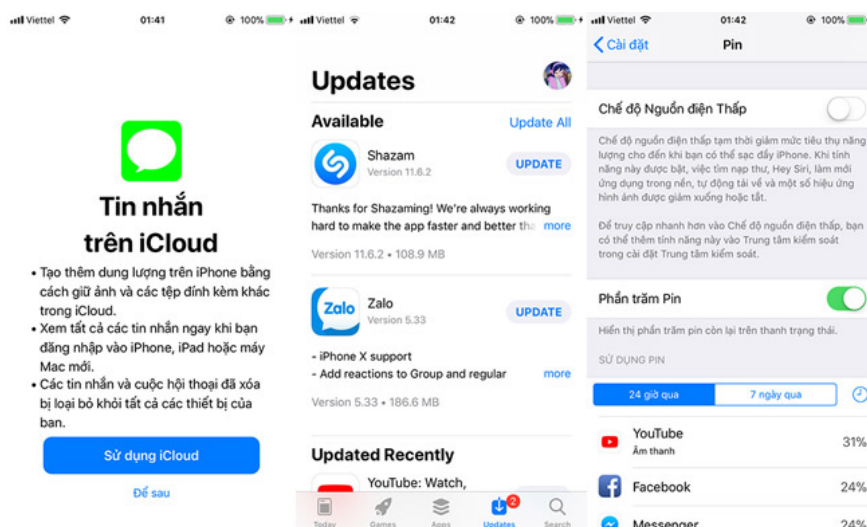


Instructions for iOS 11.3 official update to turn off the iPhone slowing feature

If you are looking forward to this update, you can proceed to upgrade iOS 11.3 now, and the following article will show you how to update iOS 11.3 officially.

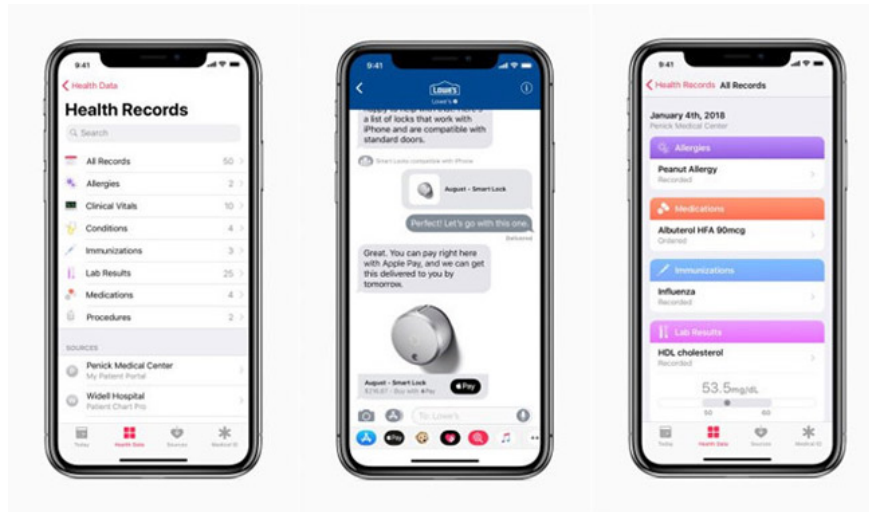

The new version of iOS 11.3 released in the morning brings with it many valuable improvements, such as the message feature on iCloud that has officially returned, it allows you to save messages on iCloud and sync via Different devices. In the Settings section, a section of Privacy is also added, in the App Store the update is added with version information and capacity of the application.



"Apple House" also brought a small change on iOS 11.3, when deleting the message in the Message section, there will be a notification will appear by default to confirm the deletion but not delete immediately as on the previous version. . AppStore on iOS 11.3 also has a separate startup page.

The most anticipated price improvement in this new iOS update is probably the off feature that reduces battery performance. Upgrade to iOS 11.3 users can check the battery status on the device yourself, from which option to use the performance reduction feature of Apple.



To update you follow the instructions below:

As usual, you can update immediately by going to *Settings > General Settings > Software update*. Particularly for you who are in Beta version to update iOS 11.3 officially, do the following:

1. Connect your iOS device to iTunes on a PC or Mac.
2. The connection process is successful, you reboot the device by holding down the Home and Power buttons simultaneously, but do not let go when the Apple logo appears but must continue to hold until the iPhone and iPad enter mode Recovery Mode).
3. When the device boots into Recovery Mode, iTunes will immediately display the update message and you just need to follow the instructions of iTunes correctly and will update to iOS 11.3 officially successful.
