There's a Mail Privacy Protection setting built into your iPhone to block this type of tracking. Here's how to turn on Mail privacy protection on iPhone.

How to Turn on iPhone Mail Privacy Protection

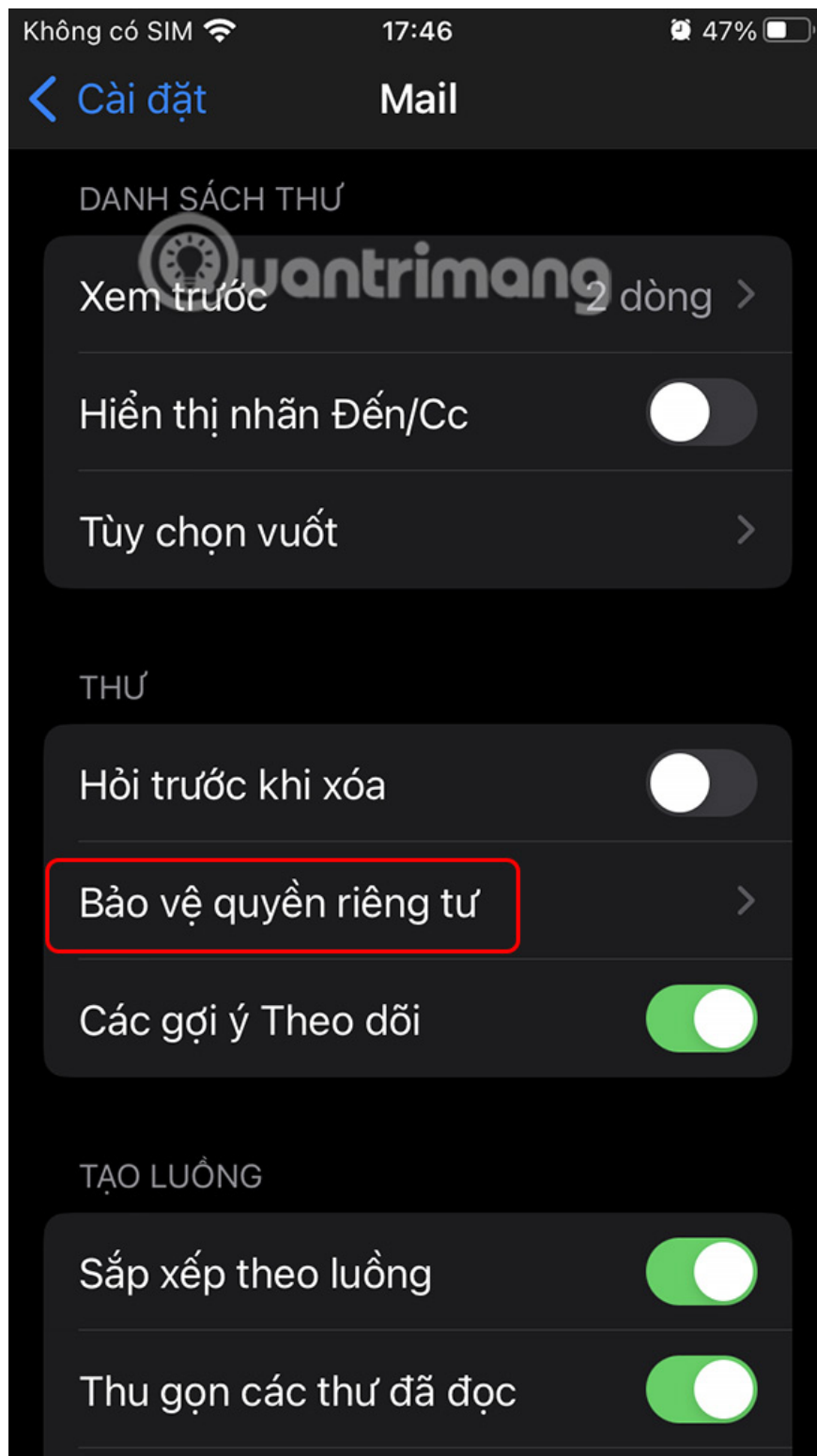
Step 1:

You access Settings on iPhone then tap on **the Mail app** to make adjustments.



Step 2:

Switch to the custom settings interface for the Mail app, scroll down and select **Privacy protection** .



