If you are switching from Android to iOS, you may want to move your Gmail contact list to iCloud. In this article, TipsMake.com will guide you to do that.

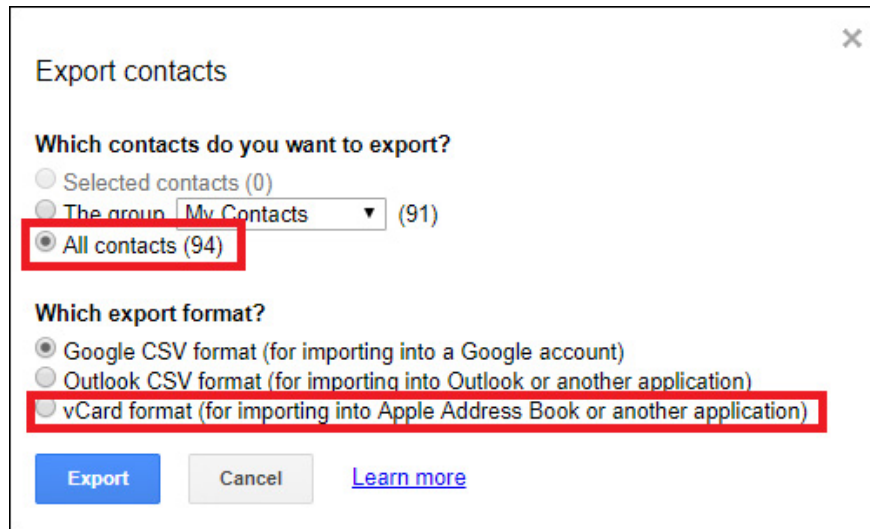

## How to move Gmail contacts from Android to iOS

1. First, you need to access **contacts.google.com** and log in to your Gmail account.
2. In the left panel, expand the **More** menu .
3. In the section **Which contacts do you want to export?** , click **All Contacts** .
4. Under **Which export format?** , click to select **vCard format (for importing into Apple Address Book or another application)**.
5. Visit **iCloud.com** and log in to your account.
6. Click **Contacts**.
7. Next, click the gear icon in the lower left corner of the screen.
8. Select **Import vCard** .
9. Use the pop-up window to browse previously downloaded files from Google Contacts.
10. Finally, click **Open**.



Depending on the size of the VCF file, uploading and importing contacts may take several minutes. Once completed, you will see all Google contacts on the screen.

All contacts will be available in the iPhone's contacts application and any other Apple device you own.
