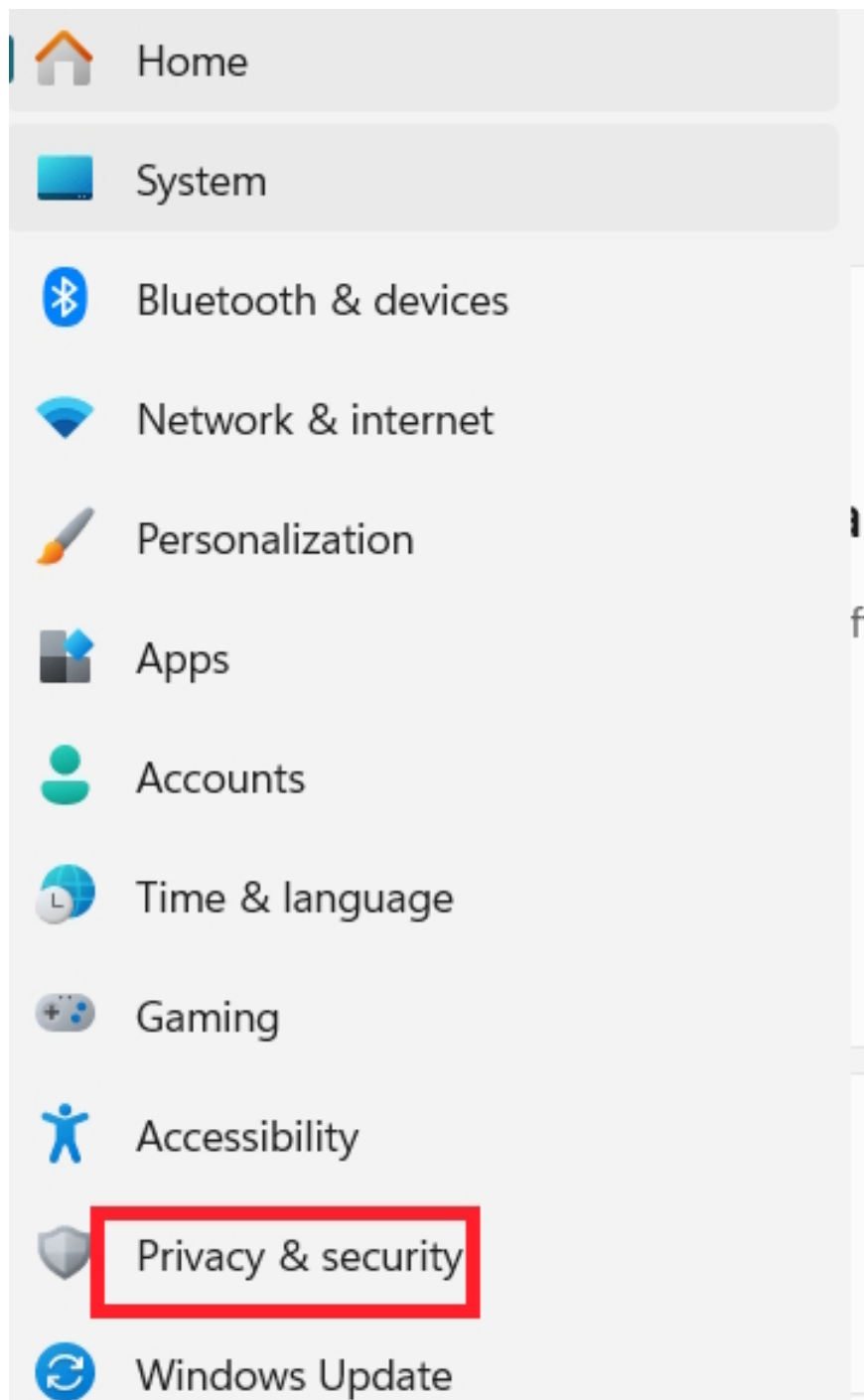
Apps can ask to create or use Passkeys on your Windows 11 PC, and you'll manage app Passkey access, following the instructions below.

## How to enable Passkey access for Windows 11 apps

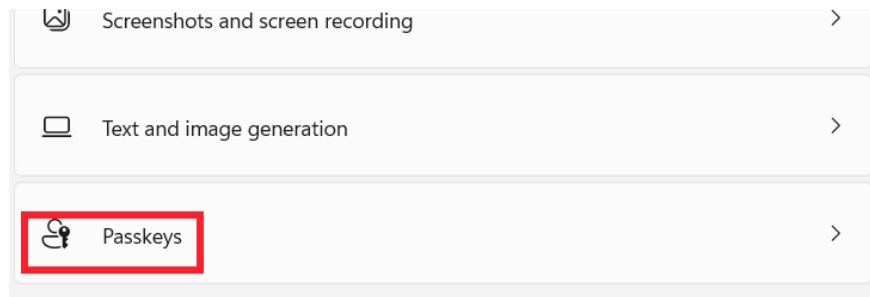
### Step 1:

Open Settings on Windows then **select Privacy & security** in the left menu of the interface.



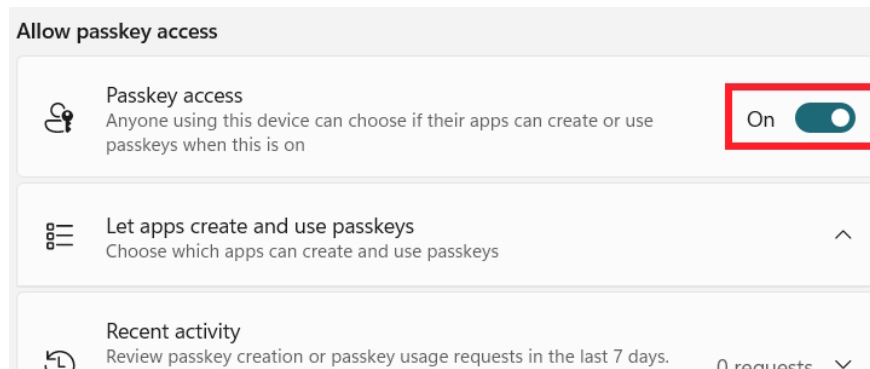
**Step 2:**

Looking at the next interface, we scroll down and click on **the Passkey feature** to proceed with the setup.



### Step 3:

In the next new interface, users need to **enable Passkey access settings** .



Applications will then request to use and access the passkey on your computer. Enabling or disabling passkey access is a simple process. And regularly reviewing the application permissions associated with the passkey can improve the overall security of your computer.