Step 3:

Now you will see that **the Mail activity protection setting** is turned off, please **enable this setting** to enhance Mail security on iPhone.

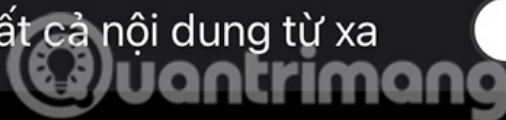


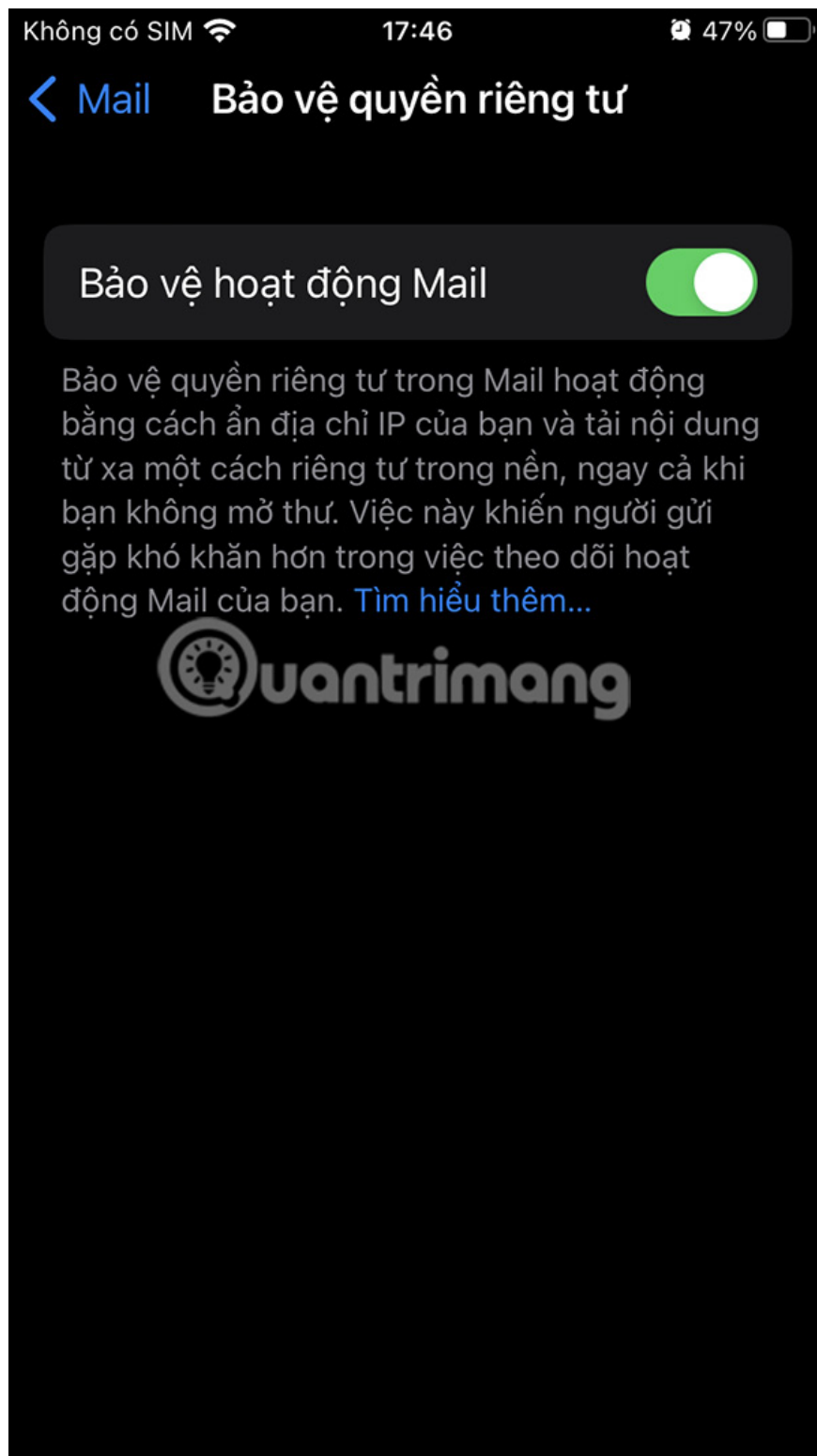
